INVESTMENT HIGHLIGHTS

- Frimley is located in the **affluent county of Surrey**, only 30 miles from Central London and benefits from an extensive catchment population of 147,418 people within 10 minutes' drive time.
- **Exceptionally affluent catchment** with 30.3% of the 10 minute drive time catchment comprising the AB social groups, **which exceeds the GB average by 33%** (source: ORC).
- **Freehold.**
- Purpose-built omnichannel foodstore, extending to 29,617 sq ft, with a total provision of **125 customer car parking spaces (60 demised)**, reflecting **an overall ratio of 1:236 sq ft**.
- Fully let to Waitrose Limited until **14th June 2036** providing an attractive **unexpired term of 10.75 years. The tenant regeared in June 2021.**
- Affordable rent of **£498,488 per annum* (£18.52psf**)**
- Income benefits from **guaranteed rental growth** with 5 yearly rent reviews to CPI, collared and capped at 1% – 3% per annum calculated over the 5 year period.
- **Waitrose is the only major supermarket** in Frimley town centre.
- **Strong trading profile** and the store has an important on-line fulfilment function.

LOCATION

Frimley is situated within the Blackwater Valley, 30 miles south-west of Central London, 14 miles west of Guildford and 20 miles south-east of Reading. The neighbouring towns include Camberley, Farnborough, Fleet and Hook.



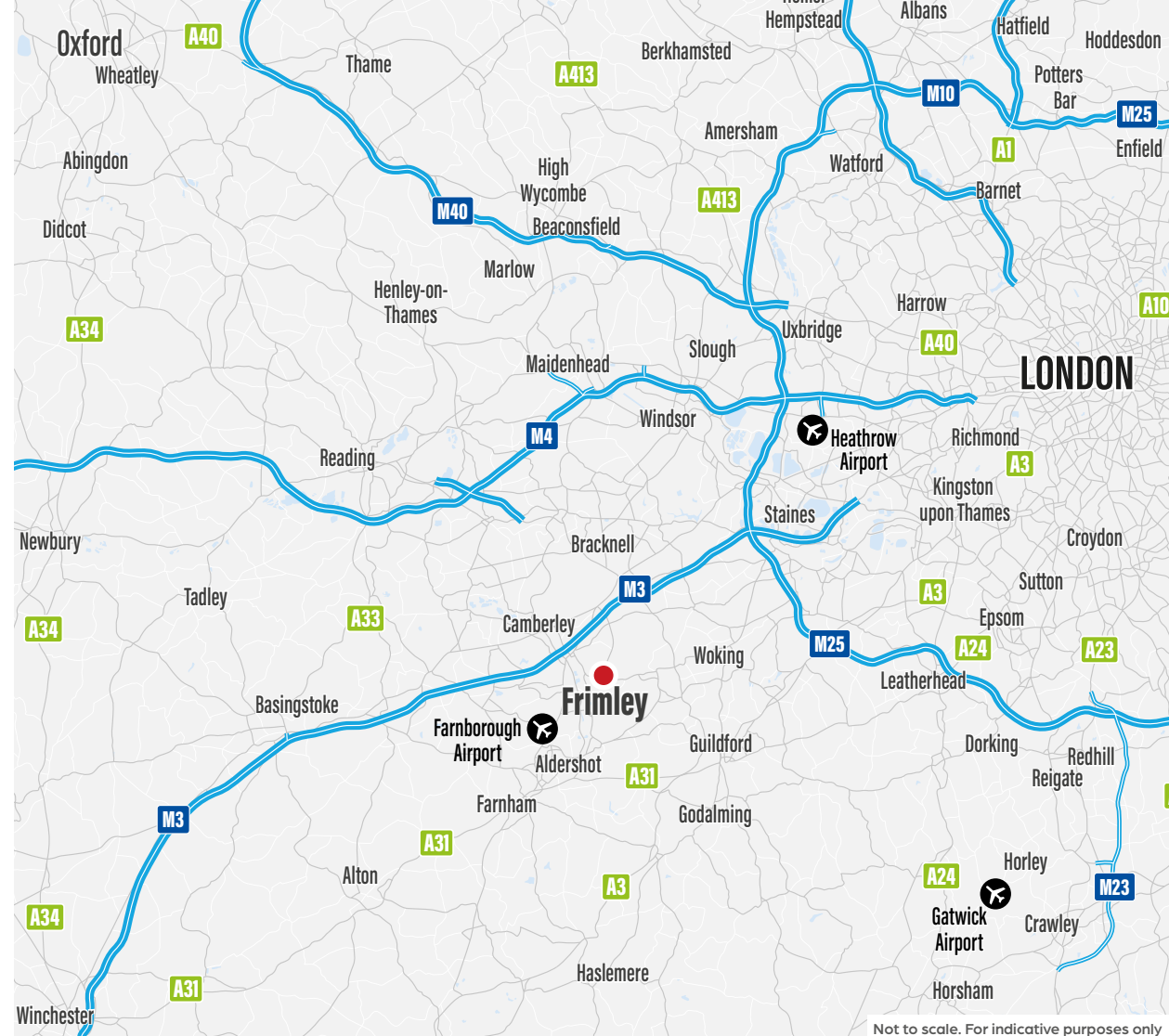
Frimley has excellent transport links and is a strategic location, being close to several major arterial road links with direct access to the M3, M4, M25, A31 and A3 all within 20 minutes, connecting the town to London (East) and Brighton, Southampton and Portsmouth (South).



