



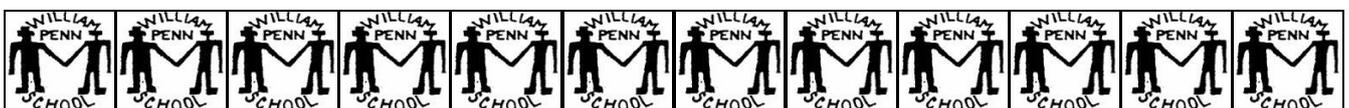
Home Learning Reminder


Please sign and return the Acceptable Use Agreement Form as soon as possible to the School Office.
