Straight from the station a striking, 170m red timber boardwalk cuts across a regenerated dock. Intertwining waterside working and socialising, with a natural haven.

Seven wetland islands planted with native species have created reed beds, wet woodland and wet meadow, this is somewhere you could expect to see a Kingfisher as you walk from the tube to the office.

Mature-planted trees, bio-diverse wetlands, a hidden courtyard and a new park larger than Leicester Square take their place alongside the existing 130 acres of Southwark Park and Russia Dock Woodlands, with some of the cleanest air in Central London.









Canada Water places health and wellbeing at the heart of this natural urban landscape.

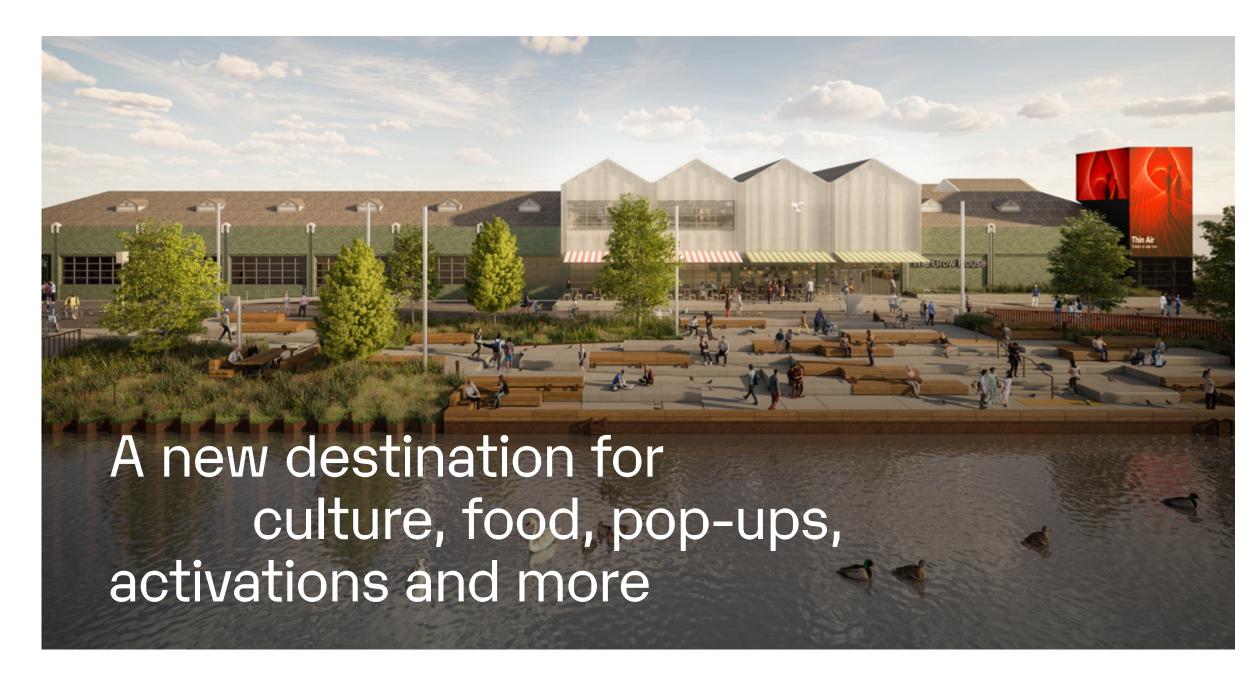
From peace and serenity in everyday spaces, to sports and activities, the sheer scale of variety, opportunities and ease of access makes it as inclusive as it is exciting.

From kayaking on Greenland Dock to tennis on Southwark Park's all-weather courts, there are space and facilities for just about any sport and pastime.

