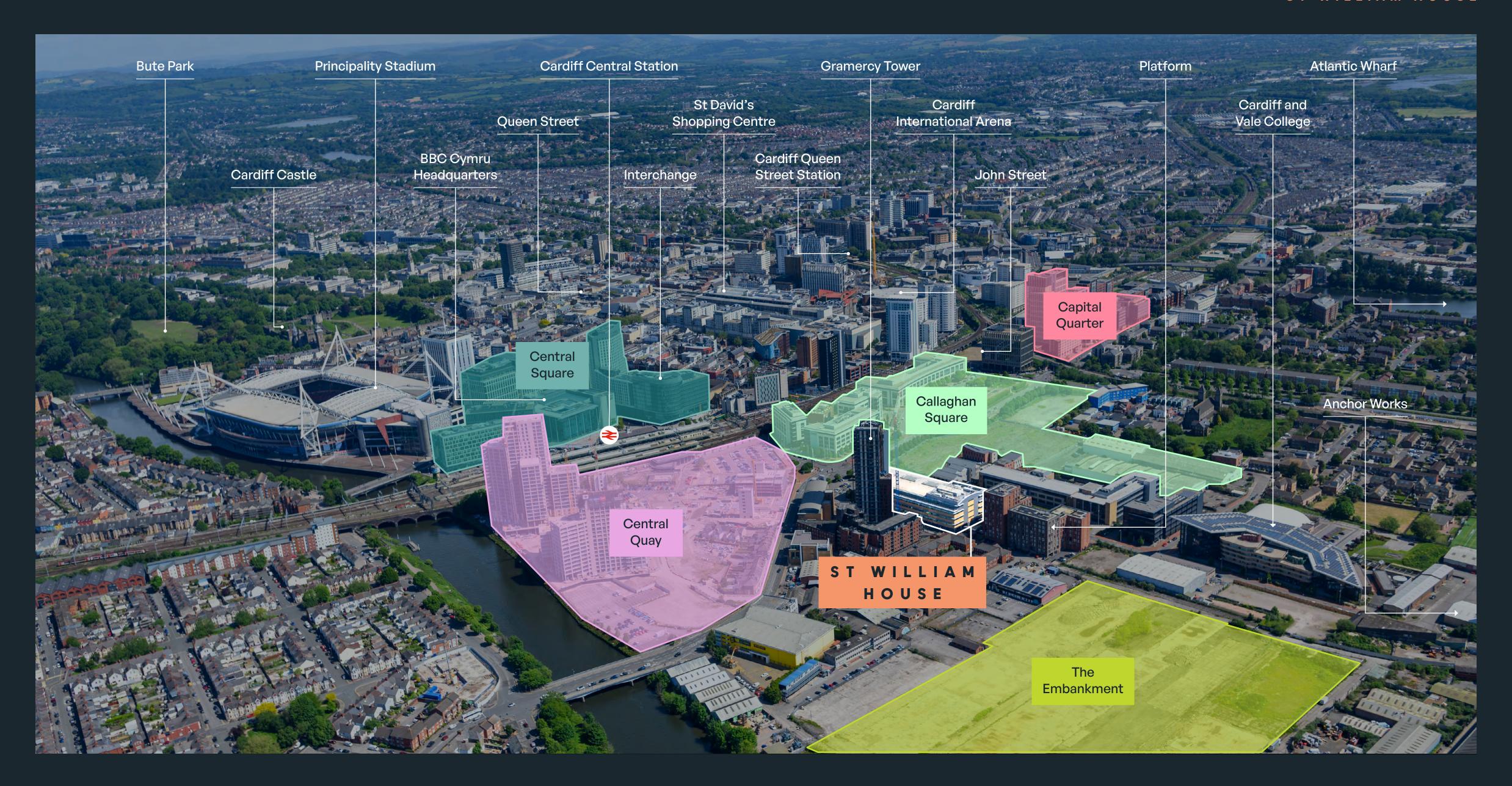




THE OPPORTUNITY

- Opportunity to lease or purchase the headquarter office building in the heart of Cardiff city centre.
- Cardiff is Wales' capital city, the closest European capital city to London and one of the top tier regional centres in the UK.
- Located within a 1 minute walk of Cardiff Central Station and close proximity to the prime retail core of St David's Shopping Centre and the flagship John Lewis store.
- It is opposite Central Quay, which is a significant 3 million sq ft mixed-use regeneration project, incorporating residential, office, leisure as well as a new metro station and multi storey car park.
- St William House is a landmark office building forming part of the greater Callaghan Square office core and is strongly visible from Cardiff station
- Extending to 144,000 sq ft over five storeys with open plan,
 flexible floor plates and secure undercroft car park.
- The strategic location provides potential for a conversion for alternative use, subject to planning.



