



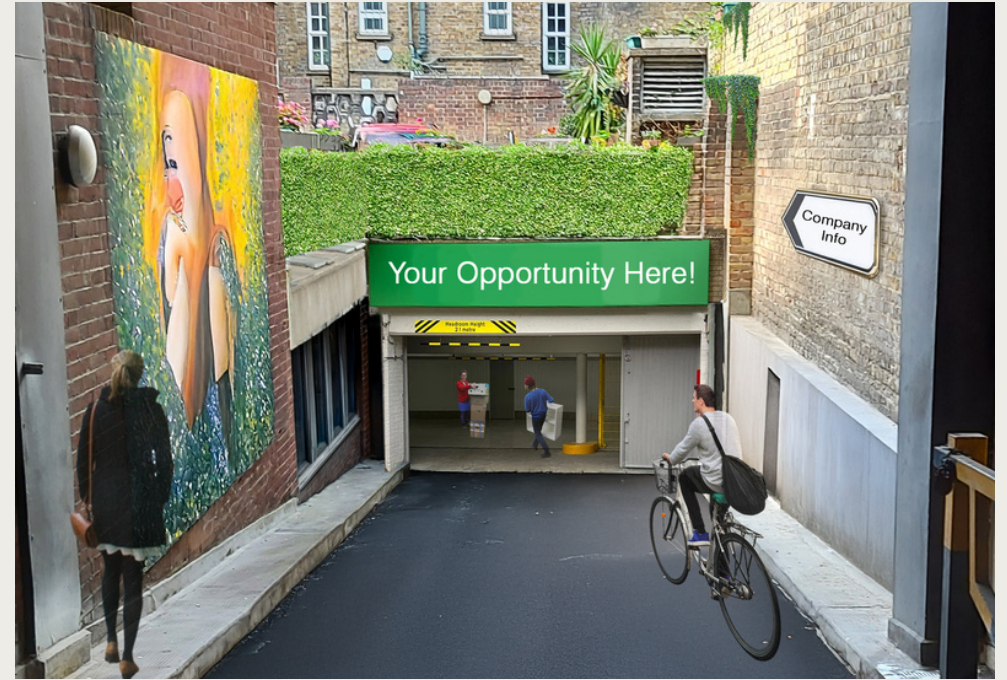

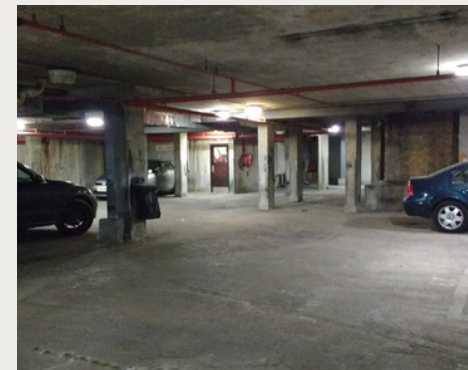
Description

London Borough of Camden (LBC) is inviting Expressions of Interest (EOI) from experienced operators to transform a former underground carpark in the heart of Holborn into a vibrant commercial or community-led destination.

Comprising approximately 750 sq m (8,073 sq ft) beneath the Red Lion Square Estate, the site benefits from direct access via Eagle Street and excellent transport connectivity by foot, bus and rail. While in close proximity to residential uses, local residents and the Council are keen to see this currently underutilised asset brought back into active use that enhances the area's social and economic fabric.

LBC will offer a 10–20 year lease, seeking an operator with a clear and deliverable vision that balances commercial viability with community benefit. The successful partner will refurbish the premises and deliver a concept aligned with Camden's strategic aims for placemaking, sustainability, and enterprise.

This is a rare opportunity to reimagine a hidden Holborn space into an exciting, purposeful new destination.

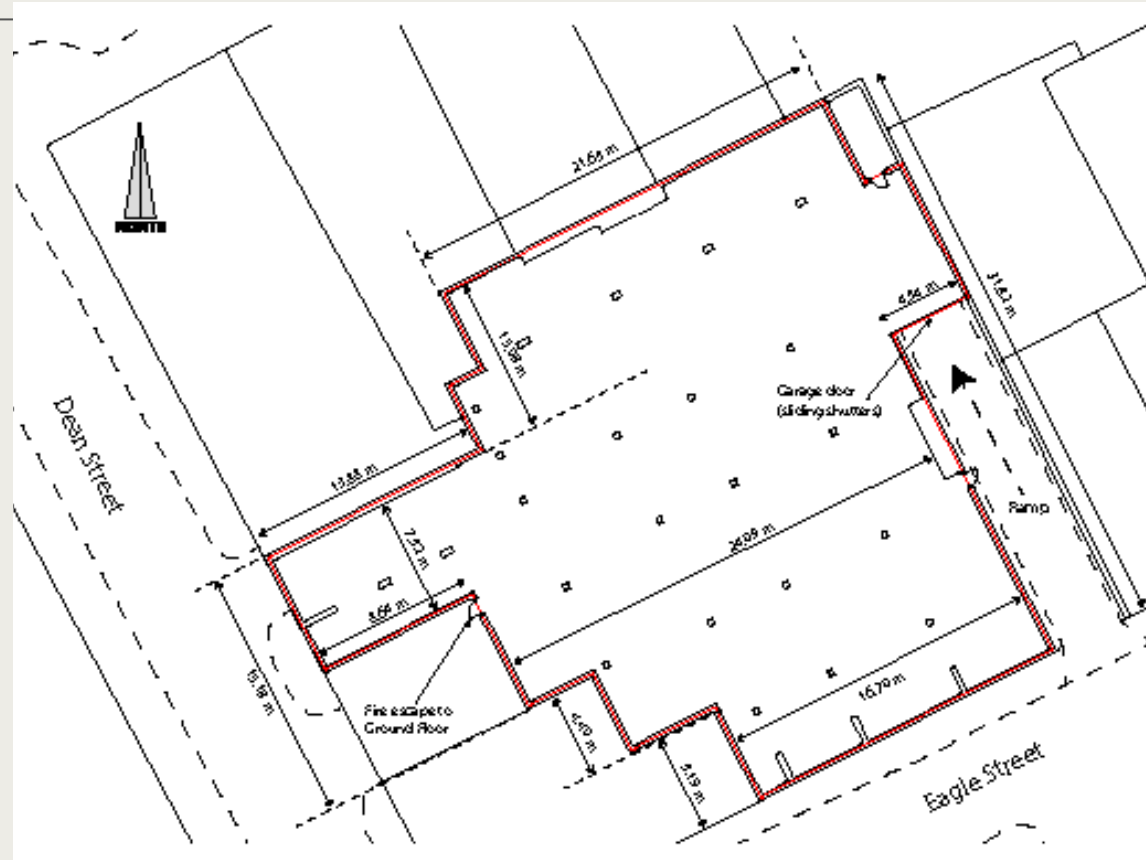
Site Description

Eagle Street, the site is a 750 m² former below ground carpark beneath the residential blocks and communal areas of Red Lion Square Estate. The property features a vast open area with structural columns with scope for a number of different potential uses.

Natural light can be drawn from the access ramp and could create a pleasant welcome space to any potential use.

There is a secondary fire escape shared with residential blocks above.
