

This affordable, light-weight car booster is great for play dates, travel, taxis & rental cars - anytime you need to take a booster! With seat belt positioning clips in place of 'arm-rests', it will fit in smaller spaces where other boosters won't, making it possible to fit 3 kids across the back seat! It easily deflates after use, making it transportable in a school bag, flight bag, glove compartment or handbag. It weighs approximately half a kilo. BubbleBum is suitable for children aged between 4-11 years who weigh between 15-36kgs and should be used only with a normal 3 point vehicle seat belt.

## User Instructions

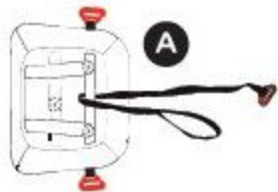


- Remove BubbleBum from packaging and locate air valve at the rear of BubbleBum. Twist valve open and, with your mouth, blow into the valve until it reaches maximum capacity, then twist valve to close. (Image 1)
- Position child on BubbleBum in vehicle, THEN buckle vehicle seat belt. (Image 2)
- Slide vehicle seatbelt (lap belt portion) into BOTH red side clips on either side of the seat. (Image 3)
- Vehicle seatbelt (lap and shoulder belt strap) should fit firmly against the child and the vehicle lap belt strap should be worn low down across the child's lap. Ensure strap is not twisted.
- To uninstall, slide vehicle seatbelt out of red side clip. Then unbuckle the vehicle seat belt.
- For storage, place BubbleBum on a flat solid surface with valve facing away from you and roll booster up to expel air. Repeat this step twice to remove as much air as possible and then close valve before packing into the carry bag provided. (Image 4)

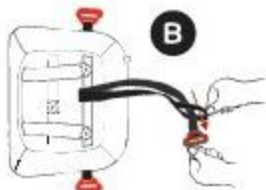
### Securing Child in Vehicle



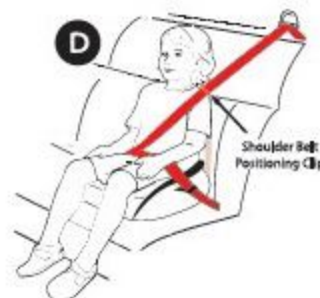
The shoulder belt **MUST** lay across child's shoulder in the red zone as shown. If the shoulder belt lays outside this zone, the shoulder belt positioning clip **MUST** be used.



Insert the loop end of the strap around the middle of the strap on the underside of the BubbleBum as shown in diagram A.



Pass the clip through the loop ends (like a luggage label) as shown in diagram B and pull straps as shown in diagram C.



Slide the vehicle belt into the clip as shown in diagram D and pull down to tighten clip against child's shoulder. The lap belt portion **MUST** pass through both red side clips and be positioned low on the hips. The belt **MUST NOT** be twisted.