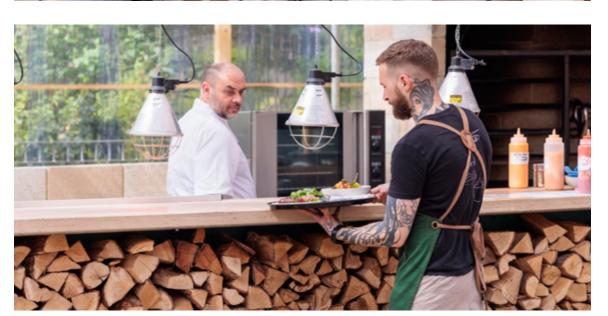

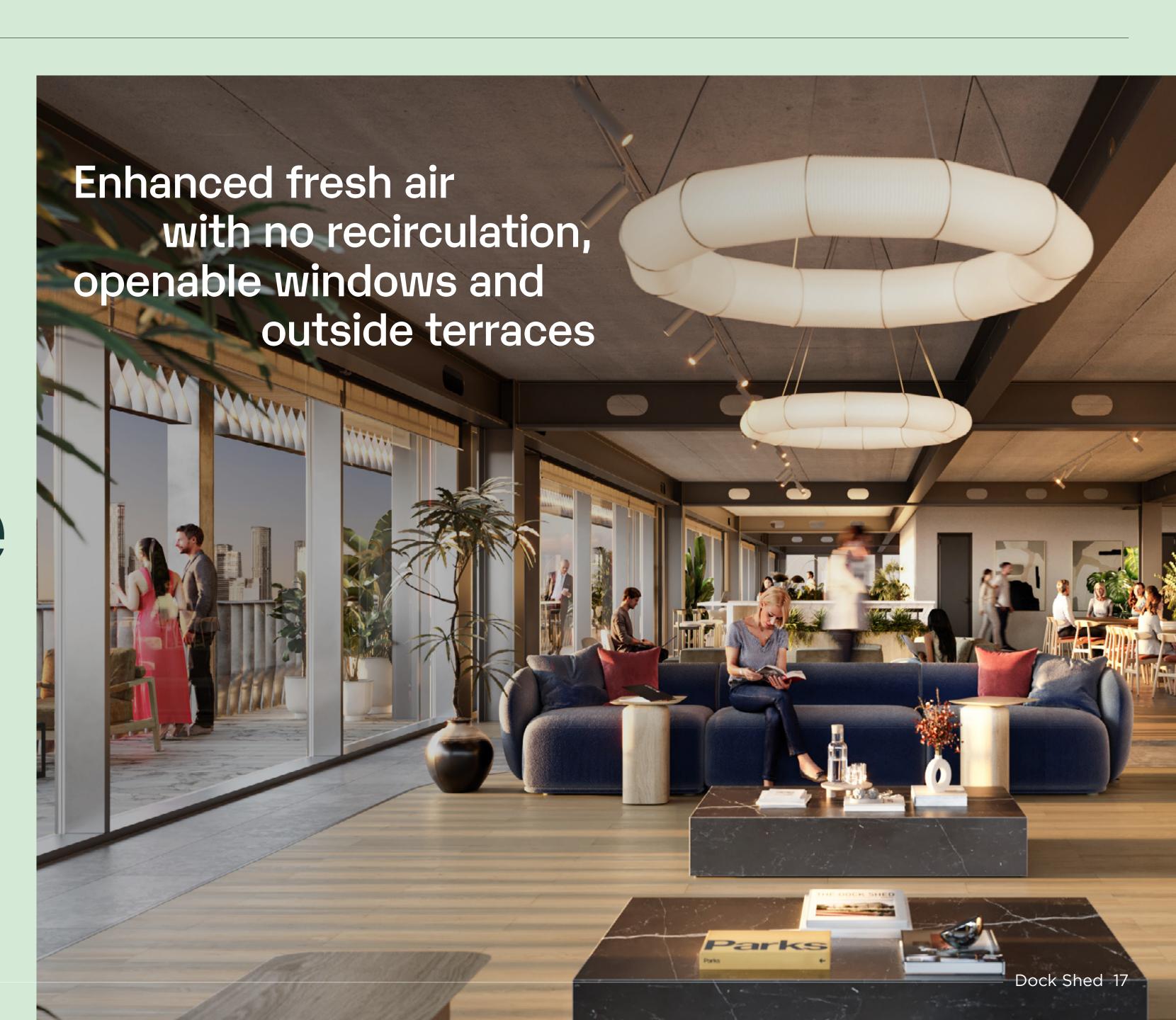




A new level of workspace

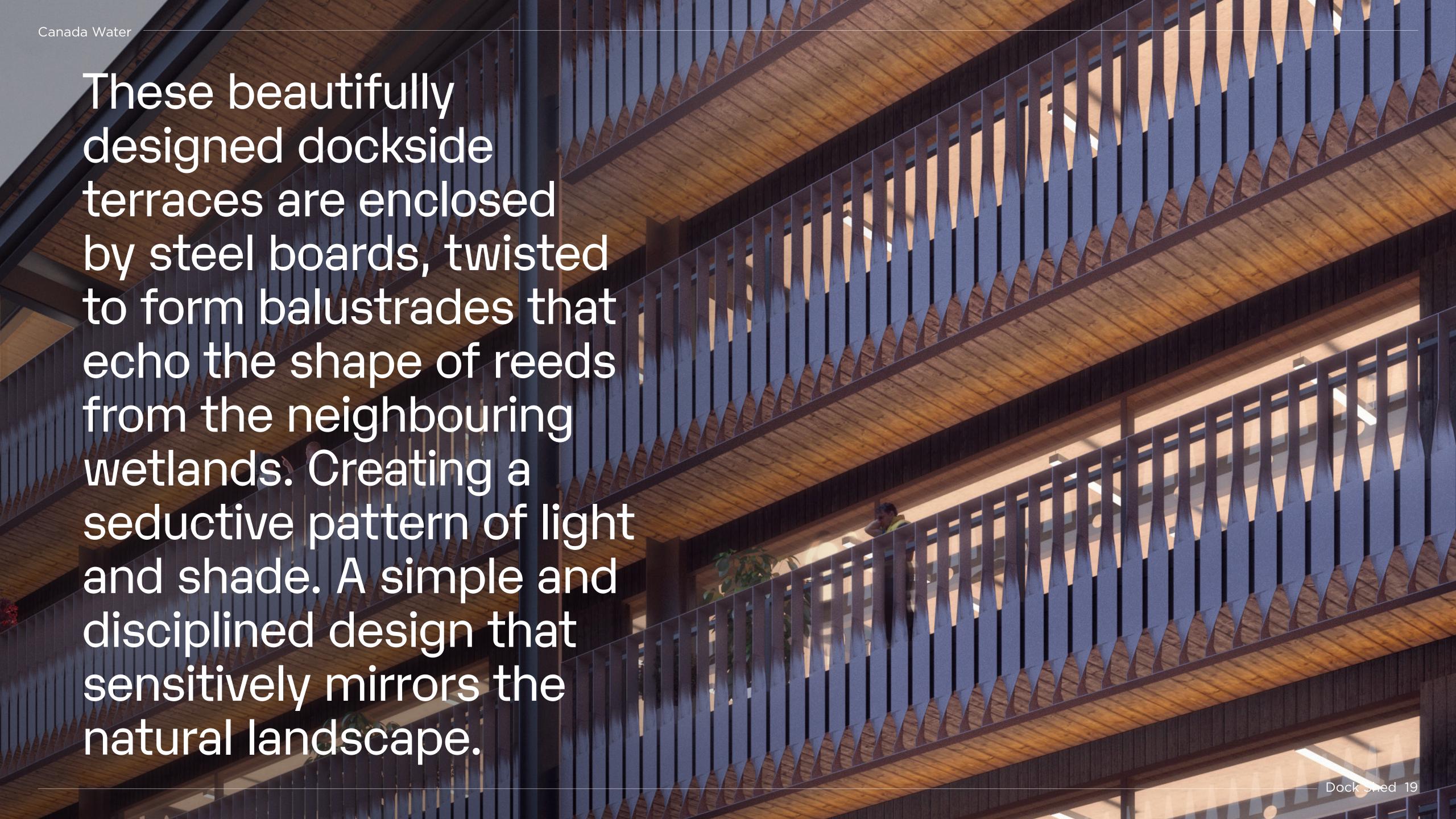


