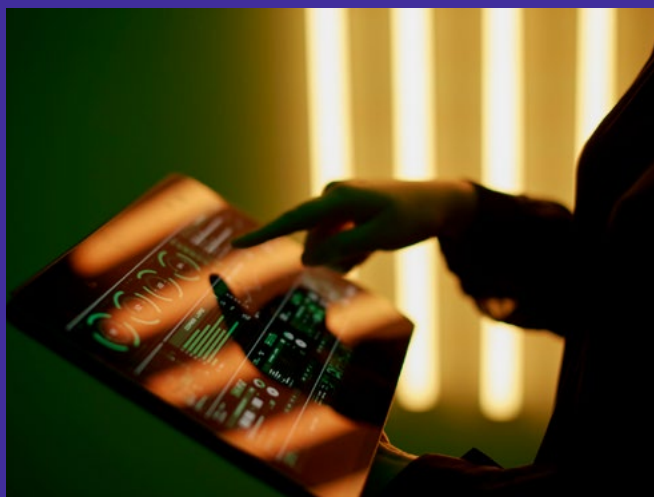

ACCESSIBILITY MATTERS



Bus

Bedford Commercial Park benefits from excellent local connectivity, with bus services linking the site to Milton Keynes, Bedford town centre and Cranfield.

Rail

Two railway stations are within close proximity (Kempston Hardwick and Stewartby), both providing direct access to Bedford and Bletchley. Nearby Bedford train station provides fast access to London with a fastest journey time of 35 minutes.

Cycle

The area also has an excellent cycle network, combined with new cycle ways in and around the park connecting with Route 51 of the National Cycle Network.
