Logistics City Andover is a gateway location offering easy access to the west country, the South and to London via the A303 and A34 interchange.

Location

Walworth Business Park lies adjacent to the A303 on the eastern side of Andover close to the town ring road. The business park is strategically located close to the M3 motorway as well as the A34 trunk road providing excellent road communications to London, the Midlands and the North, as well as Southampton and its busy port and international airport to the South.

It has been chosen as the location for regional distribution centres for the Co-op (400,000 sq ft), Ocado (250,000 sq ft) and Rich products (200,000 sq ft) along with several larger occupiers such as Twinning's, Vitacress, Able & Cole and Howard Tennes.

Planning

Full detailed consent has been granted for 452,439 sq ft (42,033 sq m) of B2 and B8 uses.

Lease

Units will be available on full repairing and insuring leases for a term by arrangement subject to rent reviews in an upwards direction only at five yearly intervals.

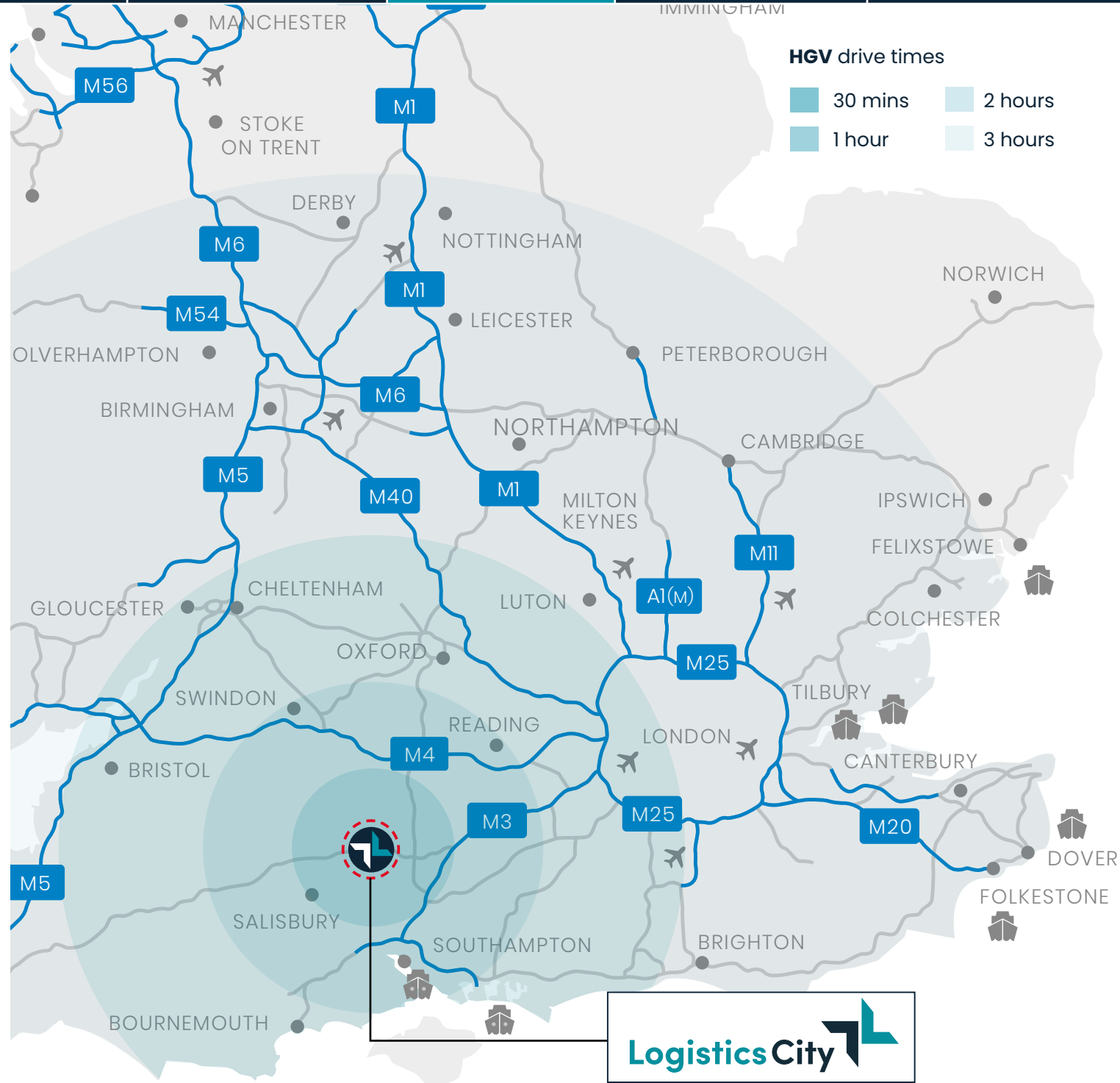
