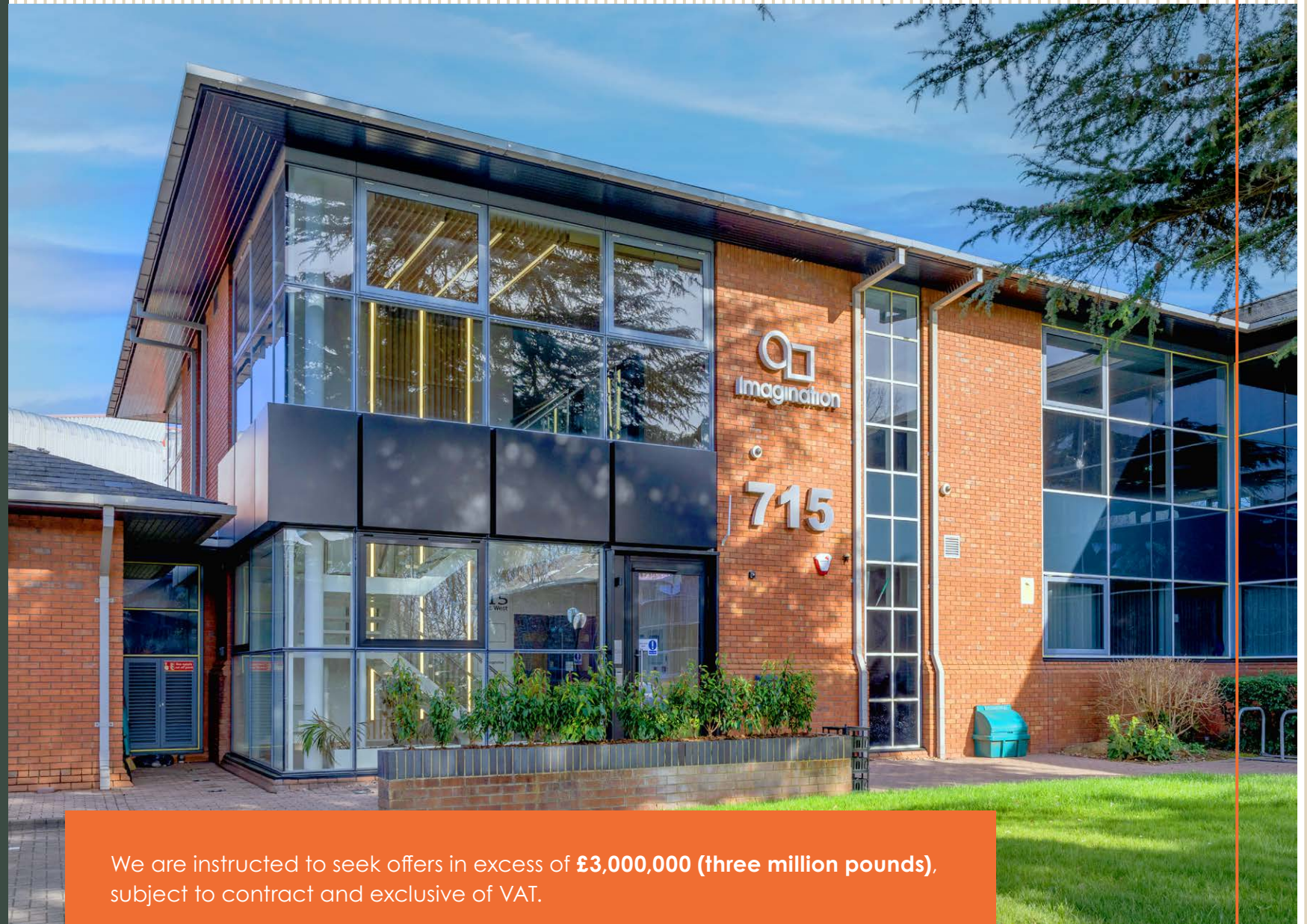

Bristol

Economically, Bristol is one of the UK's fastest growing cities and is globally recognised as a leading destination for digital and tech industries. It's also one of the best places to live and work in the UK, according to PwC's 2024 Good Growth for Cities Index. In 2024, Bristol was named the Best Place to visit in the UK by TimeOut and ranked the second most liveable city in the UK by the Daily Telegraph. Additionally, a BBC Newsbeat analysis ranked it as the best place to live in the UK outside London for people under the age of 26.

