Location

Bicester is located on the M40 Motorway, midway between Birmingham and London, approximately 12 miles north of Oxford and just 6 miles from J10 and only 4 miles from Junction 9 of the M40, further connecting the town to the A43 dual carriageway via the A41 trunk road.

Unit A3 Telford Road is situated within the well-established Telford Road Industrial Estate, accessed just off Bicester's southern ring road and Charbridge Lane (A4421) and close to Bicester town centre.

Description

The property comprises a modern semi-detached light industrial/warehouse unit, together with two-storey offices to the front elevation and a ground floor office addition. Constructed around a steel portal frame and has been divided into a number of working areas for the current occupier which can be removed or adapted to suit a tenant's requirements. Plans are available.

The height to eaves is 3.35 meters and there are two loading doors measuring 3mx3m. The property is to be refurbished and may also suit a trade counter user.

Services

We understand that three phase electricity, mains water, drainage and gas are connected to the property. These services have not been tested by the agents.

Business Rates

Unit A3 has a Rateable Value of £40,500. This is not what you pay. Further information is available from the agents or via the local charging authority.

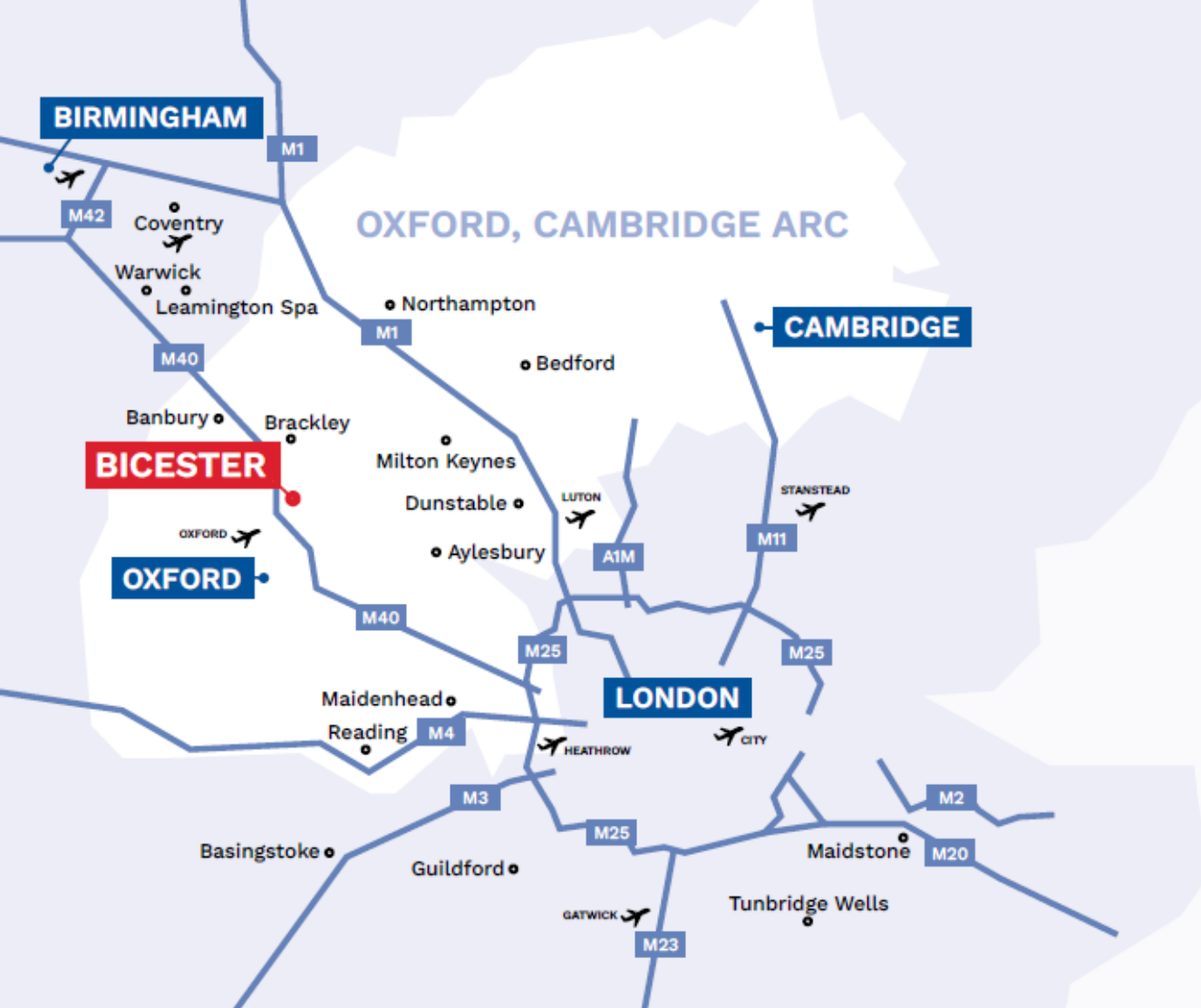