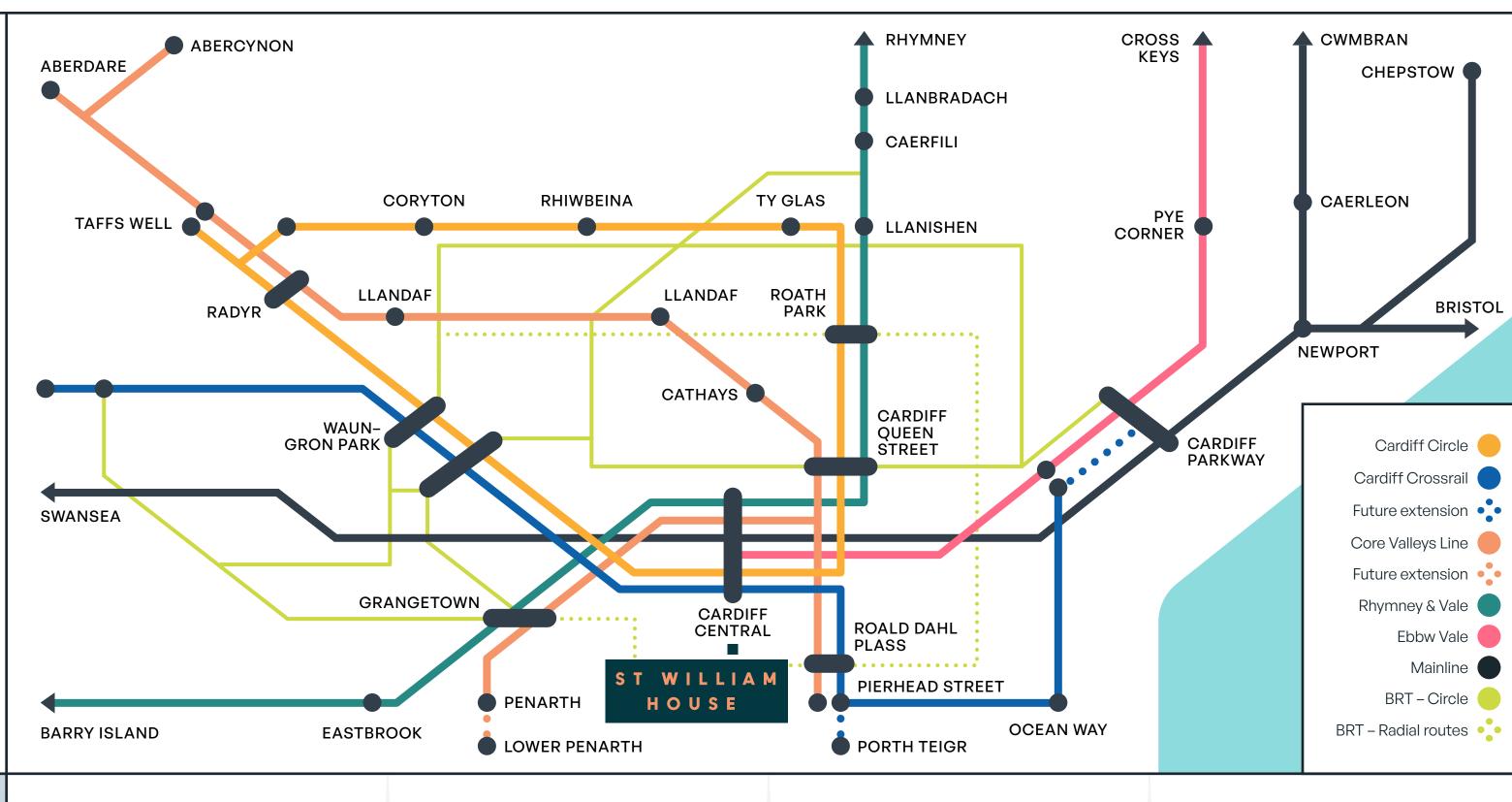
CONNECTIVITY

The South Wales Metro

The £734m Metro project will improve the city's connectivity via additional rail and public transport services across South Wales, with a focus on central Cardiff. As part of the UK Government's levelling-up scheme, an additional £50m in funding has been secured to deliver a new rail line, connecting Cardiff Central Station to Cardiff Bay.

Cardiff is set to be at the core of the South Wales Metro, which is being designed to improve the public transport options across Cardiff and the wider region.

