- Situated on a prominent site within North Walsham's established industrial area, and adjacent to Waitrose Supermarket; **approximately 15 miles north of Norwich**, with excellent access to the A149 and A140, serving the wider Norfolk region.

- **Low site coverage of approximately 12%**.

Location

Norfolk is a key economic region in the East of England, with a population of over 916,000 and a diverse economy spanning agriculture, manufacturing, logistics, energy, and tourism (Source: ONS Norfolk). The county benefits from its strategic location, offering access to major UK markets while maintaining strong links to Europe via the Port of Felixstowe and regional airports.

Norfolk's economy is supported by significant infrastructure investment and housing growth. The Norfolk Local Plans collectively target the delivery of more than 100,000 new homes by 2038, with major allocations across Greater Norwich, North Norfolk, and the coastal belt. This expansion underpins demand for construction materials, trade services, and commercial space, creating opportunities for businesses serving both residential and infrastructure sectors.

Norfolk also benefits from a thriving tourism economy, attracting 7.5 million visitors annually (visitnorfolk) to its coastline, Broads National Park, and historic market towns. This seasonal influx supports retail, hospitality, and leisure sectors, complementing the county's viable property development.

Connectivity

North Walsham is a key town in the northeast of Norfolk, benefiting from excellent transport links and a broad catchment area extending 20–30 miles, including, Norwich, Cromer, Sheringham, Burnham Market, and surrounding locations.

Strategic road links include the A11 and A47, providing direct access to Cambridge, London, and the Midlands, while the A140 and A149 connect Norfolk's market towns and coastal destinations. Rail services from Norwich deliver fast connections to London Liverpool Street (approximately 1 hour 50 minutes), Cambridge, and Ipswich. Norwich International Airport offers domestic and European flights, and the Port of Felixstowe is 62 miles to the south.