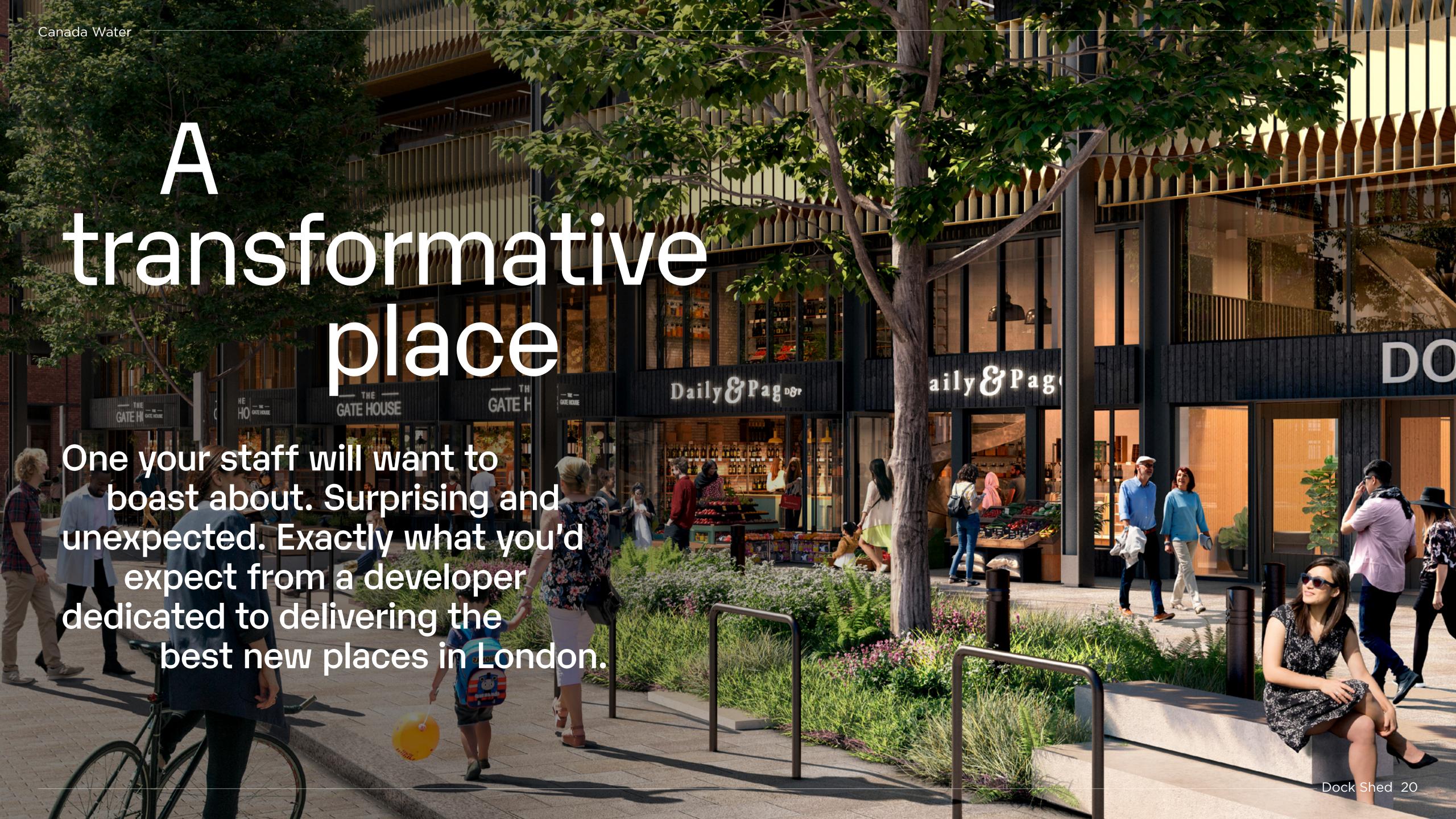


From the top floor terraces there are impressive views of St Paul's, The Shard, and across the city.