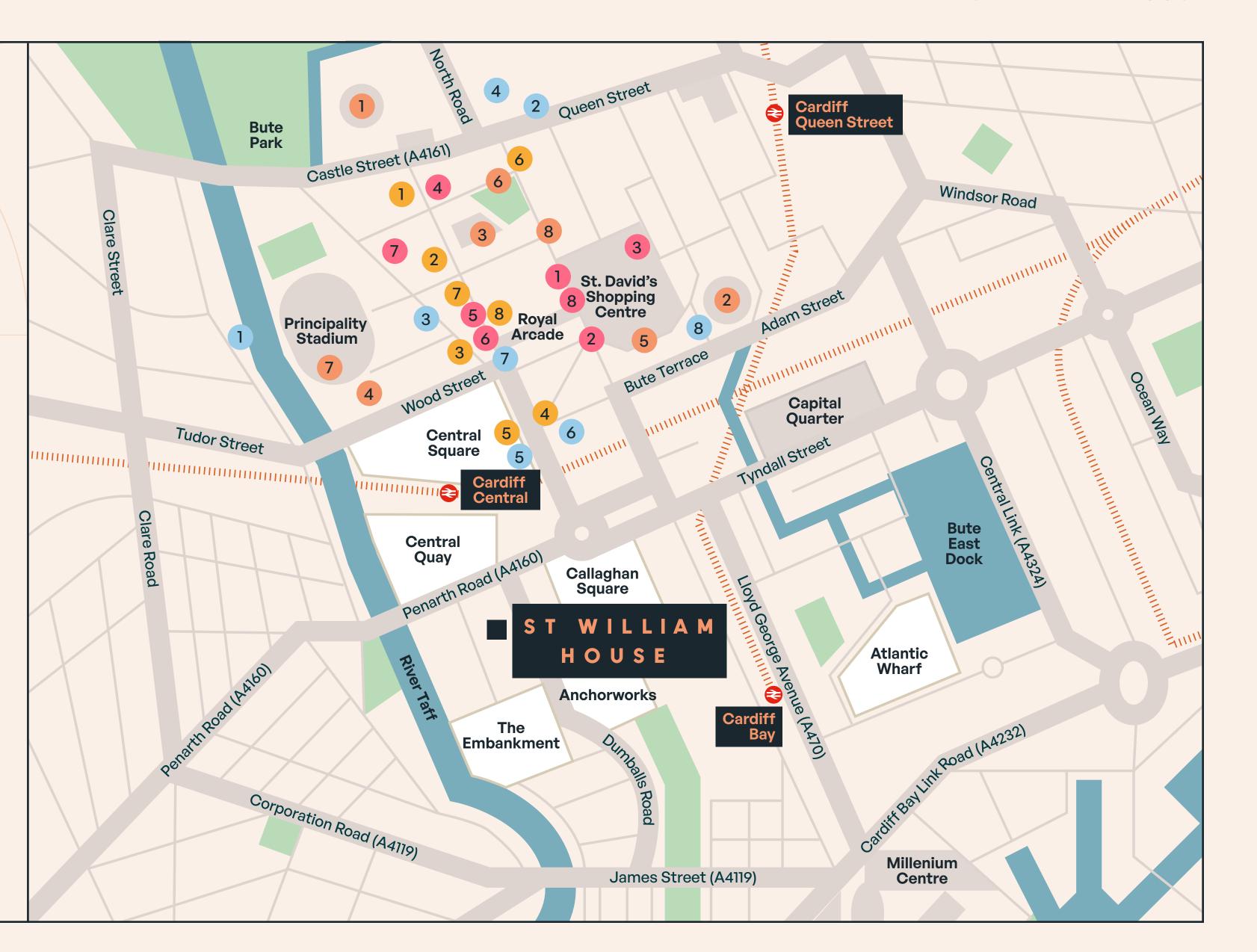

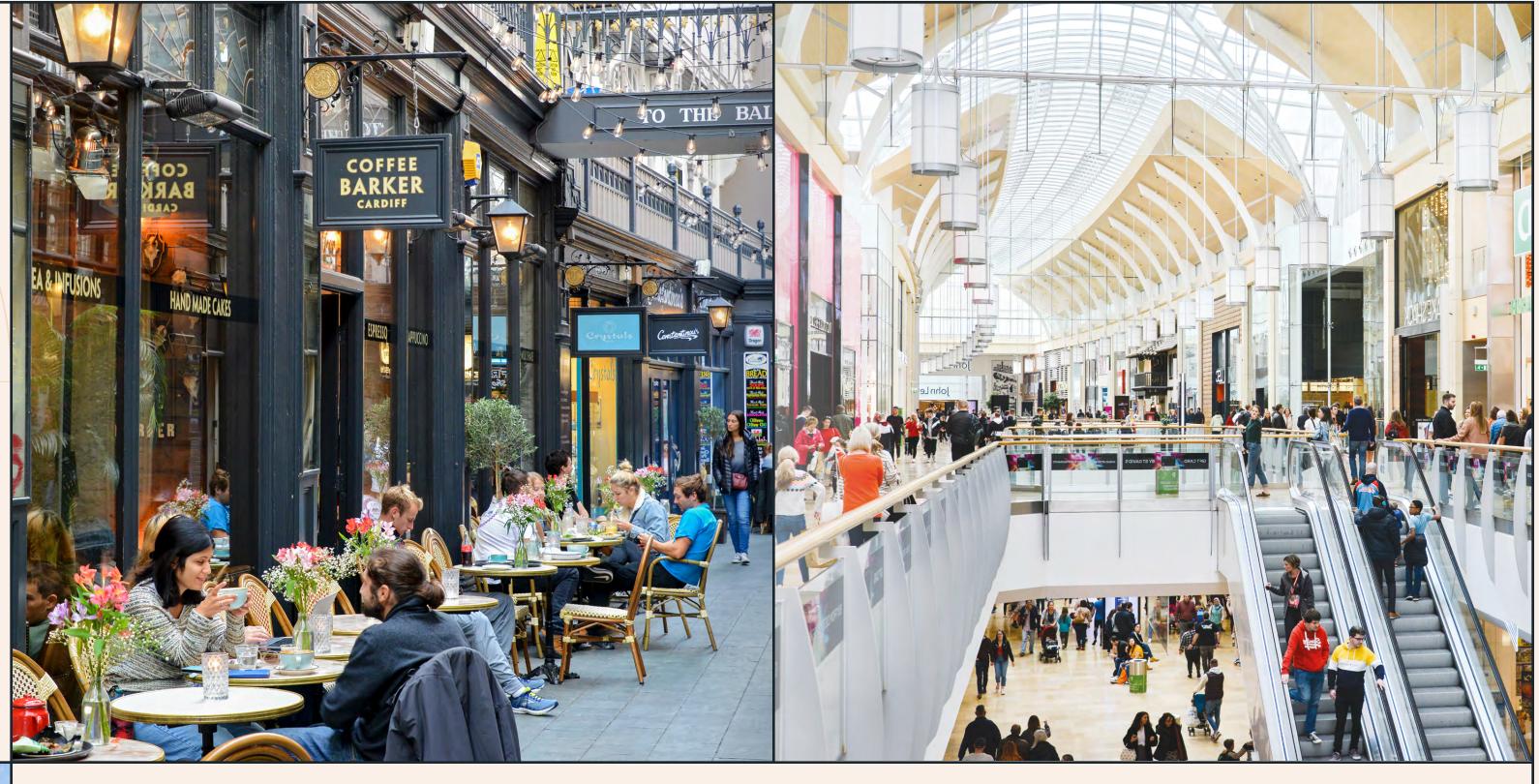
LOCATION & AMENITY

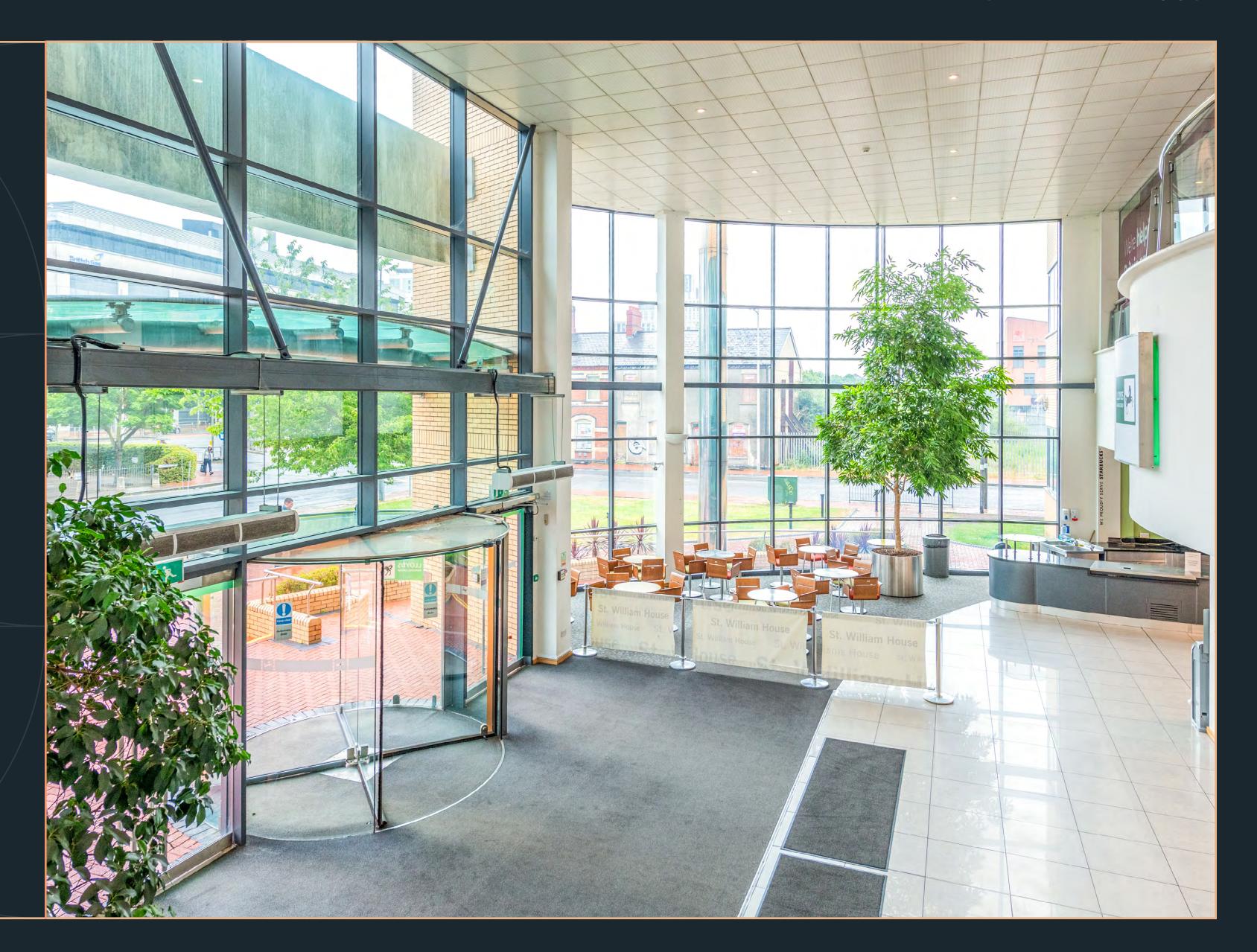

