

DESCRIPTION

A large 3 storey reception area creates an impressive arrival hall; complete with an attractive landscaped perimeter around the building. Lift access is provided across the three floors facilitating step free access. Being situated in high Blantyre, the upper floors offer terrific views across the greater Strathclyde area.

The property is located in an elevated position on Lister Way overlooking the entrance to Hamilton International Park. The property comprises a steel framed, detached office building, constructed in 2004. The building is arranged over four floors including basement parking.


