

How can I test kato integration?

1. Login in [wp](#)
Email: development@tribedigital.com
Password: %UOsvDY9vzc)TD@v5eKo0udf
2. Login to [app.agents-society-sandbox.com](#)
Email : [tribe@tribedigital.com](#)
Password: TribeDigital25!
Go to [properties](#), and select one, and get id example: ID #180839
3. Import a Single Property by ID - Go to [Import properties from KATO](#), paste the ID (180839), click the 'Import from KATO' button, and wait. If the import is successful, go to the [properties](#). You will see the imported property at the top of the list. Click [view](#) to see it on the front end.
4. Import Multiple Properties by Date - Go to [Import properties from KATO](#), select 'Updated From' (e.g., 01.07.2025), and click the 'Import from KATO' button to import multiple properties. The imported properties can be viewed in the [properties](#).
5. Automatic Daily Import - The properties are imported automatically, without any manual action required. A daily cron job runs and uses the current date to import only the properties that have been updated on that day. If a property already exists in WordPress, it will not be imported again; instead, its data will be updated.
6. To sync a property's data with KATO, click to [edit property](#). Scroll down to the left side, where you'll find the 'Sync with KATO' button. Click this button. If you see the message 'The property has been synced successfully', it means the property has also been updated in KATO. Then go to the kato [properties](#) list to check the result.
7. The update/create method requires certain fields to be filled in. If any required fields are missing, an error message listing the mandatory fields will appear at the top in an alert box.