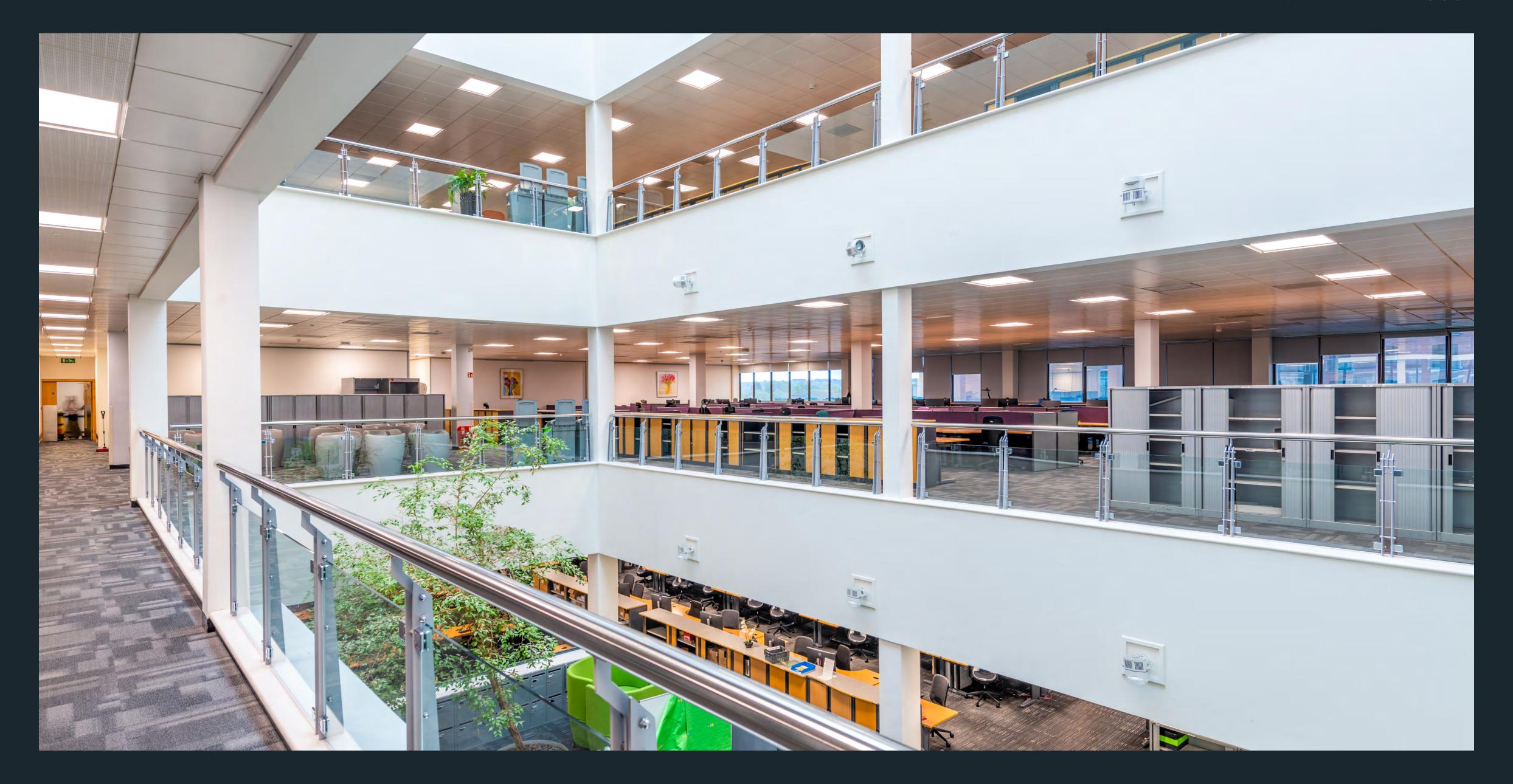
THE DESCRIPTION

City centre HQ building

St William House comprises a 144,000 sq ft detached headquarter office building over 5 floors. Boasting a generous sized reception with two storey atrium and extensive glazing provides an impressive welcome to the building, which currently offers a tenant coffee shop facility, informal seating areas as well as a designated reception desk and speed gates.

