Location

The building occupies a prominent position on the corner of Mary Ann Street and Livery Street, just off St Paul's Square in the heart of Birmingham's historic and vibrant Jewellery Quarter.

The property is only a short walk from Birmingham City Centre and is located near the city's Inner Ring Road (A4540) and benefits from easy access to the A38(M) and the UK's wider motorway network.

The immediate area is well served by public transport with regular bus services nearby and Snow Hill mainline railway station approximately 600m via Livery Street.

Description

The property comprises of a high bay warehouse premises of with full height brickwork elevations and pitched steel truss roof incorporating translucent roof lights.

The building is accessed via a large loading door to the fore and provides single span warehousing, first floor offices, canteen, and WC facilities.
