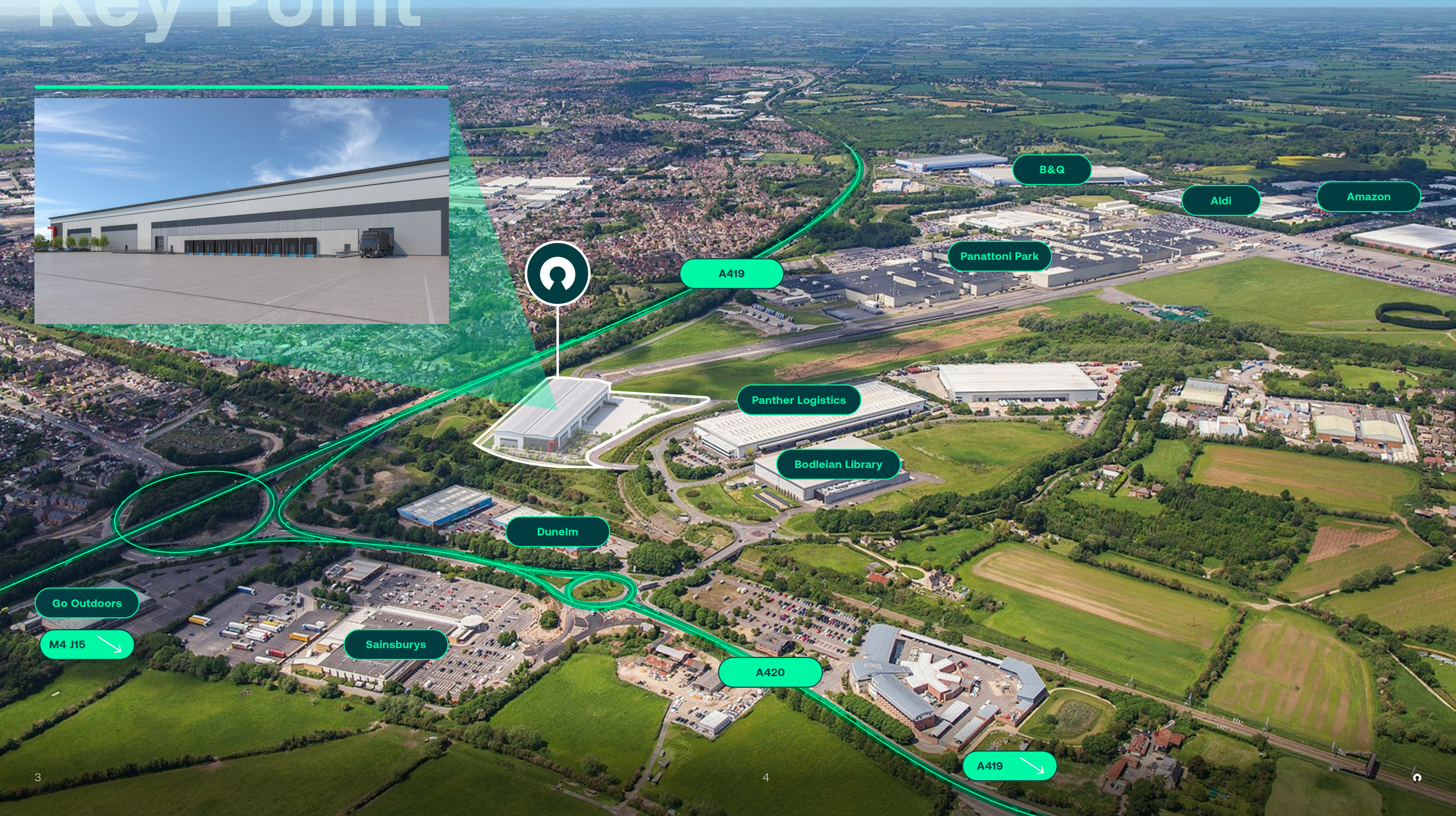
Key Point

Swindon is the principal town and commercial centre in Wiltshire, strategically positioned on the '**M4 corridor**' between London (80 miles), Bristol (37 miles), Oxford (37 miles) and Reading (44 miles). The town is **ideally located**, from a distribution perspective, for **access to London, the south west and south coast**.

Keypoint is located within the established industrial area of South Marston, on the eastern side of Swindon.

The area is home to a number of **notable occupiers**, including; Oak Furniture Land, Amazon, Iceland, B&Q, FedEx, and Aldi.

The site is situated off the intersection of the **A419 dual carriageway and A420**. The former provides direct access to the **M4 motorway** (c. 3.5 miles), while the latter provides access to the north towards Oxford.