Frimley Station is a commuter station with approximately 500,000 passengers, annually (pre-Covid). The rail service connects the town to London Waterloo within an hour. Camberley Station is located 1.2 miles (5 minutes) north of Frimley and provides additional service lines into Central London and recently benefitted from a £1.4 million refurbishment to accommodate additional passengers.



Heathrow Airport is the UK and Europe's largest, busiest airport and the 7th busiest airport, globally. Heathrow airport is located 18 miles (20 minutes) north of Frimley. It accommodates approximately 80 million passengers, annually and carries over 1.7 million tonnes of cargo.

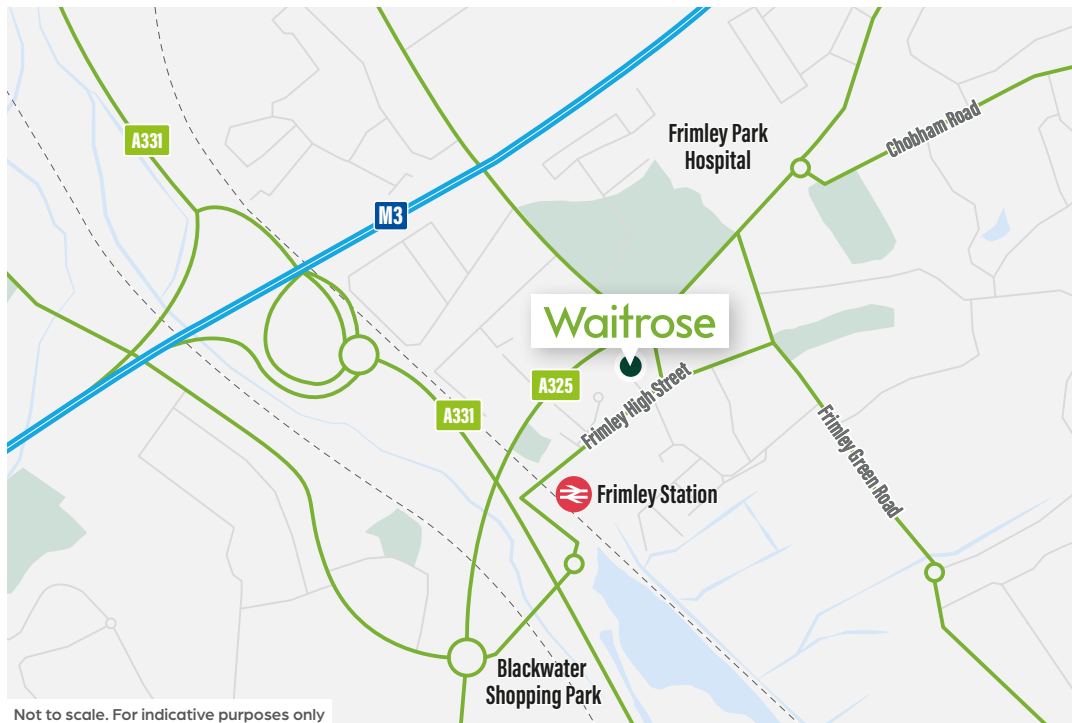

SITUATION

The property is prominently situated on Frimley High Street, immediately south of Farnborough Road (A325).