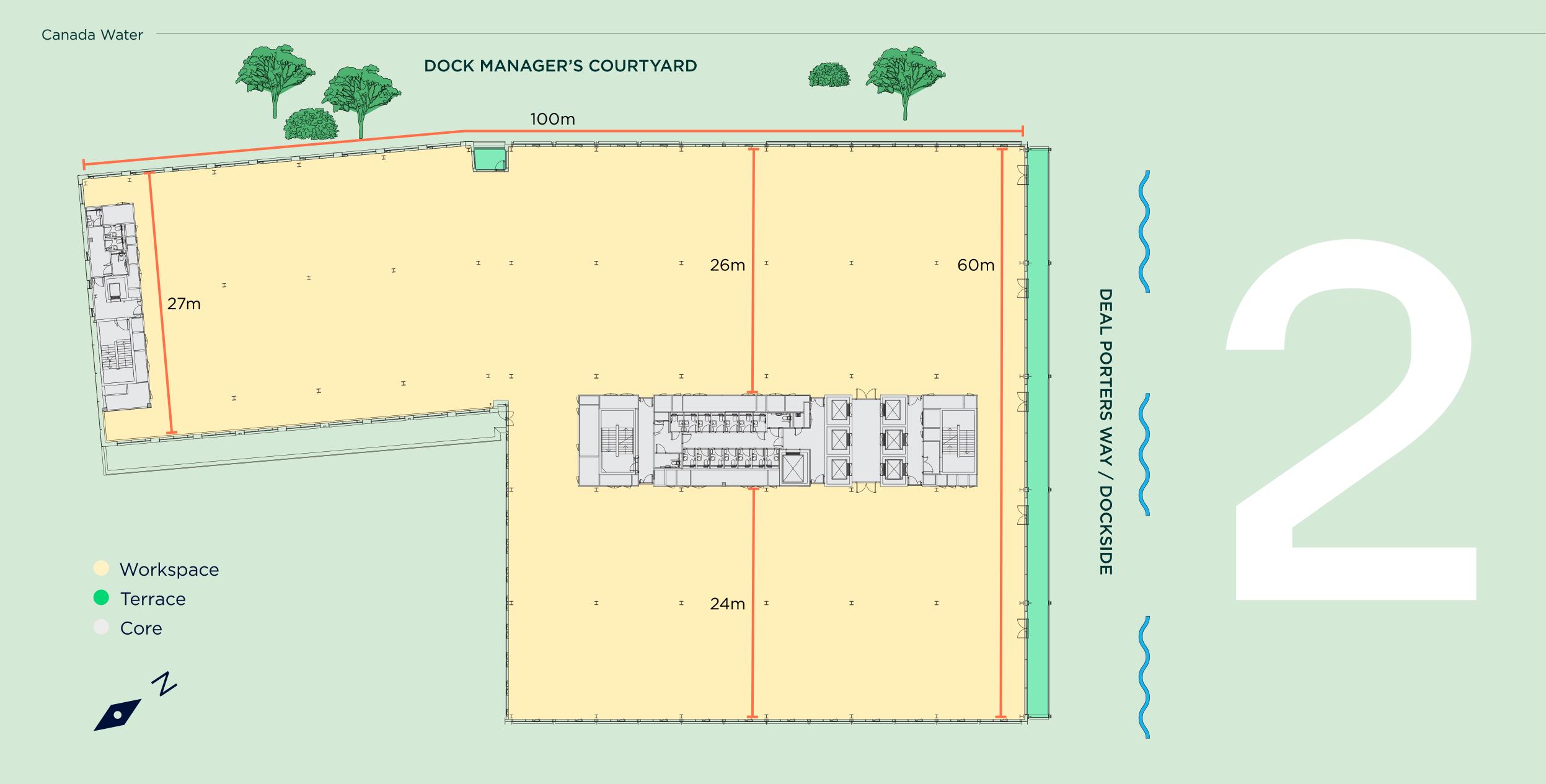

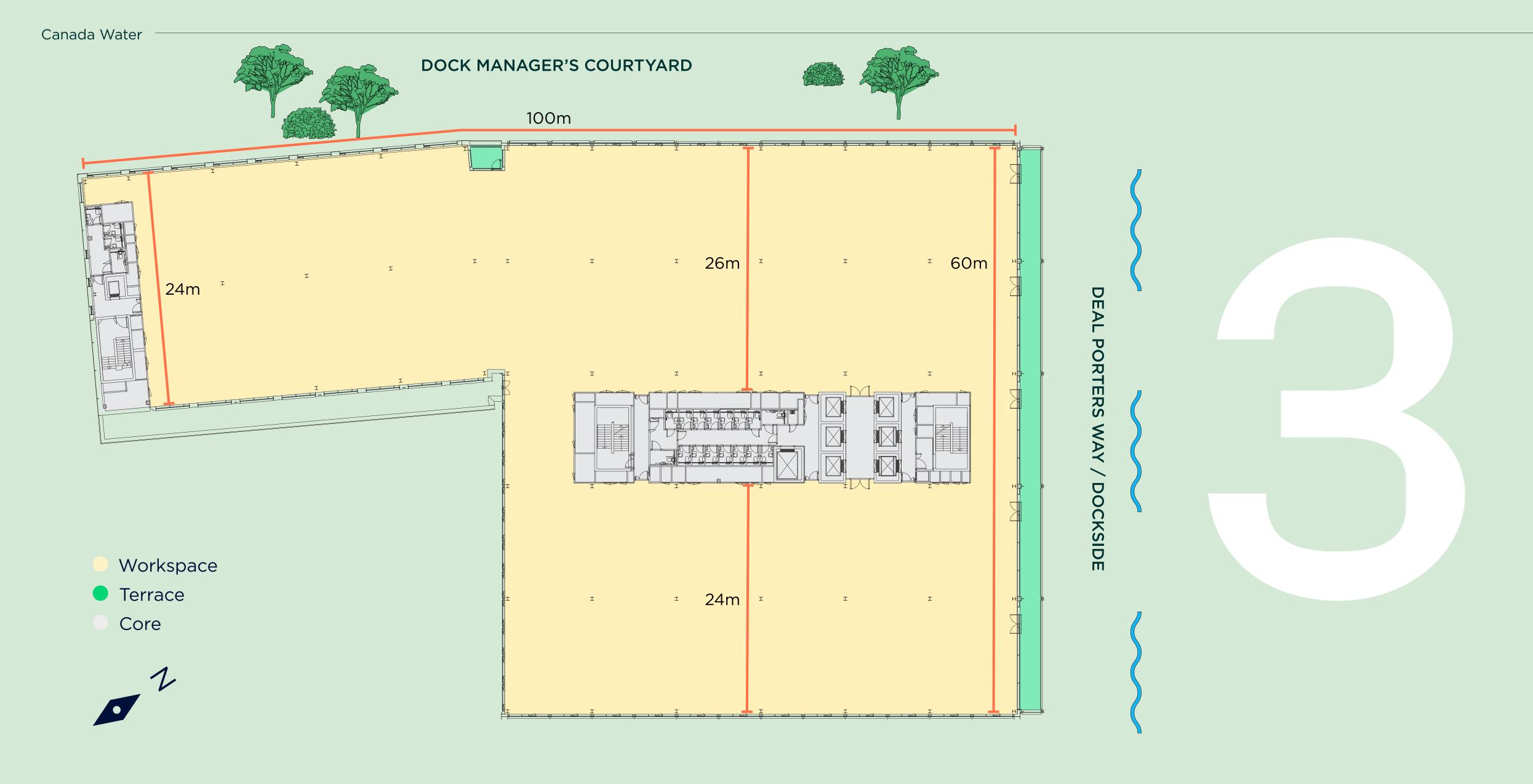


Workspace – 32,507 