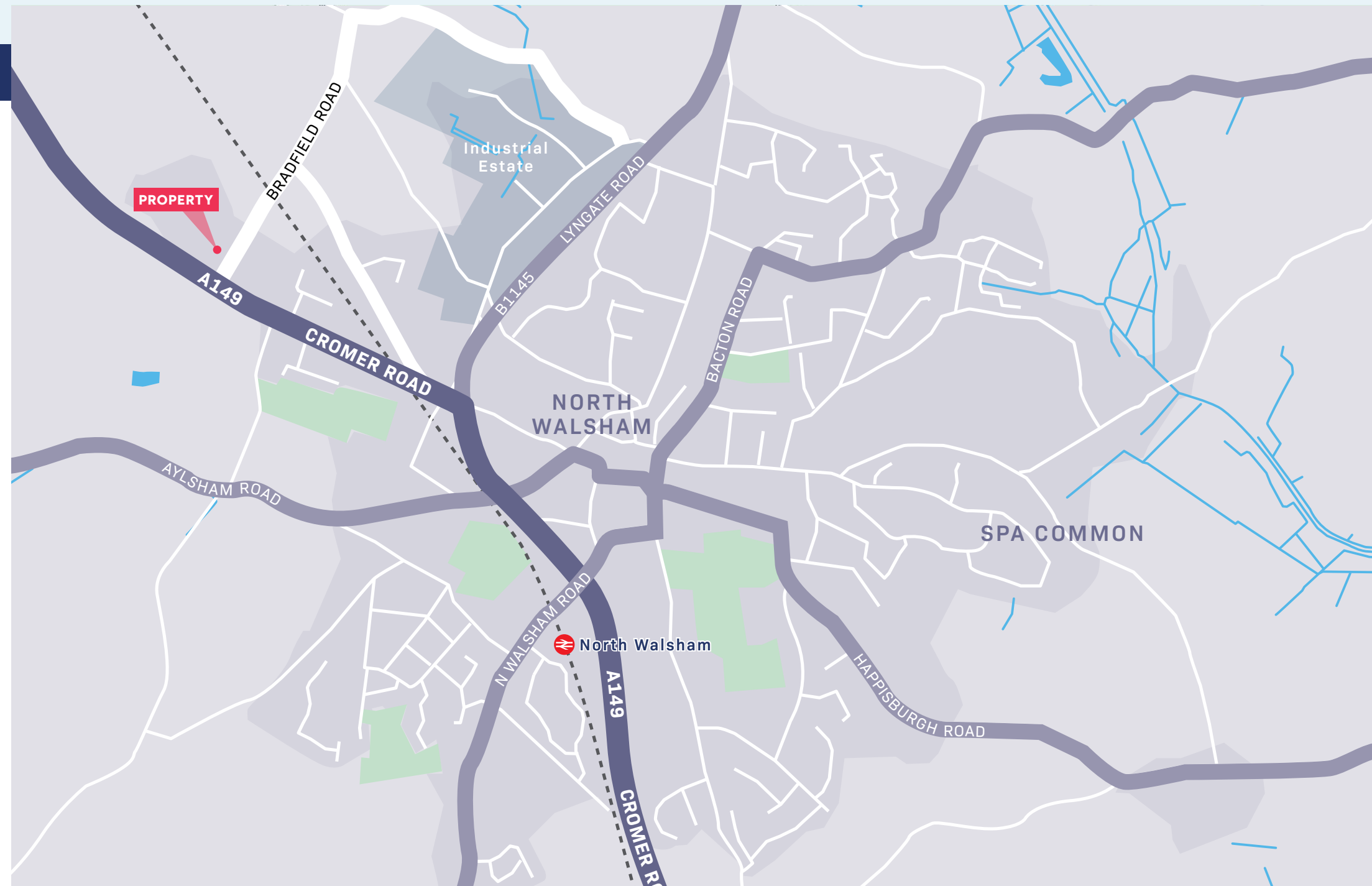

Situation

North Walsham is the largest settlement in North Norfolk, with a population of approximately 12,800, and acts as the principal commercial centre for the district. The town offers strong local amenities and a well-established retail and trade presence, with the MKM branch serving as a leading builders' merchant supporting coastal development.

The property is positioned around 18 miles north of Norwich, 8 miles southeast of Cromer, and 25 miles northwest of Great Yarmouth, providing excellent access to regional hubs. MKM's catchment area spans 20–30 miles, drawing customers from across North Norfolk.

North Walsham's role as a regional hub is reinforced by a diverse mix of national and independent businesses, including Waitrose, Sainsbury's, Toolstation, and Screwfix, catering to both local residents and the wider rural economy.



Description

The building was originally built in 2014 and then was substantially refurbished in 2022 to provide the completed specification below. The property comprises a purpose-built trade counter unit, with a large yard.

- Clear internal height of 6.26m
- Secure, fully concreted yard with perimeter fencing (2.4m) and gated entrance
- 3 Level access loading doors
- 100KVA 3 phase electricity supply
- Floor loading to 30 KN per sq m
- Mezzanine floor loading 7.2 KN per sq m
- Internal LED lighting and external LED floodlighting
- 32 customer parking spaces (including 3 disabled spaces) and 12 staff car parking spaces.

Accommodation

The property has been measured in accordance with the RICS Code of Measuring Practice (6th Edition) on a gross internal area.