A feature stair links the ground and first floors and the two impressive full height atriums in the centre of the building provide plenty of natural light throughout the building.

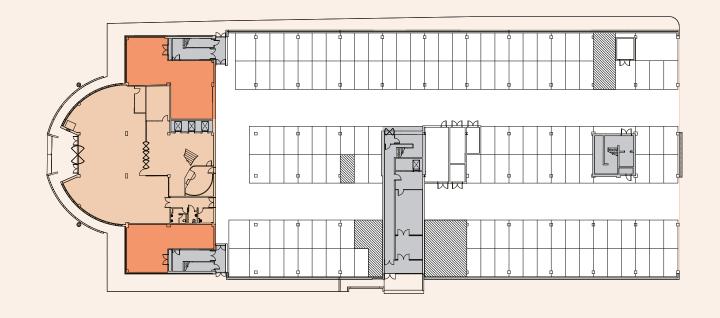

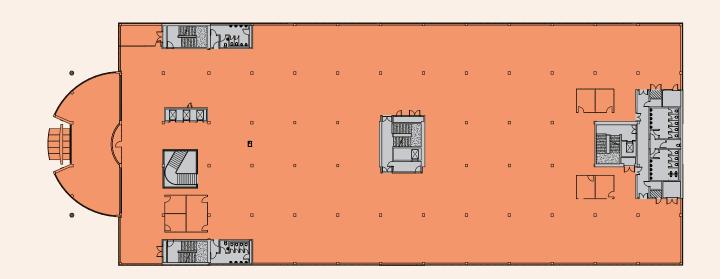

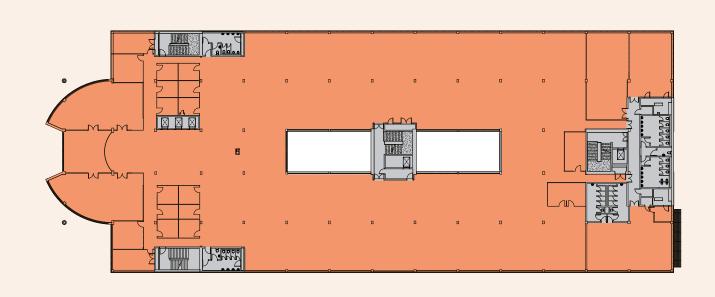
FIRST FLOOR

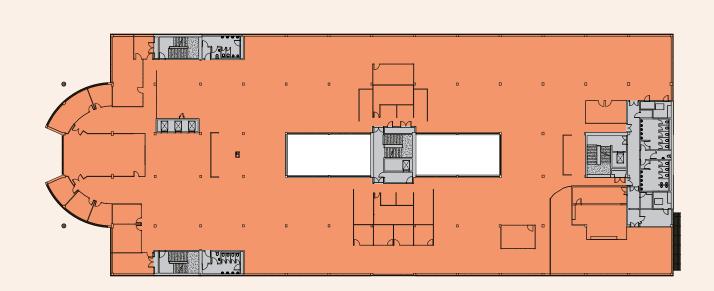
SECOND FLOOR

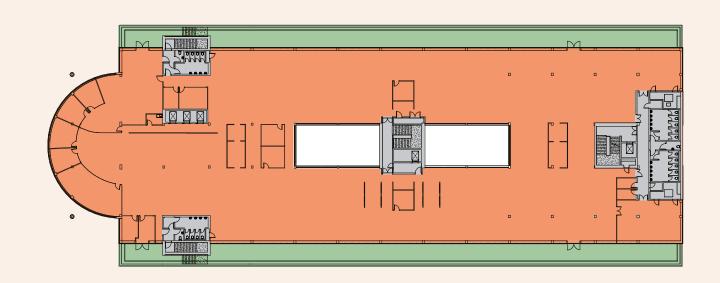
THIRD FLOOR

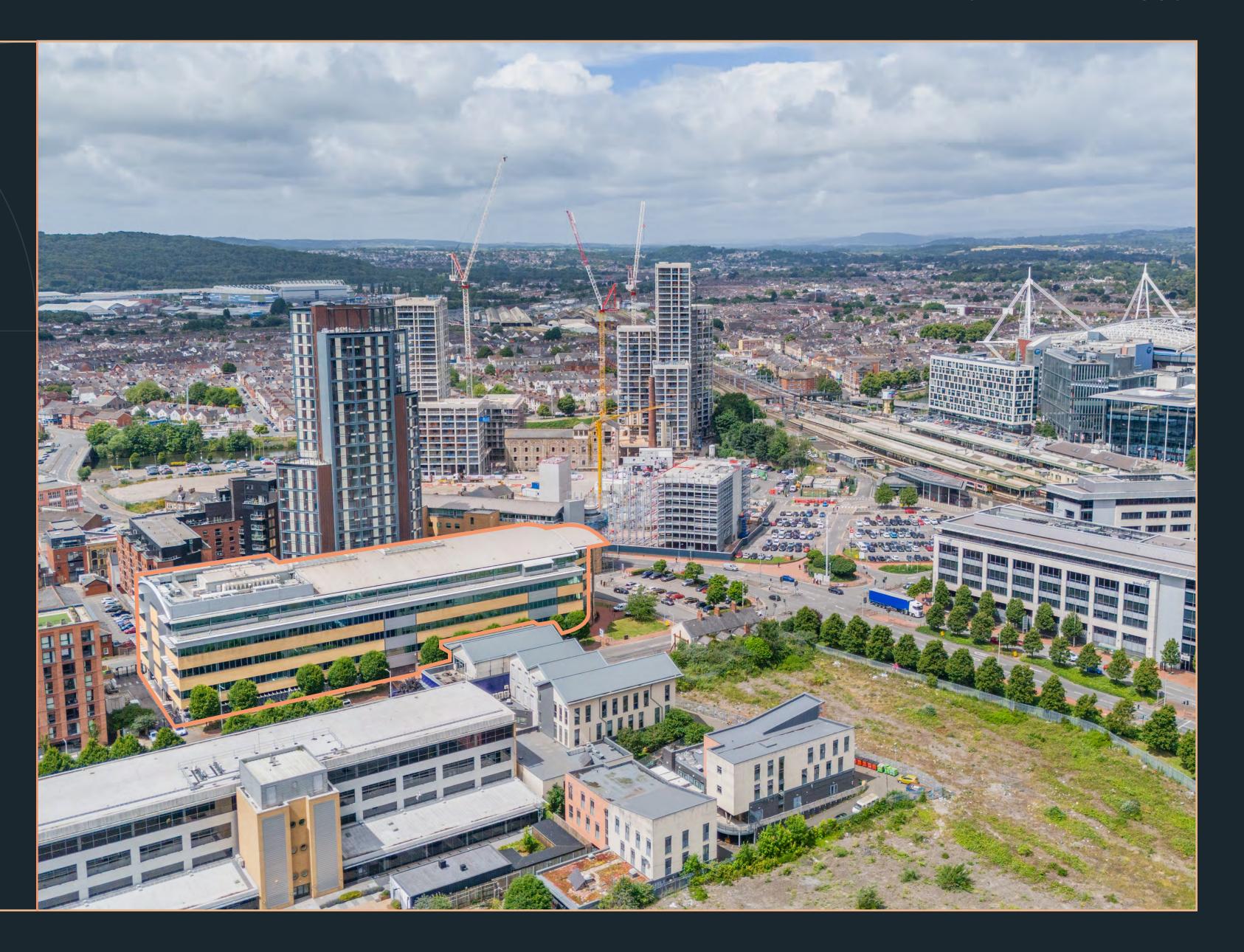
