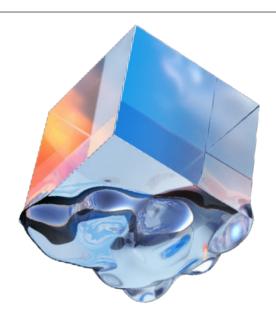

Paddington is evolving, with new business, residents and infrastructure arriving every year. They're all drawn by the neighbourhood's historic charisma and central location. Paddington has been a hub of innovation since the 19th century, when the construction of the Paddington Basin in 1801 opened London to commerce and cultural exchange via the Grand Union Canal, and Isambard Kingdom Brunel unveiled Paddington Station some 50 years later: an immense project far ahead of its time. It was here too in St Mary's Hospital on Praed St that Alexander Fleming discovered penicillin.

The neighbourhood has been evolving and leading the way ever since, with more than £5bn invested in the area in the last three decades alone. Today, global brands from Microsoft and Vodafone to Visa and Sony continue this tradition of forward-thinking, working alongside the scores of independent businesses that thrive in the historic area – be it the journalist-hangout Frontline Club or independent media firms like Monocle.

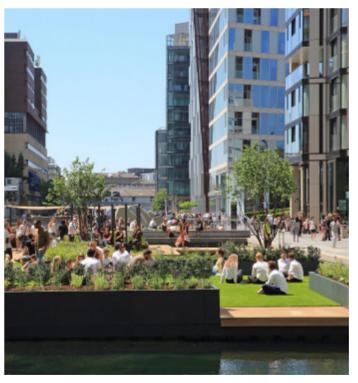

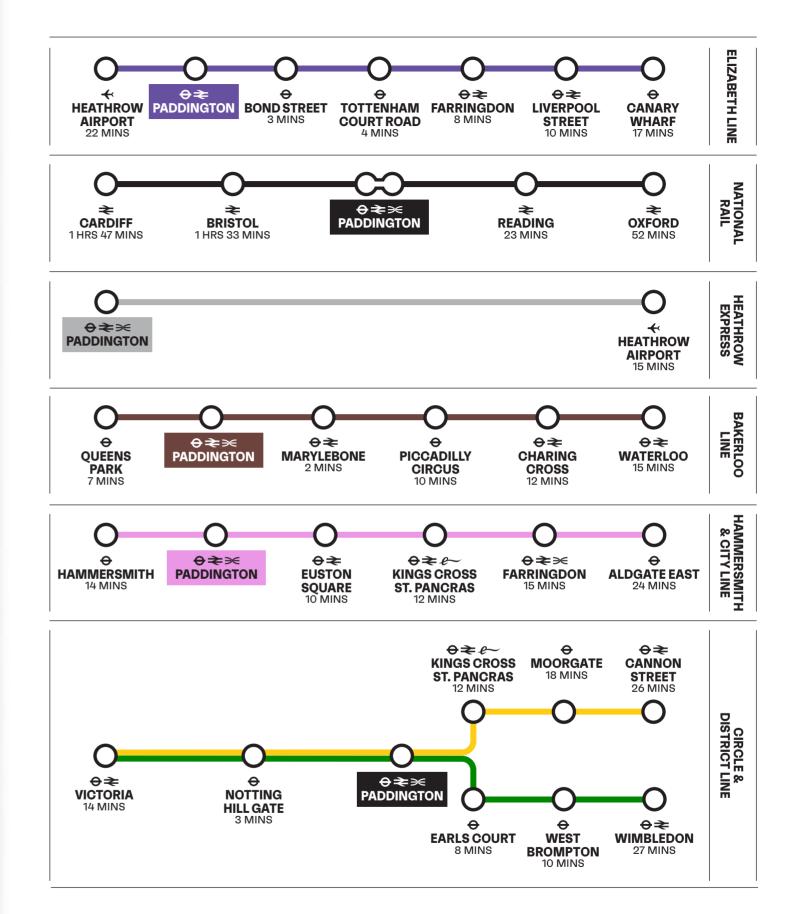

Paddington Square not only benefits from this infrastructure but expands and improves it. The development is integrated into Paddington station and brings with it a new Bakerloo Line ticket hall, meaning fast and secure travel from platform to desk in minutes.

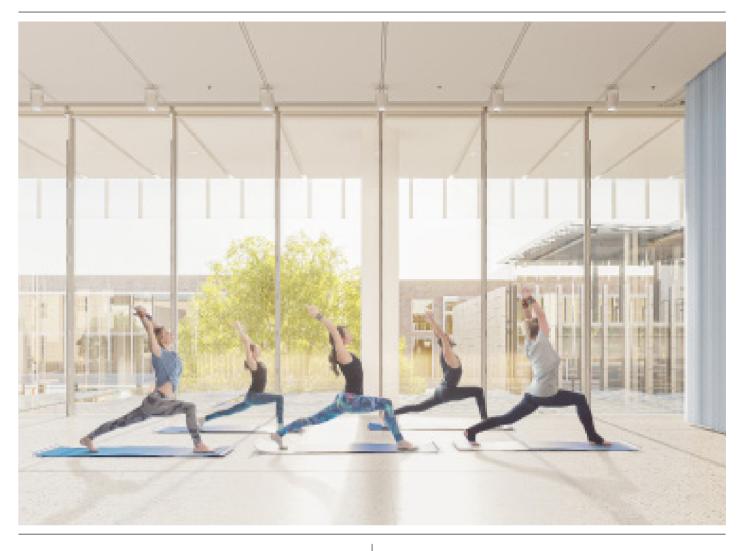
AN ACTIVE BUILDING FOR ACTIVE MINDS

Paddington Square's commitment to wellbeing and empowering individuals doesn't stop at The Exchange.

