RULES

The competition deadline is **5pm, Thursday 6 June 2019**.

Competition entries must be from primary school aged children.

Entries will be split into two categories: Primary 1-3 and Primary 4-7. Winners will be selected from each category.

Any 2D/flat materials can be used to create a picture, which should be supplied as either A4 or A3 size. If submitting a digital entry, images must be 3500 pixels wide by 5000 pixels high and supplied in Jpeg (.jpg) or Tiff (.tif) formats.
