The Roost, the communal clubroom and garden located on the 14th floor, provides an inspirational space for the building's occupiers to freely use.

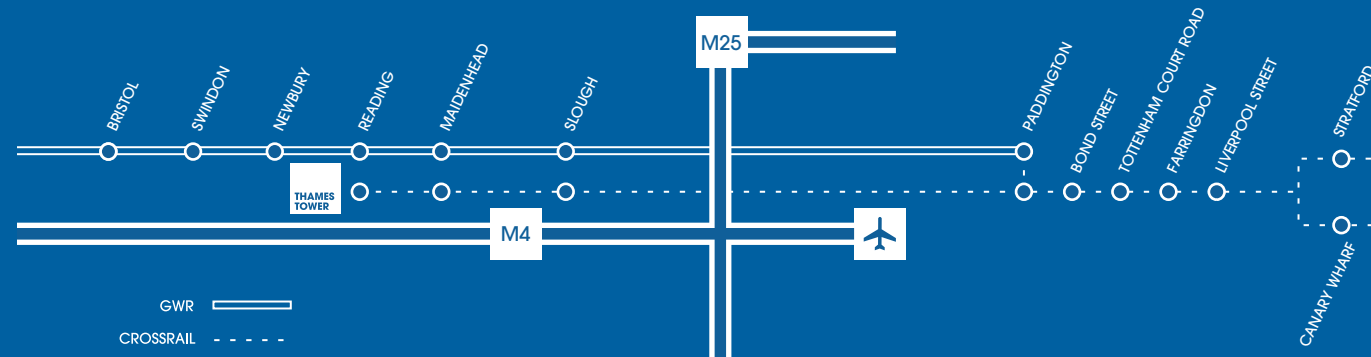

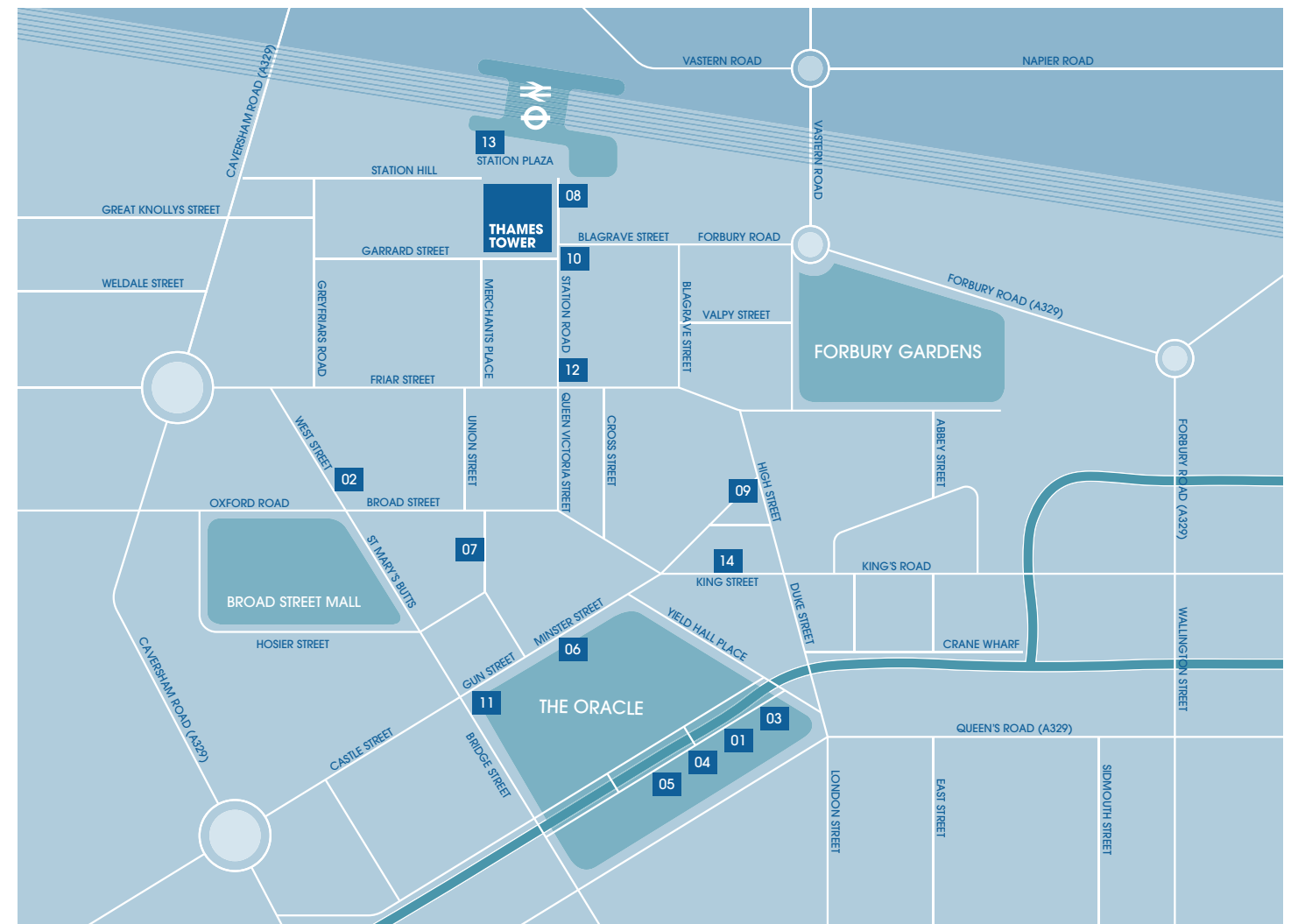
Reading is located within easy access from the M4 at three junctions and further connections to the national motorway network and the M25.

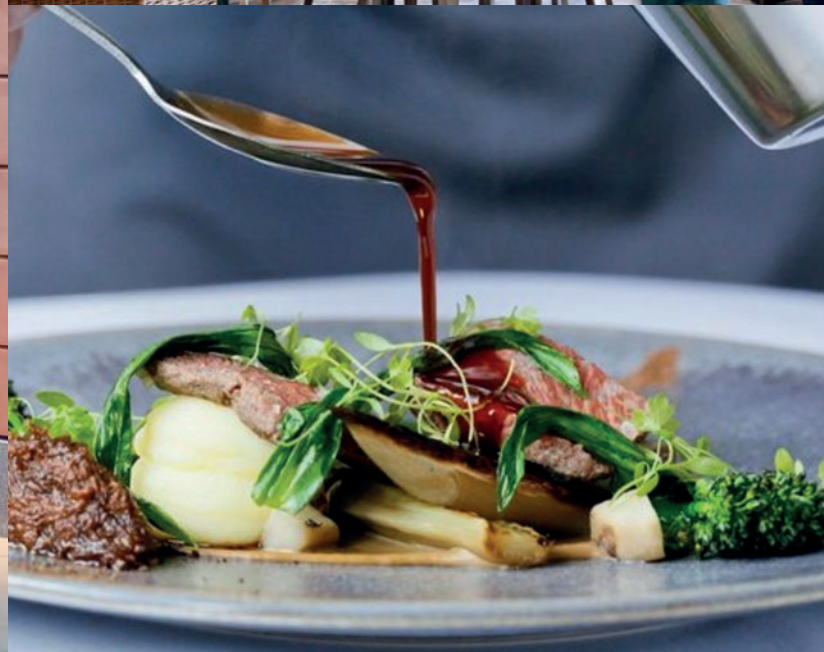
