Location

Banbury is situated at Junction 11 of the London to Birmingham M40 and is the main North Oxfordshire centre for commerce and industry, with its population approaching 52,000 and a catchment of approximately 160,000. The town is undergoing significant commercial growth.

The property is situated on the eastern side of Church Lane, within the busy pedestrianised and established 'Old Town' retail area, also acting as a thoroughfare between High Street and Parsons Street. Banbury's modern Castle Quay shopping centre is also a short walk away and includes a cinema, hotel, food retailing scheme and 'Lock 29' Artisan Market.

Description

The premises comprises a self-contained 'lock-up' ground floor retailing unit, benefitting from good frontage with two display windows. The unit has been configured to suit the outgoing occupiers use as a fitness/supplement business and can be brought back to open plan if required.

The unit has one WC and also a rear enclosed store area. As the premises benefits from use Class E, a wide variety of uses can be considered.

To the upper floor is a separate and privately leased residential dwelling.

Terms & VAT

The unit is available at a rent of £11,000 per annum on a new internal repairing lease, with terms to be agreed and subject to contract.

External Building Maintenance Contribution

For any external building maintenance that might be required during the term, the ground floor will contribution 50% of the costs, which are to be shared equally with the separately leased upper floor residential flat.

Services

We understand that all main services are provided to the property, excluding gas. None of these services have been tested by the agents.

Business Rates

The Rateable Value for the property is £12,500 per annum. Under current legislation you may be eligible for 'discounted business rates relief'. This will need to be claimed by the ingoing tenant and is subject to individual circumstances. Further information is available from either White Commercial or the local authority.

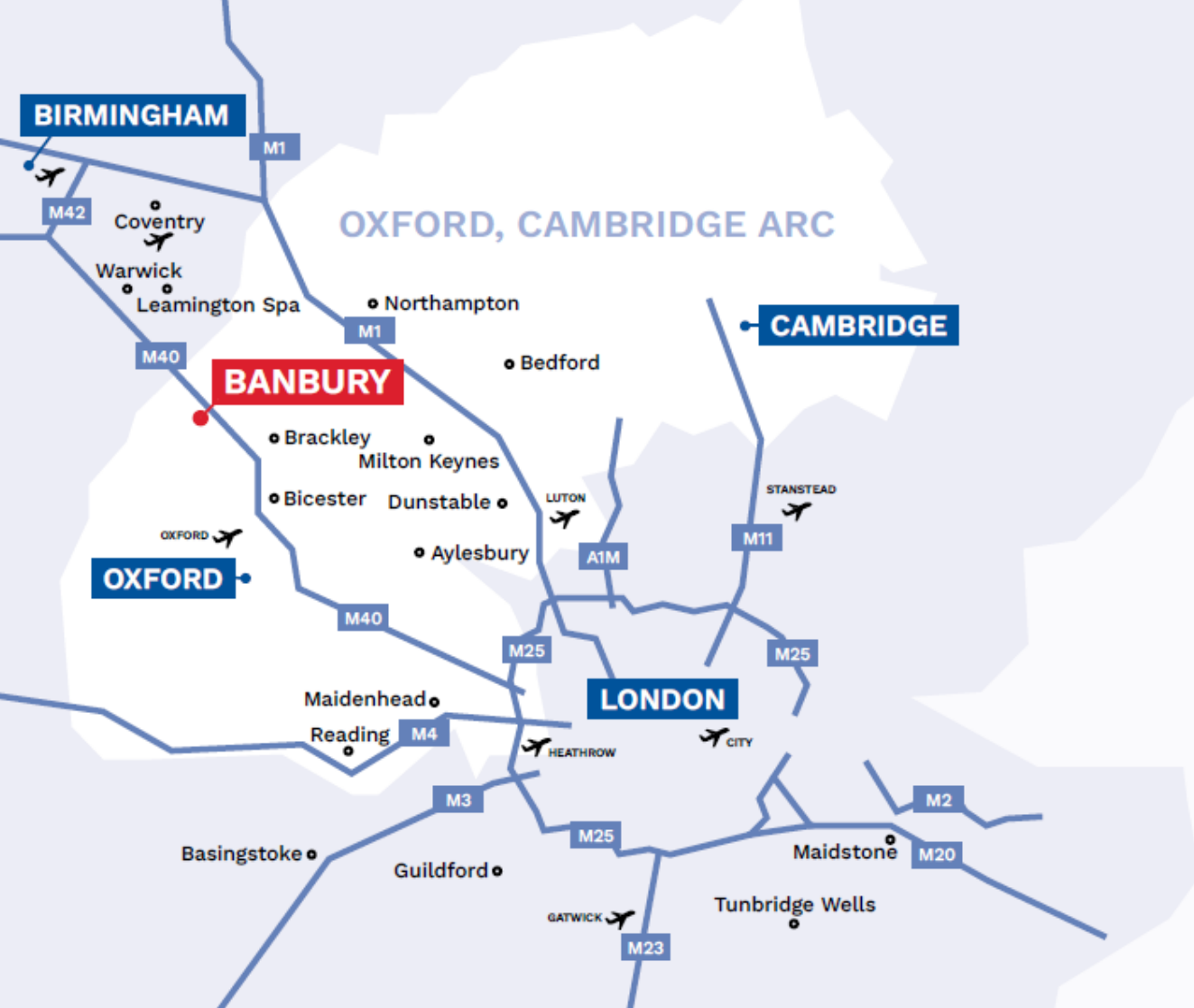

Banbury is an affluent south east market town in Oxfordshire, strategically located at Junction 11 of the London to Birmingham M40 motorway with excellent access to the key urban areas of Oxford (20 miles south), Warwick (20 miles north) and Milton Keynes (31 miles east).
