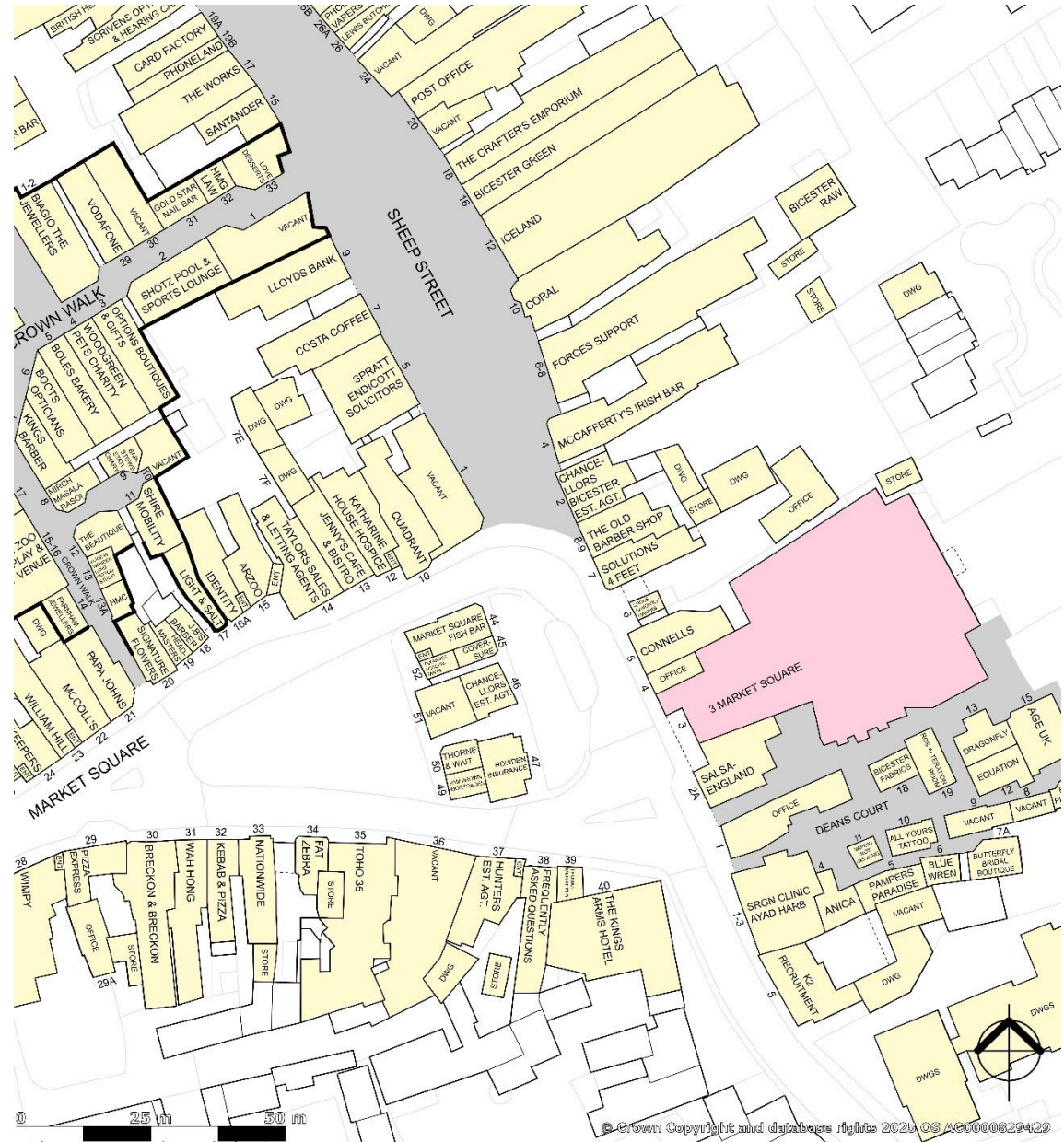

Location

3 Market Square is prominently located in the main Market Square in Bicester town centre. Bicester is located at Junction 9 of the M40 motorway and has impressive growth plans, with 10,000 new homes planned within 12 years; the population set to increase from 32,000 to 50,000+ by 2031.

Renowned for Bicester Village and its 6 million international visitors, Bicester also has excellent rail services to both London Marylebone & Paddington Stations Oxford, as well as Birmingham Snow Hill.

Description

3 Market Square comprises retail accommodation in a prominent Grade II Listed three storey period building fronting Market Square. The property benefits from a large modern rear extension over two floors providing retail sales and storage at ground floor level (17,025 sq ft) and ancillary storage to first floor (4,807 sq ft).

The rear extension also benefits from a secondary entrance, which links to the Claremont Car Park, one of Bicester's main car parking facilities, situated to the rear. The property has its own separate access road, service area and loading bay accessed off Victoria Road, with a roller shutter door for store deliveries.

To the rear are 38 car parking spaces currently let to Cherwell District Council and form part of a wider Victoria Road council run car park which provides a total of 159 additional surface car parking spaces.

Market Place Bicester – A 'Multi Million Pound' Enhancement Initiative

Market Square in Bicester comprises part of Cherwell District Council's 'multi-million pound' redevelopment and enhancement initiative in conjunction with the new Local Plan 2042. The project illustrates the Council's commitment to enhancing both the town centre and Bicester's long-term evolution.
