Full-time version

Part-time version

- This is a two-year programme delivered over 3 semesters from September to September.
- When completed the student will be awarded with a nationally recognised undergraduate qualification.
- This programme is delivered at 2 partner colleges: West Herts College, Watford and North Hertfordshire College, Stevenage Campus

For both modes of study
