The Plaza Parade was built in 2018 and centrally located on Maylands Avenue, close to its junction with Wood Lane End. Occupiers in the parade include Tesco Express, Greggs, Indigo Sun and Starbucks amongst several other independent tenants.

The subject unit is set back from the existing parade and built within Phase 2 of the development which has provided a further 166 residential units.
