Design Risk Assessment & Appointment of Principal Designer forms to be produced if APSS are appointed as "Principal Designer", works are to last longer than 30 days and have more than 20 workers working simultaneously at any point in the project OR works exceed 500 person days.

All products / materials / finishes / fixtures / fixings to be securely fixed and installed as per manufacturers instructions and guidelines. APSS designer & project manager to be advised prior to installation if any of the above are considered inappropriate for intended use by contractor responsible for installing.

Significant or unusual / "not obvious" residual risks during construction, use & demolition to be recorded below.
