



Location

Endeavour House is located on Crow Arch Lane and is approximately 1 mile distant from Ringwood Town Centre and the A31 which provides access to the motorway networks.

Description


Endeavour House is a two storey office building with brick elevations under a pitched and tiled roof constructed in two phases. There is a shared entrance leading to the reception area where the Facilities Manager is based. There are shared WC facilities and a communal break out area providing kitchenette facilities and a coffee vending machine.

The suite is predominantly open plan with 2 meeting rooms, store room, and teapoint area and can be fitted out to requirements (subject to terms).