sq ft | Terraces – 105 sq ft



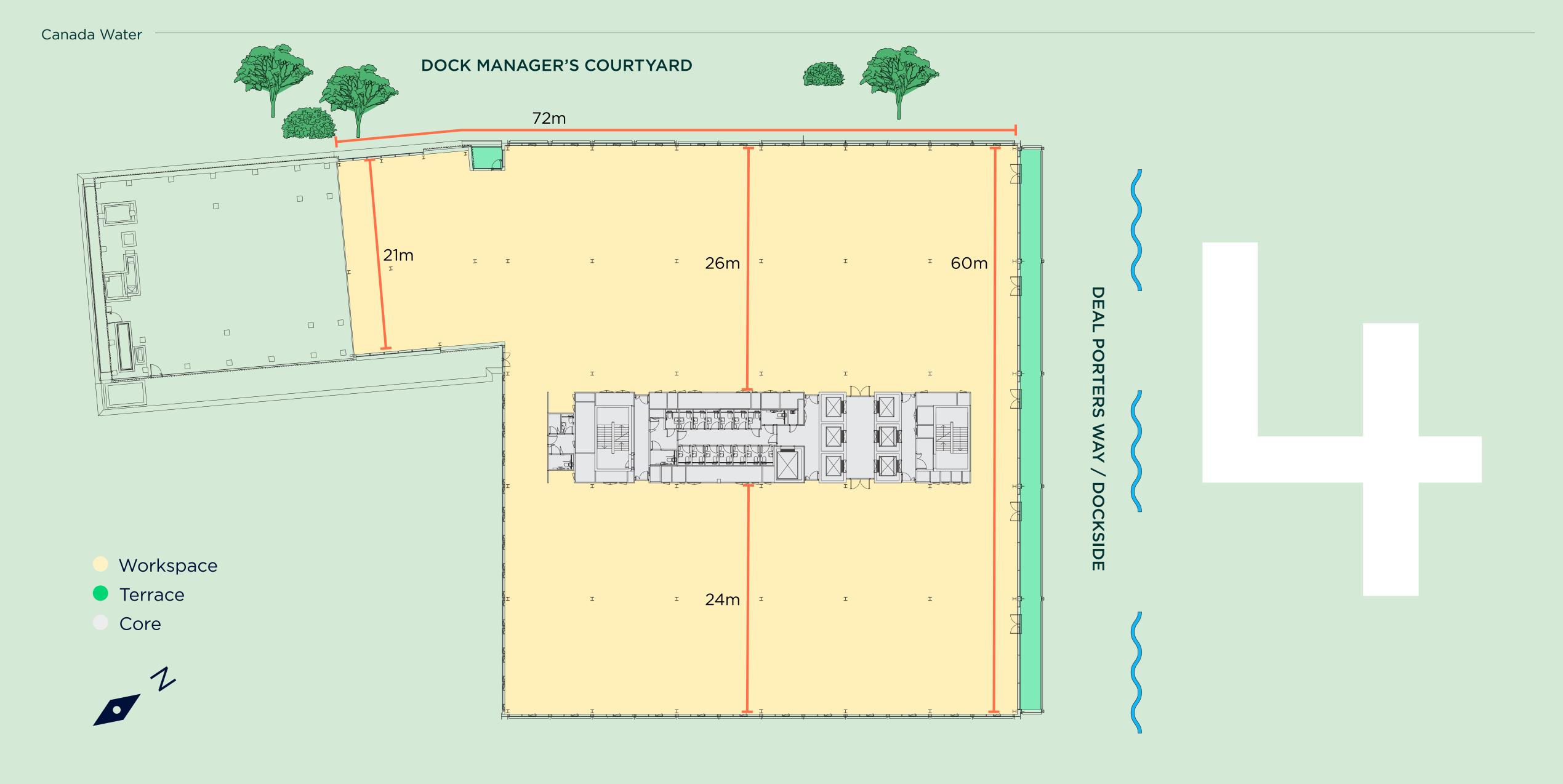

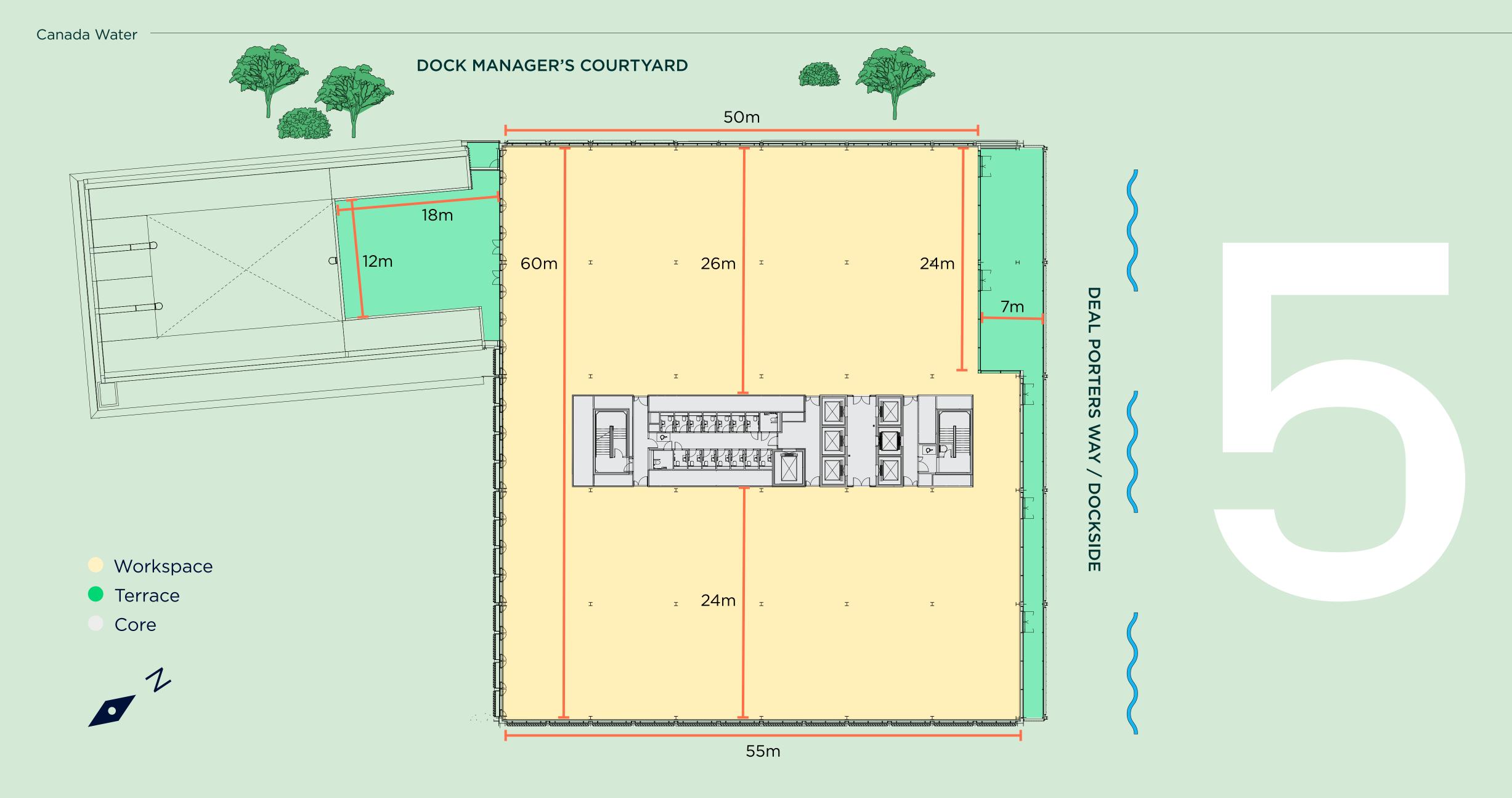

