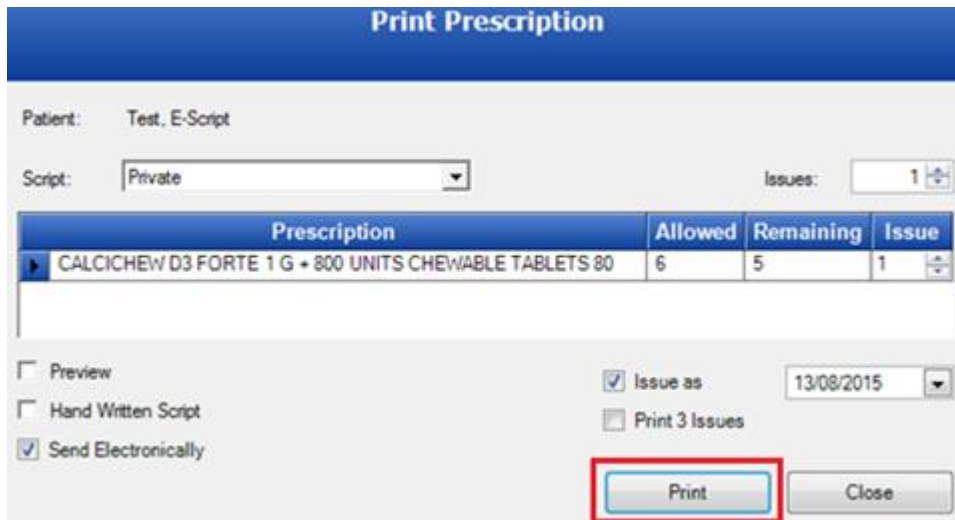


## 1. Print Prescription

When the doctor prints a prescription **Send Electronically** will be checked by default. When the doctor clicks **Print** a new account will attempt to be created.



## 2. Registration

### User Consent

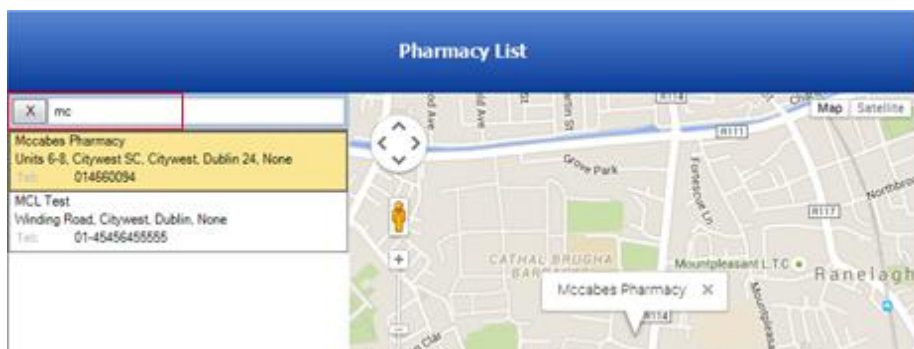
The doctor must read the consent and click Yes to be registered on e-Script. [Consent is displayed in Control Panel > My Profile.]

### Patient Consent

The doctor must enter the patient's mobile number and confirm their consent to register on escript. [Patient consent is recorded in Extra Patient Details.]

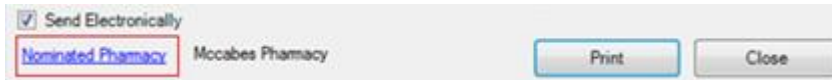
## 3. Patients Pharmacy

Select the Patients Pharmacy and click ok to send the E-Script. Type in the Search field or scroll through the available list. The Pharmacy list will be sorted A – Z if the Practice does not have the Lat/Longitude set in Practice details.



## Nominated Pharmacy

The last pharmacy used for the patient is displayed the next time a prescription is printed. Click **Nominated Pharmacy** to search & select another Pharmacy.



## 4. E-Script Status


A patients' prescription history is synchronised on chart load and when Printing Prescriptions. The Dispensed Status in the patients' chart will be updated if the prescription is marked as Dispensed by the Pharmacy.

## 5. Configuration

### Practice Location Lat/Lng

Open My Control Panel > Admin Console > Practice. Click the Google Maps icon in the Latitude / Longitude field and save the details.



### Send Electronically Preference

If the doctor does not wish for the **Send Electronically** to be checked by default select Edit > Preferences. Select Prescriptions tab and uncheck 'Send eScript Electronically'.
