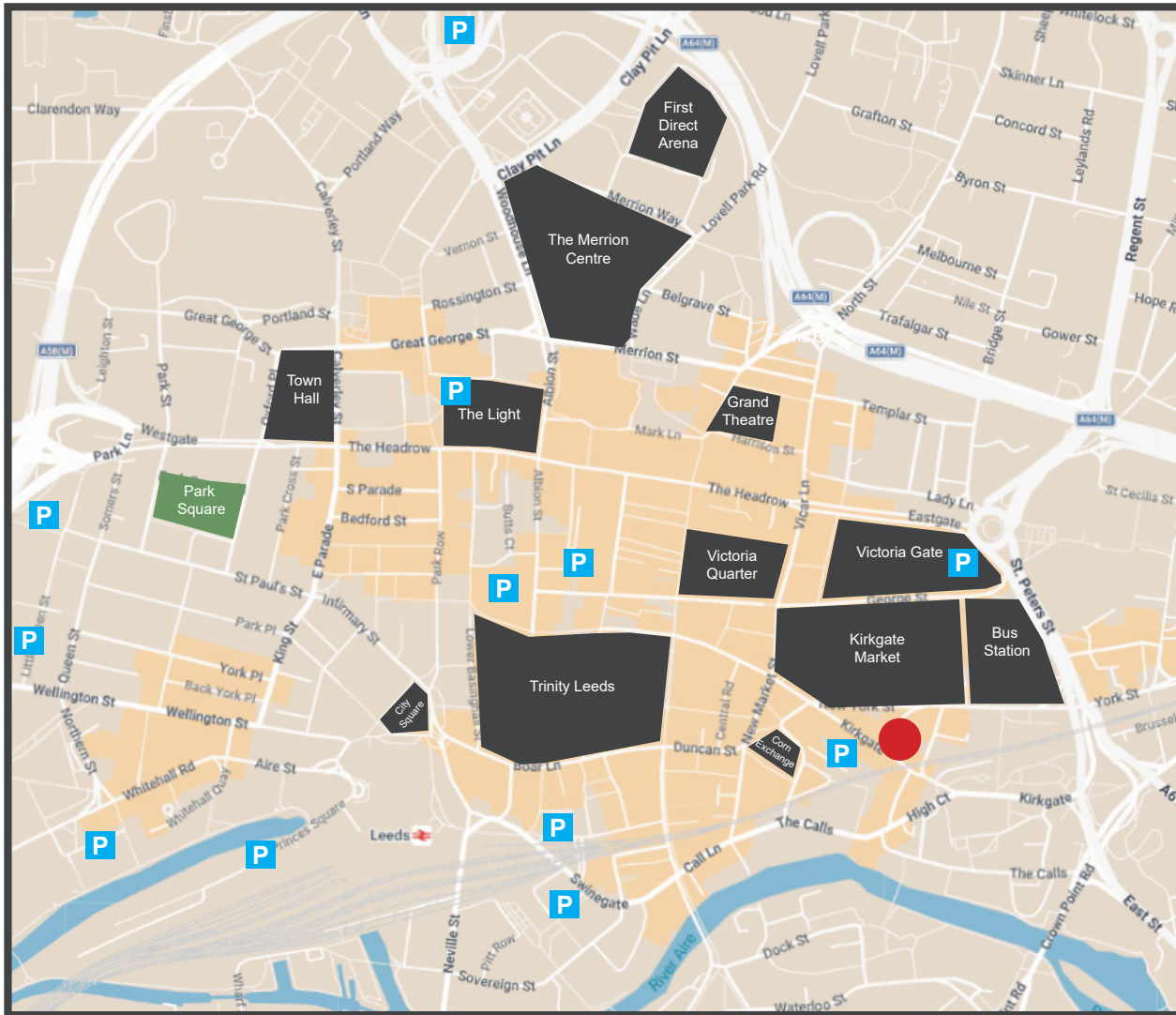

## Situation

- The property has prominent frontage to Kirkgate.
- Kirkgate is situated to the east of Leeds city centre and is the oldest retail street in the city.
- The property benefits from excellent connectivity, being only a short 5-minute walk to the Leeds Bus Station and 10 minutes from Leeds Railway Station
- This is a vibrant location day and night. A number of the buildings and shops have already undergone a sympathetic refurbishment and have been re-occupied by quality independent operators, bringing the location back to life.
- Nearby occupiers provide a range of quality new independent operators including Wapentake café bar, Blue Collar Barbering, Doghouse Bagel Shop and Bar, Konzept Studio, LeSon, Lamb & Flag, Fred Aldous, Crowd of Favours and the recently refurbished stunning Grade II\* First White Cloth Hall.

- 30–31 Kirkgate is a double fronted period property with a ground floor restaurant plus basement storage and ancillary space.

Kirkgate has been a major focus of regeneration for Leeds City Council (LCC) over recent years.

Heritage buildings such as First White Cloth Hall (Grade II\* listed) have benefited from extensive restoration and in early 2026 the building was successfully let as a mixed use café & beauty studio.

Leeds Market is one of the largest indoor markets in Europe with a wide variety of vendors and amenities.

The brand Stack and LCC have recently put forward a planning application to transform part of the outdoor market into a vibrant, two-storey container-style leisure hub featuring:

- ◇ 10 street food vendors
- ◇ 6 bars + a coffee shop
- ◇ Live music on a central stage
- ◇ Huge digital screens
- ◇ Covered plaza for all-weather

A six-storey development is soon to transform the market's George Street side, featuring a 143-room hotel, a council-run gym, and new commercial units on the ground floor.