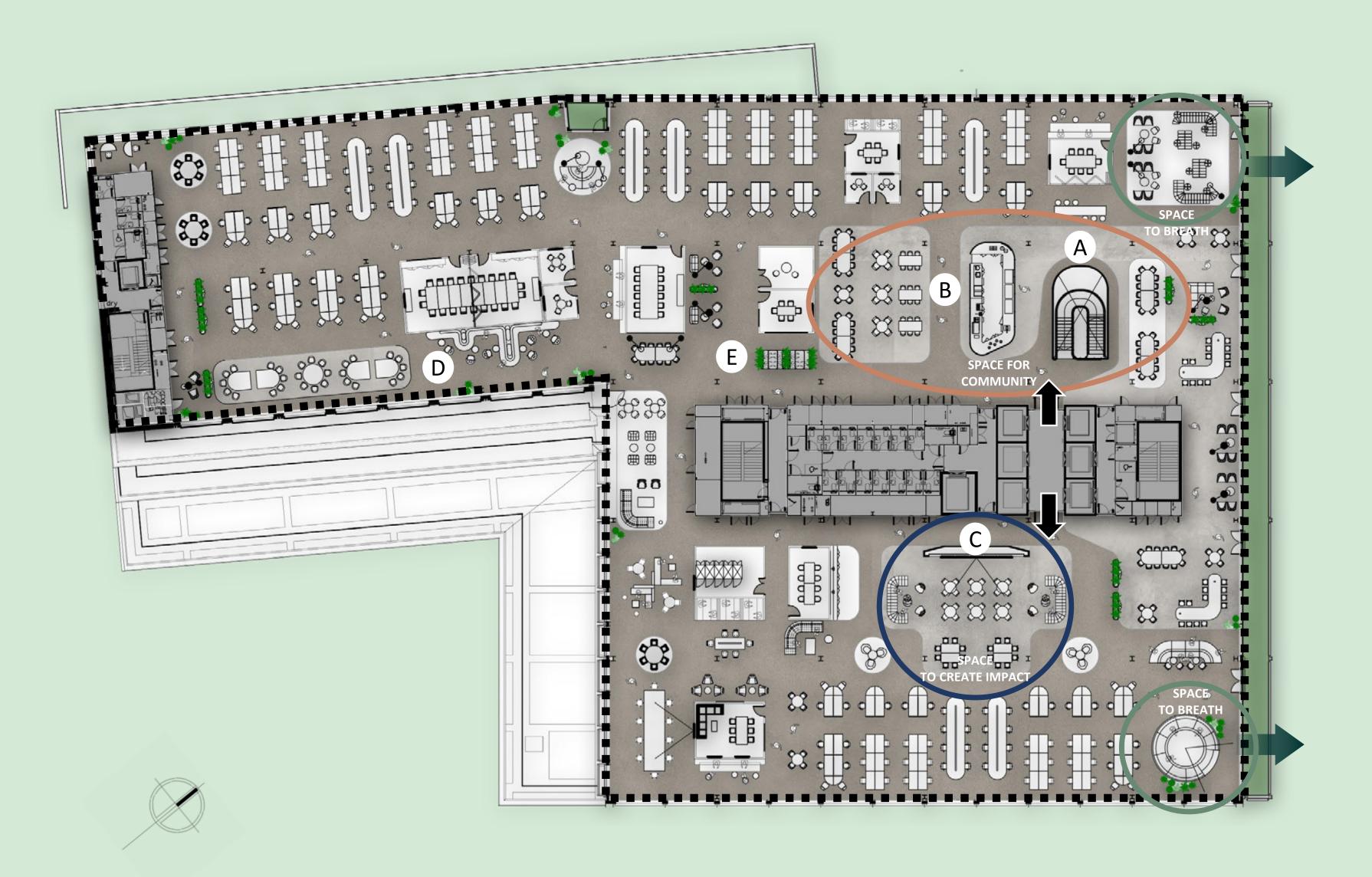

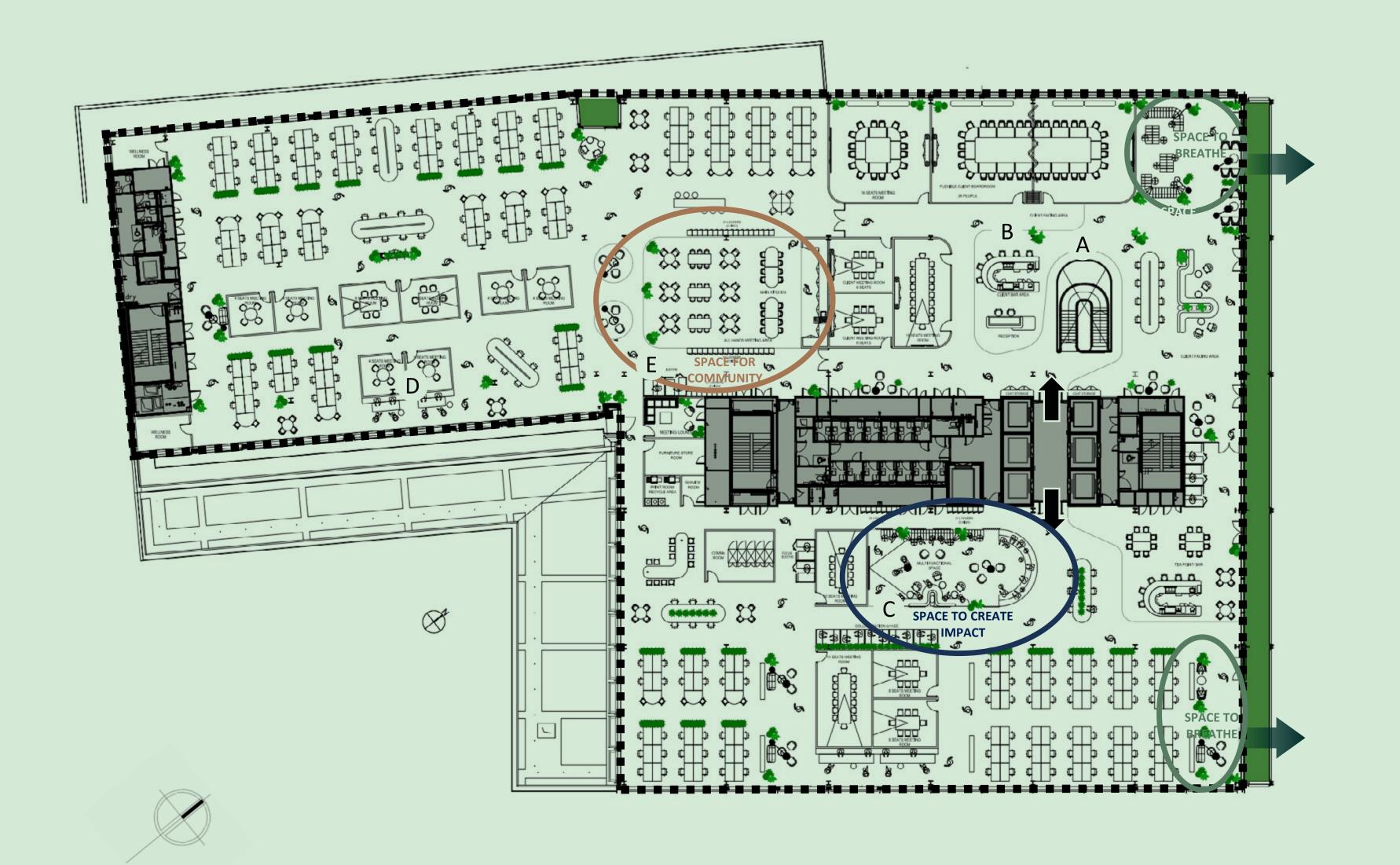

