


Key Access Key Occupiers Ley Point

Swindon is the principal town and commercial centre in Wiltshire, strategically positioned on the 'M4 corridor' between London (80 miles), Bristol (37 miles), Oxford (37 miles) and Reading (44 miles). The town is ideally located, from a distribution perspective, for access to London, the south west and south coast.

Keypoint is located within the established industrial area of South Marston, on the eastern side of Swindon.

The area is home to a number of **notable occupiers**, including; Oak Furniture Land, Amazon, Iceland, B&Q, FedEx, and Aldi.

The site is situated off the intersection of the **A419 dual** carriageway and **A420**. The former provides direct access to the **M4 motorway** (c. 3.5 miles), while the latter provides access to the north towards Oxford.



Planning

The site benefits from a detailed planning consent (ref: S/22/1574/MORGAP) for the erection of a Class B8 warehouse, ancillary offices and gatehouse plus car parking and associated works.

The site also has an extant planning consent for the construction and operation of a renewable energy centre (sui generis) for the recovery of energy (heat and electricity) from non-hazardous residual waste, using an Advanced Conversion Technology (gasification), with associated plant and infrastructure.


