- evaluation of the strategic, organisational and economic benefits in choosing alternative formulas for the management of public services;
- launch of steering and control systems in companies in which public entities are shareholders;
- introduction of control systems to monitor results and quality of public sector services;
- assessment of top management and the performance of personnel in public administration entities;
- review of personnel policy in public administration entities and public service enterprises;
- assessment of the impact of decentralisation processes within the public sector;
- development of new governance models in social, economic and local systems;
- internationalisation processes of public administration entities;
- simplification and relations between enterprises and the public administration sector.
