The offices benefit from excellent accessibility, with both a private, exclusive side entrance and an impressive communal front entrance. Shared WC facilities are available, and the accommodation is further enhanced by six allocated on-site parking spaces, making it an ideal opportunity for a range of professional occupiers.




# Location

Mercury House is located within the Creative Quarter of Shrewsbury Business Park, widely regarded as the county's premier office destination. 