Features such as smart light metres, floor-to-ceiling windows with low-iron glass, allowing for more natural light and sweeping views of London – keeping people vitalised and in sync with the outside world.

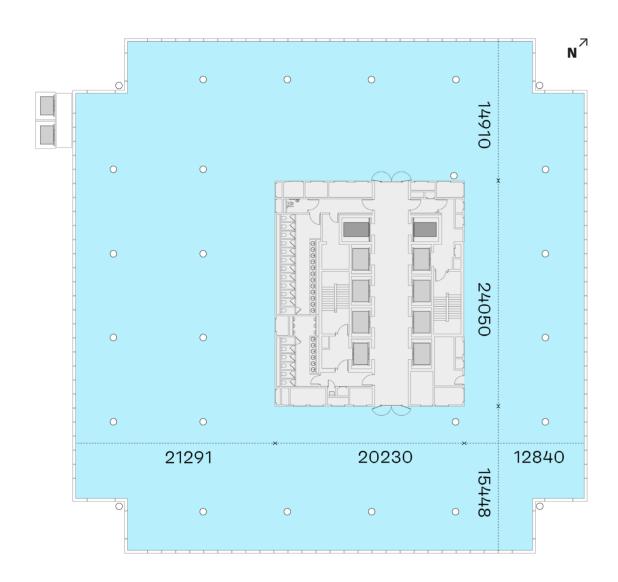




LEVEL 3-5 FLOORPLAN

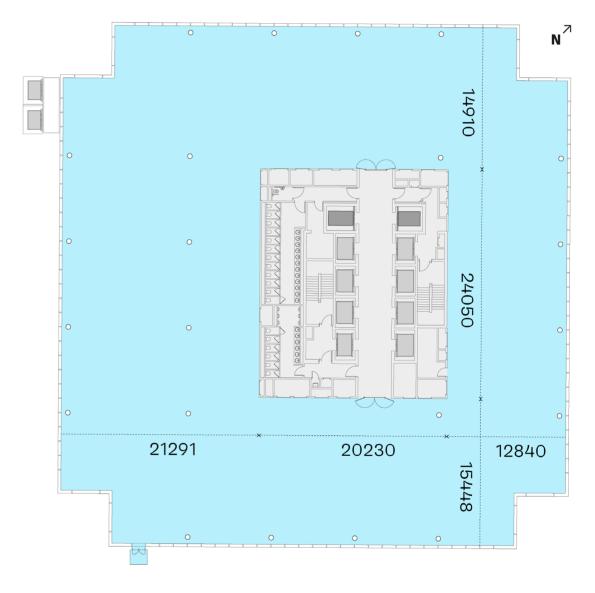

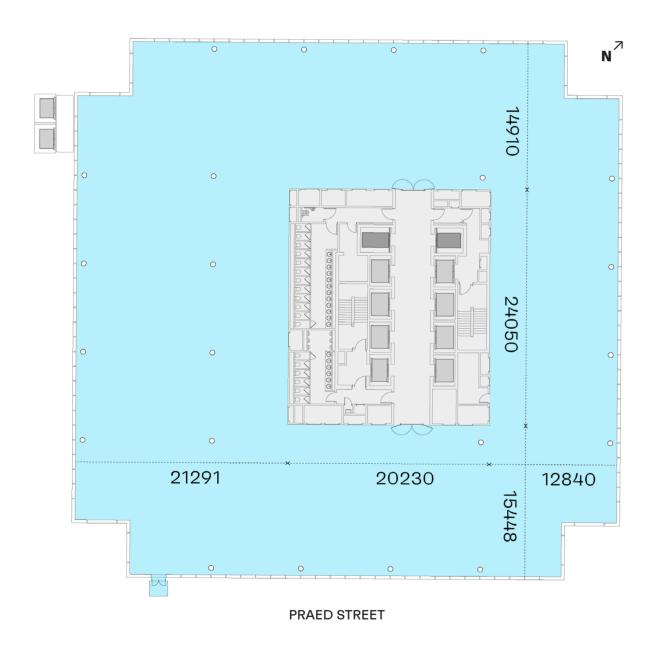

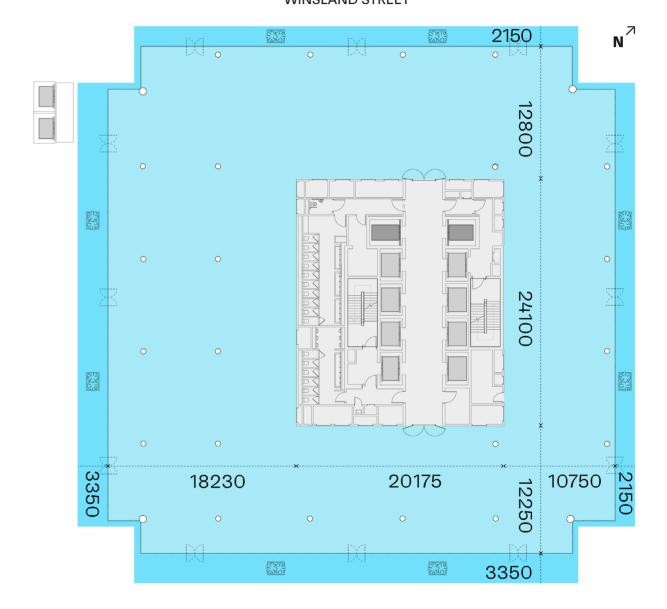

LEVEL 4 SPACE PLAN

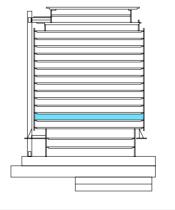

LEVEL 7 SPACE PLAN

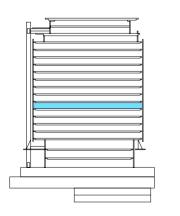