Rich in history and culture, Bristol is home to two prestigious universities: the University of Bristol and the University of the West of England. The city has one of the highest student retention rates in the UK, with many graduates choosing to stay post-graduation. Over 30,000 students attend the University of Bristol, and more than 39,000 are enrolled at the University of the West of England. Bristol's population includes a high proportion of adults aged 25-44, and young adults aged 15-24 are also well-represented, reflecting the large student population.

This strong academic foundation contributes to Bristol being a significant economic hub in the West of England, with a high concentration of jobs and businesses. The employment rate in Bristol in March 2025 was 77.6% which is the second highest employment rate versus the GB Core Cities and well above the national rate (75.4%).

Bristol has an estimated population of 483,000, which is projected to exceed 500,000 by the early 2030s

Over the decade 2014–2024, Bristol had the 3rd largest percentage population increase of the Core Cities in England and Wales. Bristol's population grew by an estimated 50,600 people, an 11.4% increase

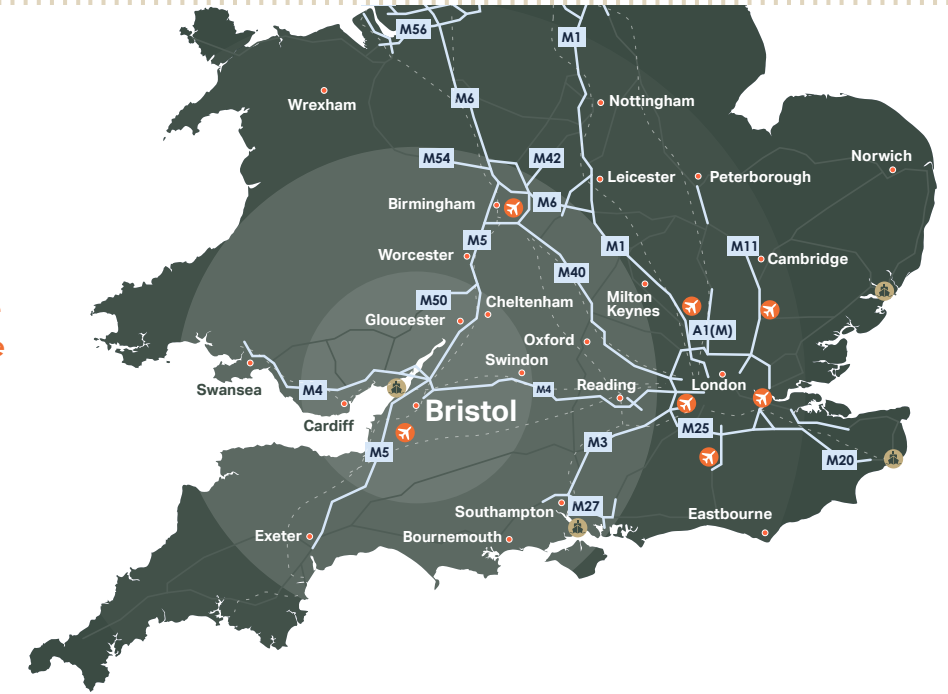

Situation

Aztec West is Bristol's premier business park. Covering an expansive 152 acres, it is the most established out-of-town office location in the South West, making it a top choice for businesses. The park can be easily accessed off the A38, approximately 5 minutes to Junction 16 of the M5, and Bristol City Centre is approximately 8 miles to the south.

The park continues to attract and retain major occupiers, including Virgin Media, Edvance, National Highways, Rheinmetall, Kuehne + Nagel and Allianz, as well as numerous house builders including Barratt Homes, Bellway and David Wilson.

