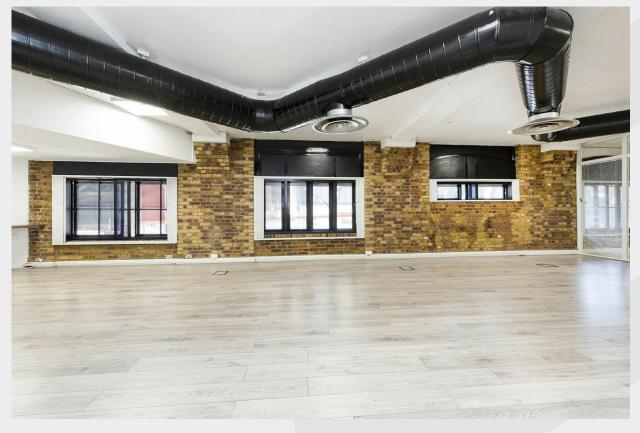
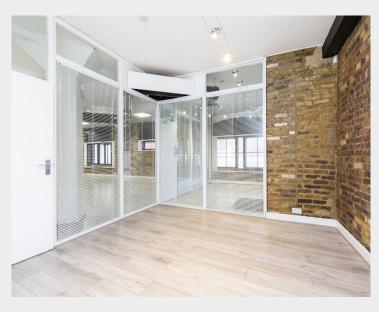


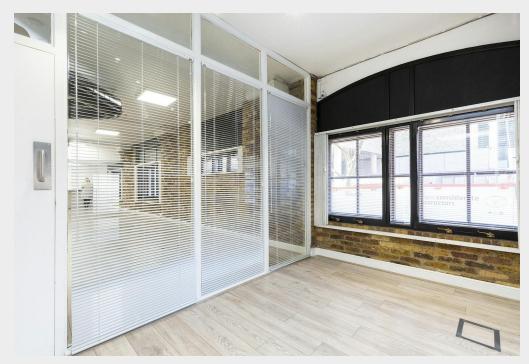
Ground floor E Class office in a converted warehouse with parking

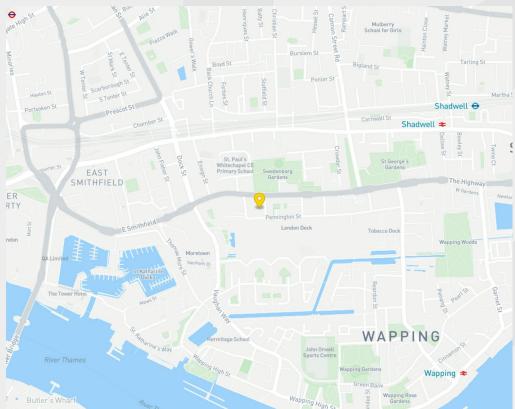


Description
