







Highlights

- Excellent residential development opportunity with a total site area of approximately 16.67 acres (6.74 Ha)
- Reserved Matters for 254 dwellings (LPA ref: P/2019/0278) comprising 201 dwellings and 53 apartments. The scheme seeks to provide a 4% affordable housing provision (see S106)
- The population of Torbay has increased by 6.4%, from around 131,000 in 2011 to 139,300 in 2021
- Direct rail services to London Paddington with an average journey time of 3 hours and 24 minutes
- The freehold of the site is offered for sale by informal tender with preference for unconditional offers with the benefit of the existing planning consent

Location

Paignton is a seaside town on the coast of South Devon. Together with Torquay and Brixham it forms the borough of Torbay, also known as the English Riviera. Paignton is around 25 miles north-east of Plymouth and 20 miles south of Exeter. The site benefits from excellent regional road communications with easy access to the A3022 (Paignton to Brixham Road) which links to the A380 and the South Devon Highway. Both Paignton and Brixham are within a short drive from the site, with it being located on a major link road and bus route. Paignton's Railway Station is situated approximately 2.5 miles from the site and offers direct rail services to London Paddington with an average journey time of 3 hours and 24 minutes.

The M5 Motorway is accessed in Exeter via the A380 dual carriageway. Brixham Harbour is located approximately 5 miles to the south of the site and the historic market town of Totnes is situated around 6 miles to the west. Exeter Airport provides a range of national and international flights and is located approximately 27 miles north-east of the site.

The site is situated to the northern part of the former Nortel/Bookham site that is now referred to as Devonshire Park. The site sits to the west of Brixham Road, Paignton and to the north of Long Road and the recently built retail park. The site is on the western outskirts of Paignton, close to the widely known residential areas of Roselands, White Rock and Yannons Farm. The northern high point of the site has an elevated topography with far reaching views of the coast and abuts mainly residential uses.



The Opportunity

Devonshire Park represents an exceptionally rare and exciting opportunity to acquire a consented and well-located site in Paignton. The opportunity comprises a circa. 16.67 acre (6.74 Ha) former brownfield site with the benefit of Reserved Matters approval for 254 dwellings (LPA ref: P/2019/0278).

The residential scheme includes various house types across 201 dwellings, which are a mix of detached, semi-detached and short terraces ranging from one to four levels, plus apartment blocks of three and four storeys high. The additional 53 apartments will be arranged in two blocks, one of 12 units and one of 41 units.

The site is largely cleared with pockets of trees/scrub and occasional border vegetation. Towards the southeast corner there are retained low-level buildings.

Planning and S106 Agreement

Approval of Reserved Matters, subject to conditions, was agreed at the Torbay Council Planning Committee on 14/03/2022 under the following: Reserved Matters on application P/2014/0947 (Outline mixed use application for retail, business and residential uses with all matters reserved except for access (as revised by S73 applications P/2016/1372, P/2017/0123, P/2017/0571 and P/2017/1041)). Reserved Matters sought: Appearance, Landscaping, Layout & Scale for up to 255 Residential Dwellings (As revised). The Decision Notice was issued on 8th July 2022.

Details of the affordable housing contribution are contained in the completed S106 agreement (see dataroom).

The S106 agreement provides for 4% social housing with a claw back based on sales value achieved over a base value (see S106).

Buildings S, K & T

Part of the site known as the land and buildings (S, K & T block) to the southwest of the application boundary is occupied on a short-term lease commitment. This income producing element of the site has significant potential to increase the income in the short-term whilst the earlier phases of the development are completed.