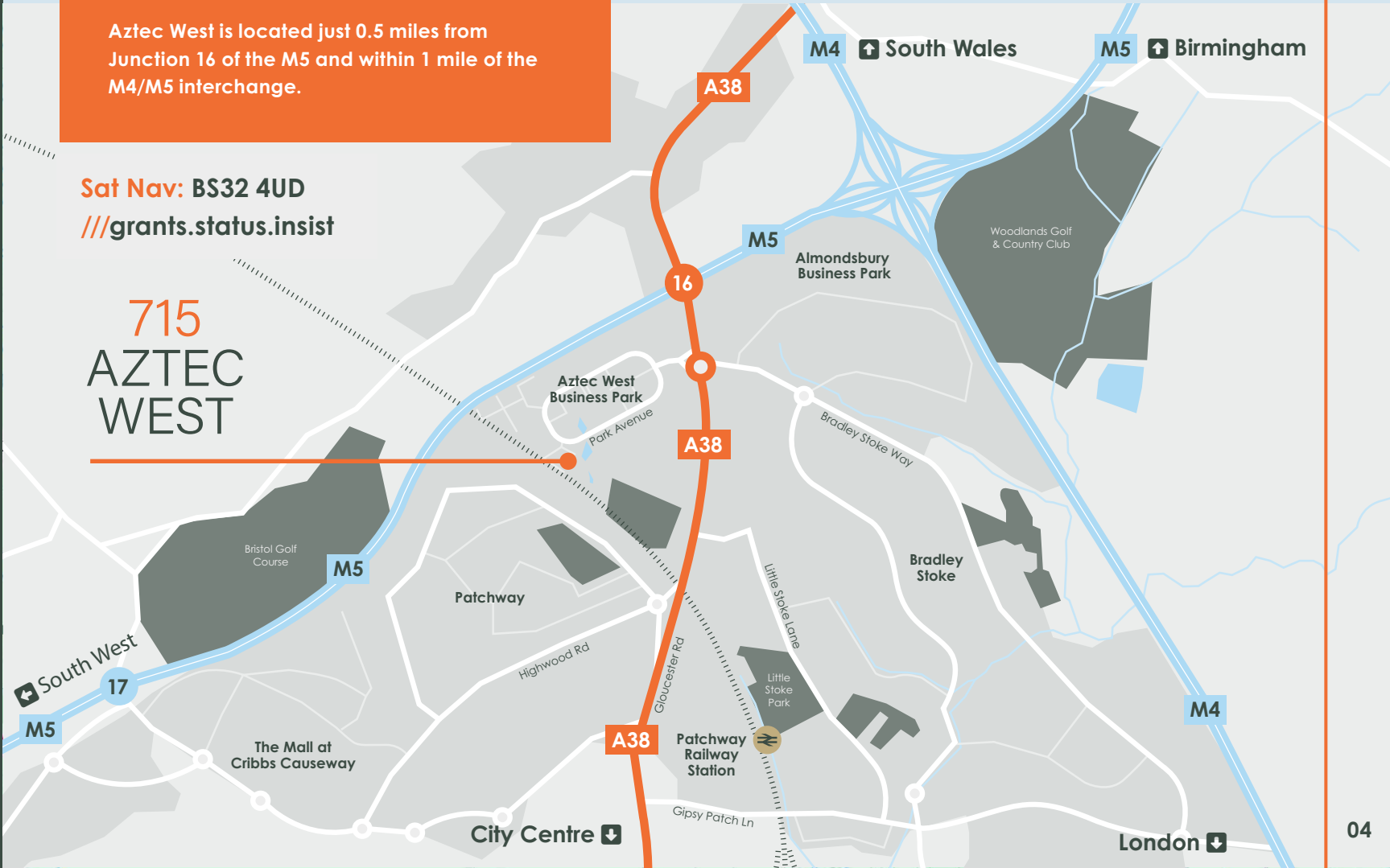

Occupational Market

EDF have recently re-committed their long-term future to Aztec West, agreeing a 15 year lease at the 80,000 sq ft, back-to-frame £17m refit of 1000 Aztec West, the South West's first Net Zero Carbon out-of-town HQ office.