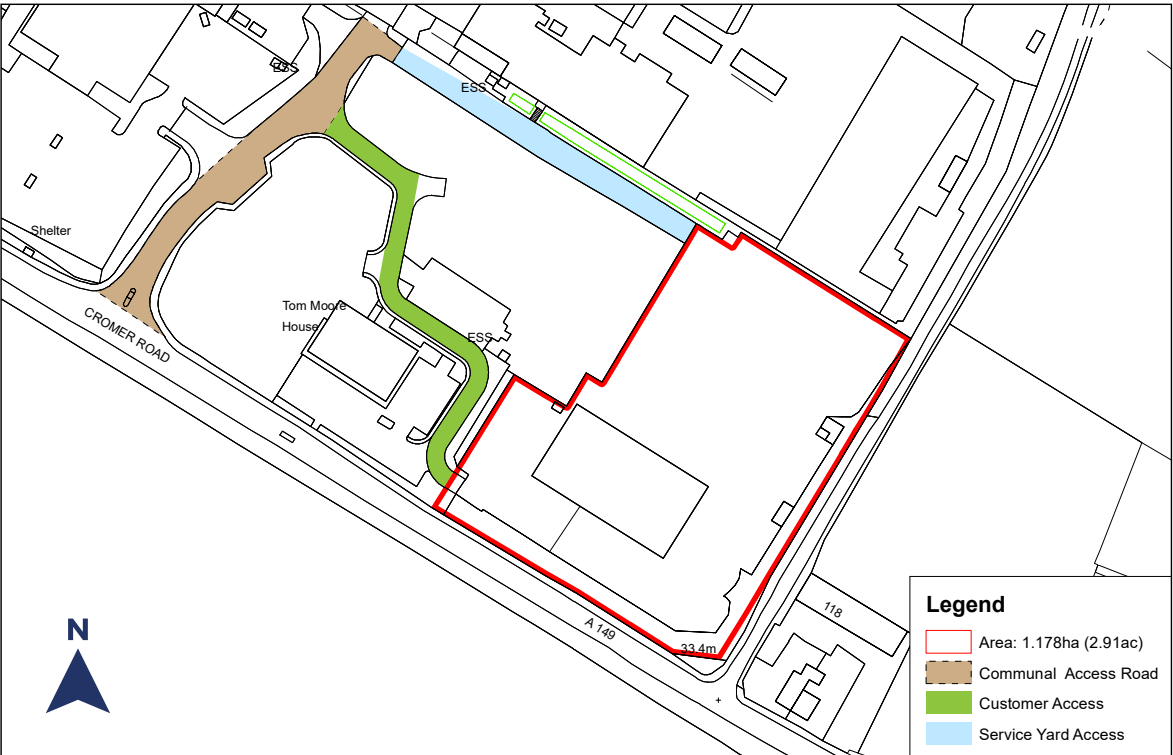

Site

The combined site extends to approximately 2.91 acres (1.18 hectares). Providing a 12% site cover.



Tenure

Freehold.

The principal MKM facility is comprised within freehold title number NK363874. Upon disposal, the MKM facility will be extracted from this title by way of a carve-out.

The property benefits from rights of way over the areas delineated in green, blue and brown on the accompanying plan.

The title further imposes an obligation on the landlord to contribute towards the maintenance of communal roads, with such costs being contractually recoverable from the tenant.

Tenancy

The property is let to MKM Building Supplies Ltd on a 20-year FRI lease from 18 October 2022, expiring on 17 October 2042 on full repairing and insuring terms.

The passing rent is £192,575 per annum. While MKM is in occupation, they pay rent monthly in advance. Rent reviews are every five years, the next being 18th October 2027. The rent review is linked to RPI with a 1%-3% collar and cap annually compounded.

Market Commentary

North Walsham sits within one of Norfolk’s most established commercial catchments, supported by a resilient local workforce and strong regional connectivity to Norwich, the A149 and the broader North Norfolk growth corridor.

The town’s industrial and trade counter market has historically been characterised by limited modern supply, with occupier demand driven by builders’ merchants, local distributors and service-led industrial occupiers seeking well-positioned sites with prominent roadside profiles.

The North Norfolk industrial market has a relatively low vacancy rate of 4% compared with the UK average for the industrial market of 6%. While the vacancy rate has risen slightly over the last two years as some occupiers have retrenched, the lack of new development in North Norfolk has limited the increase and supported continued rental growth.

Average industrial rents in North Norfolk rose by 4.5% in 2025 to £6.10 and have increased by 6.3% p.a. over the last five years. There is currently no industrial space under construction in North Norfolk and the construction of new off shore wind farms should boost demand in the area. We expect industrial rents in North Norfolk to rise by 3-4% p.a. over the five years to the end of 2030 (CoStar).
