PHASE I

- ✓ (a) P.Q.'s. E.I.D. are alerted and will co-operate; Miss Knox and myself will help.
- ✓ (b) Mr. St. John Stevas' Memorandum. I am in touch with Mr. St. J. S.
- ? (c) Contacts with the Labour Party. These have clearly been made. Mr. Adams (EID) drafted Mr. Howell's speech at the Labour P arty Conference.

- ✓ (g) Pro-Marketeers. Lists herewith. Provincial paper lists (by constituencies) to follow.
- ✓ (h) Ministerial Speeches. ECIU is now receiving advance texts of speeches by Ministers outside the FCO (if rather late!)