The immediate area comprises a mixture of commercial and residential uses, positioned within the main localised retail area.

FOODSTORE PROVISION

The property is the only major supermarket in Frimley town centre.

Competing supermarket floor space increases to approximately 588,000 sq ft (GIA) within a 10-minute drive time but the majority of this is located on the very edge of the 10 minute drive-time. The property is the closest supermarket for over 35,000 people.

DESCRIPTION

The property comprises a purpose built foodstore unit arranged over ground and first floor. There are also two self-contained residential flats at first floor that are within the Waitrose demise and used for additional storage and staff training.

Internally, the store has been fitted to the tenant's specification across ground and first floor. The ground floor provides for sales area and the first floor accommodates meeting and training rooms, together with storage.

The service yard is located at the rear of the property on Hale Way, which is also used to accommodate the tenant's online fulfilment requirements, currently operating 3 vans.

There is a large surface car park to the rear of the property comprising a total of 125 customer car parking spaces, 60 of which are within the freehold demise. This provides an overall car parking ratio of 1:236 sq ft. The car park includes 10 dedicated spaces for click and collect, 8 spaces for disabled customers and 4 spaces for family customers.

Waitrose acquired the freehold interest in a parcel of land to extend the car park in 2008 to accommodate consumer demand.

The above GIA incorporates some tenant improvements / extensions. The areas previously agreed at rent review with the tenant were 26,548 sq ft (GF: 18,765 sq ft; and 1F: 7,783 sq ft), which excluded the two flats that were apportioned a separate value.



TENURE AND SITE

The property is held freehold, which includes 60 car parking spaces, outlined red as per the plan, above.

Waitrose own part of the car park freehold, which includes 65 spaces, outlined green as per the plan, above.

The site area for the property, outlined red extends to 1.30 acres.

The property benefits from a right of way via Hale Way to enable access to the property.

Waitrose have a pre-emption right on disposal by the landlord.



TENANCY

The property is let to Waitrose Ltd on a full repairing and insuring lease, expiring 14th June 2036, providing an unexpired term of 10.75 years.

The rent is reviewed every 5 years, upwards only to CPI, collared and capped at 1% – 3% pa calculated over the 5 year period.

The contractual rent is £430,000 pa (£15.94 psf). The vendor will top-up the rent to the 15th June 2026 rent review to the anticipated uplift of £498,488 pa (£18.52 psf).

Waitrose Ltd signed a reversionary lease in June 2021, extending the term for an additional 10.75 years, rebasing the rent from £500,000pa (£18.52psf) to £430,000pa (£15.94psf) and incorporating the CPI uplifts.

The tenant received a 12 month rent free incentive, which has now expired.

Historically, the rent was reviewed 5 yearly to OMRV on the previous lease. The tenant and vendor agreed that the two residential flats were to be devalued at £8,400pa each, less 60% for service tenancy restrictions, totalling £6,720 at previous rent reviews.

Waitrose have a pre-emption right on disposal by the landlord.



COVENANT

Waitrose

Waitrose are the eighth largest grocery retailer in the UK, with a current market share of 4.5% (Kantar).

The lease is secured against the highly attractive Waitrose Limited covenant, which has a current CreditSafe rating of 81 A. Waitrose Limited is a subsidiary of the John Lewis Partnership Trust Limited

Waitrose was founded in 1904 and forms part of the John Lewis Partnership, which is the UK's largest employee owned business, owned in Trust by 80,000 Partners. There are a total of 329 Waitrose stores across the UK, of which 65 are 'Little Waitrose' convenience stores.

Waitrose have allocated £600 million to invest into 20 store refurbishments to deliver strong sales growth, 100 new Little Waitrose convenience stores by 2029 and improving supply chain.

This store has an important online fulfilment function. Growing on-demand grocery sales at a corporate level by 110% for 2024, agreeing a partnership deal with Just Eat, adding to Uber Eats and Deliveroo.

RENTAL COMMENTARY

We consider the topped up passing rent of £498,488 pa, reflecting £18.52 per sq ft to be comfortably rack-rented and is low relative to the strong trading performance. There is limited supermarket competition within a 5-minute drive time in an exceptionally affluent catchment. If the property was available, we would expect competitive interest from a number of occupiers.