This marked a significant milestone for the Bristol out-of-town office market, establishing a new prime rent record of £26.74 per sq ft. This 7% increase over the previous prime rent highlights the growing demand and competition for high-quality, sustainable office spaces in out-of-town locations.

Despite a new prime rent being achieved, Bristol out-of-town rents remain considerably lower than City Centre rates. With prime City Centre rents now reaching £50.00 per sq ft, there remains a significant differential of almost 47%.

The delivery of new Grade A supply remained constrained. The development of these spaces has continued to illustrate the strength in demand for high quality space, illustrated by the lettings of 1000 Aztec West (80,000 sq ft) to EDF and 100A Bristol Business Park (78,000 sq ft) to Rolls Royce.





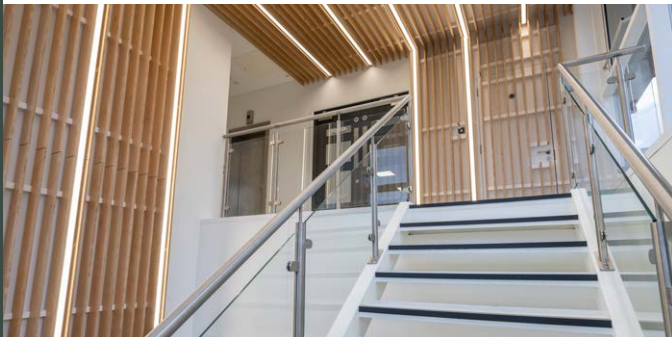
Description

The property comprises an early 1990's, modern two-storey office building of steel portal frame construction, arranged under a pitched, tiled roof. There is a further self-contained one-storey link building, arranged as an open plan office.








The property was extensively refurbished in 2014, which included replacement of all mechanical and electrical services. A further refurbishment took place in 2023 to the 1st floor and all communal areas of the main office building.



Externally the property benefits from a generous parking provision for 79 cars, equating to an excellent parking ratio of 1:223 sq ft. The property has a site area of 1.05 acres.

