

TRAVELLING TO AND FROM HARTING SCHOOL

We kindly request everyone is considerate of our neighbours when delivering and collecting children at the beginning and end of the day.

If you arrive at the front of the school, please walk along the pedestrian pathway rather than using the driveway.

WALK, SCOOTER, CYCLE

Our "Travel Plan" encourages children to travel to school by foot, scooter or bicycle. Children may leave their bikes and scooters in the racks which are located at the front of the school at the far end of the staff car park. They are left at the owners' risk. We do request that bikes and scooters are not ridden whilst on the school grounds.

TRAVELLING TO AND FROM SCHOOL UNACCOMPANIED

Please let us know if your child has your permission to walk or cycle to and from school unaccompanied. We can then monitor their arrival and release them without being collected by an adult at the end of the day.

PARKING

a. Village Hall Car Park

There are some spaces in the village hall car park. Please **reverse park into the spaces** so that you can see children should they be walking through the car park when you drive off.

b. Tipper Lane

Please comply with the regulations applying to all public roads. Please do not park in front of the school gates or close to the Warrenside access.

c. School Parking

These spaces are for staff and those with a disability only. If your child is sick during the day we are happy for you to park at school to collect your sick child, please remember to close the gates when you leave.

HARTING MINIBUS

The Harting minibuses are used each day to take children who attend secondary school in Petersfield. These buses return to Harting village in time for the start of our school day. Should you wish for your child to use this bus service, please ask for the mini-bus coordinator's contact details from the school office.

YOUNGER SIBLINGS

We ask that younger siblings are accompanied by an adult at all times. Unfortunately we cannot allow any children to play on the school apparatus before or after school.
