


A historic self-contained building in the heart of the city centre

Originally built in 1954, The Exchange was previously home to Manchester's telephone exchange and designed to provide secure communications in the event of nuclear war.

This piece of historical Manchester has since been transformed inside and out to create over 40,000 sq ft of workspace across five floors, benefiting from large floorplates and high ceilings flooding spacious suites with plenty of natural light.

The large open plan floorplates offer ultimate flexibility allowing you to design your space around your style of working. The configuration of the suites means you'll also benefit from self-contained WC facilities