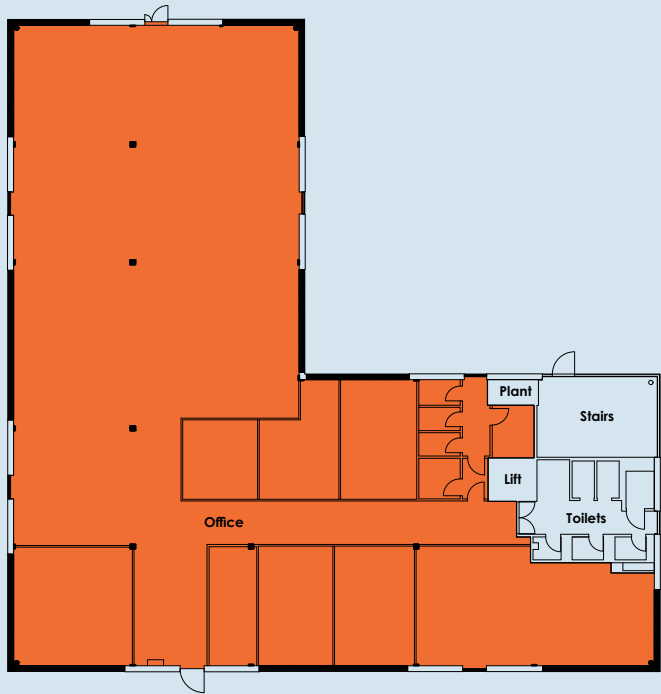

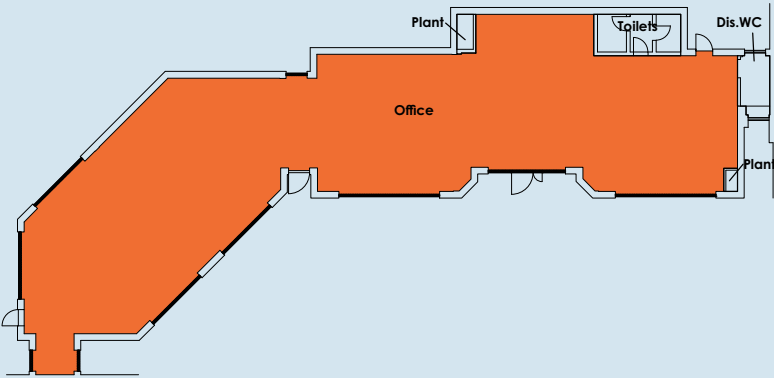


First floor office

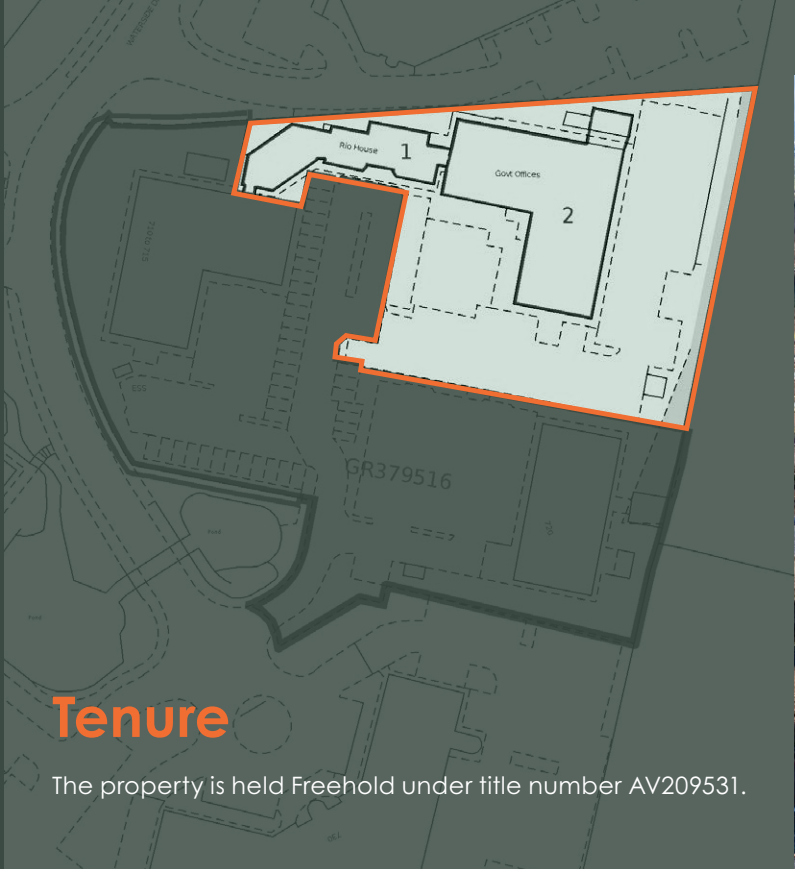

Imagination Technologies Limited is a British semiconductor and software design company headquartered in Kings Langley, England.

Founded in 1985 as VideoLogic, the company initially focused on graphics, sound acceleration, home audio systems, video capture, and video conferencing systems. The company rebranded as Imagination Technologies in 1999, shifting its focus to intellectual property (IP) licensing.

Imagination Technologies is currently owned by Canyon Bridge Capital Partners, a private equity fund based in Beijing. The company specializes in creating and licensing processor solutions for graphics, computing, and AI processing. Their IP is used in a wide range of products globally, including phones, cars, and home devices.

Miller Homes Limited

Miller Homes Limited is a well-established UK-based housebuilding company founded in 1934, and is one of the UK's largest national homebuilders.

In 2021 the company was acquired by an American asset management firm, Apollo Global Management, in a deal thought to be worth £1.3 billion.

Miller Homes have 11 regional offices and have 90 sites operating across three divisions - Scotland, North, and Midlands and South.

There is the potential to surrender the lease and relet this floor at a higher rent.

The most recent open market letting at the building was of the first floor to Miller Homes Limited at a rent of £20.33 per sq ft. This reflects a rental uplift on the current rent of the ground floor of c.10% (£1.82 per sq ft).