Single tenant

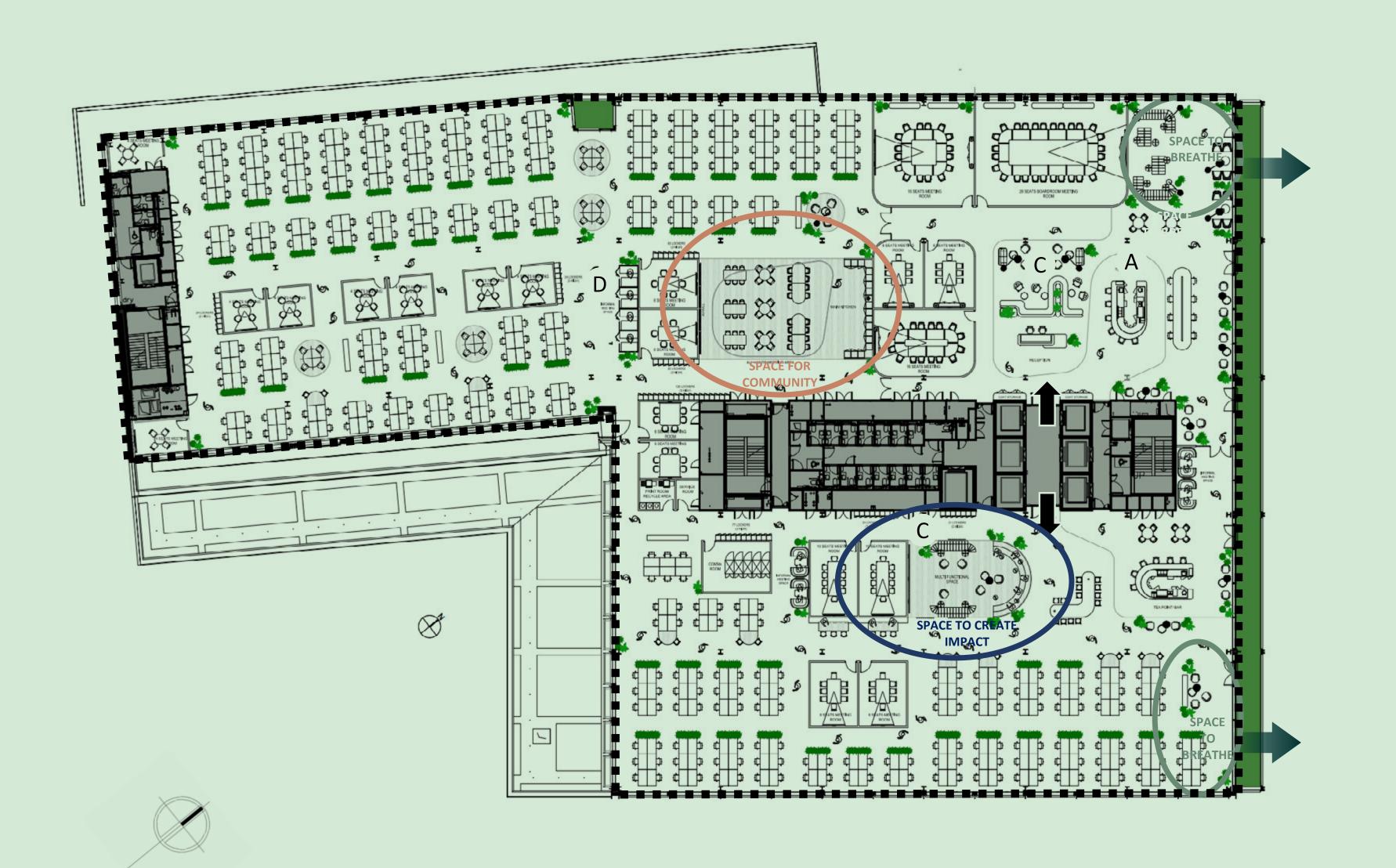
- With linking stair between two floors



