Location

Bridport is a town in West Dorset, known for its strong arts scene and proximity to the coast (2 miles to the south). It sits 14 miles to the west of Dorchester, 18 miles south of Yeovil, and 37 miles to the east of Exeter. It has a population of 12,300 residents (as at 2021).

The subject unit is amongst good quality retailers with Fatface and Waterstones directly opposite and Waitrose, Specsavers, Mountain Warehouse, Costa and Superdrug all in the town.

Description

The building is arranged as ground floor banking hall with office, storage and strong room to the rear. The first floor has two offices, along with stationery and staff rooms, and male and female toilets. The second floor provides further office space and there is also a small vaulted basement.

The property has a rear yard that has historically been used in connection with the property. Prospective purchasers must satisfy themselves as to any access arrangements.

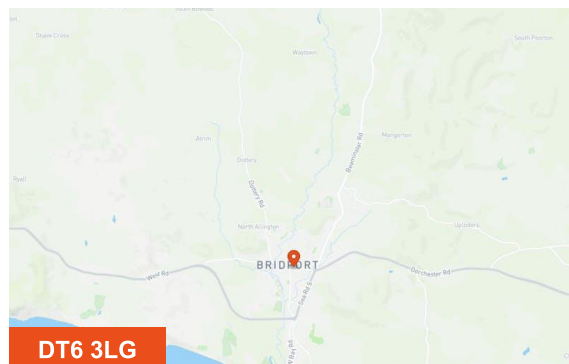
