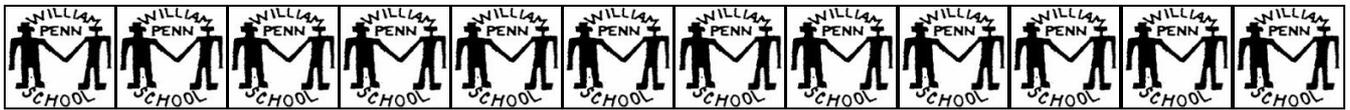
### End of Term Arrangements – Clothes Recycling/Loop It