Test Fit - High Density

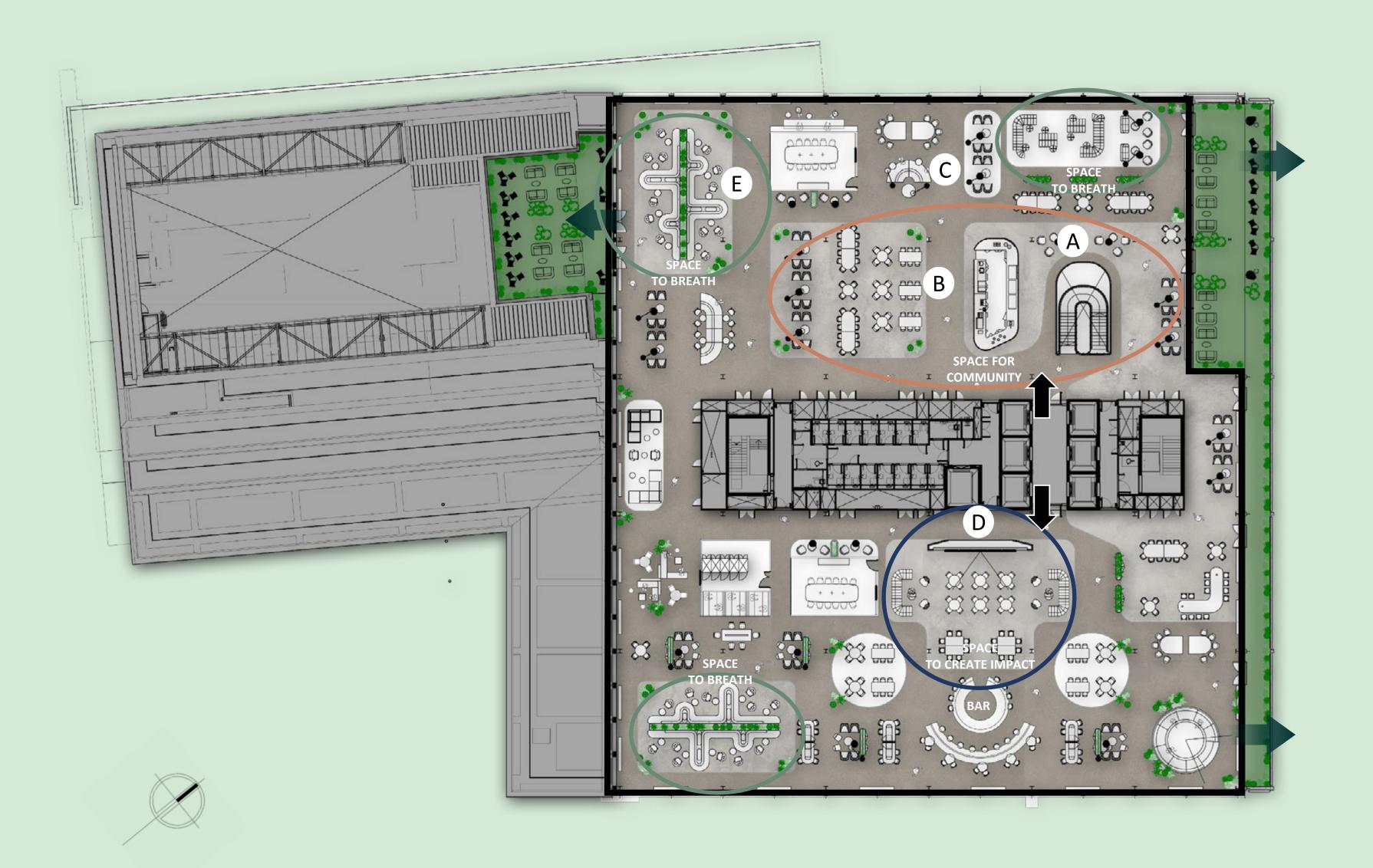

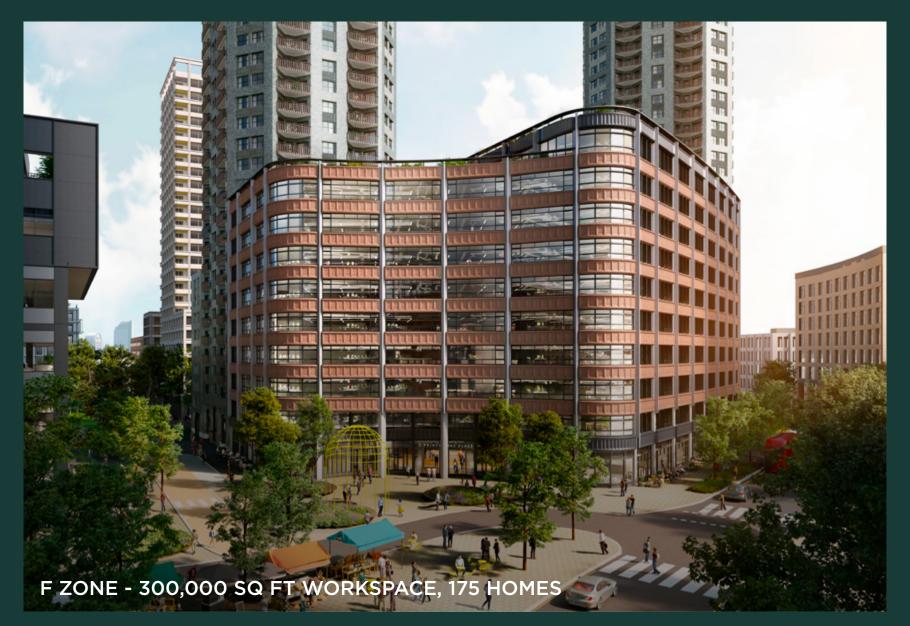
