William Penn Christmas Carol Service – 18th December at Christ's Hospital Reminder

Our carol service is fast approaching; taking place on Monday 18th December at 6pm at Christ's Hospital School Chapel. Please remember that we would like to welcome you and your relatives as we will have ample seating and parking space.

On the morning of December 18th we would ask you to bring your children to the chapel between 8.45am and 9am for a rehearsal. We have arranged transportation back to school in time for lunch and school will finish at the normal time at 3.15pm. We would ask that costumes are returned promptly by Wednesday 20th December, washed and dried ready for use next year.
