1. Please see Mr Royle's minute indicating that mention should be made in the reply of the £7,500 annual grant to the European Movement.
 2. I submit a third paragraph covering this point.
 3. This can of course only be in a negative sense since the purpose of the exchanges financed by the £7,500 is defined in the estimates exactly as described in the paragraph submitted.
The fact that one or two of these visitors have incidentally appeared on British radio and television is not something that we would want to be generally known. Otherwise we shall face the charge that this money is, in this indirect way, being used for propaganda purposes.
