The densely populated suburb of Southbourne is located approximately 3 miles east of Bournemouth Town Centre and 2 miles from Central Christchurch. 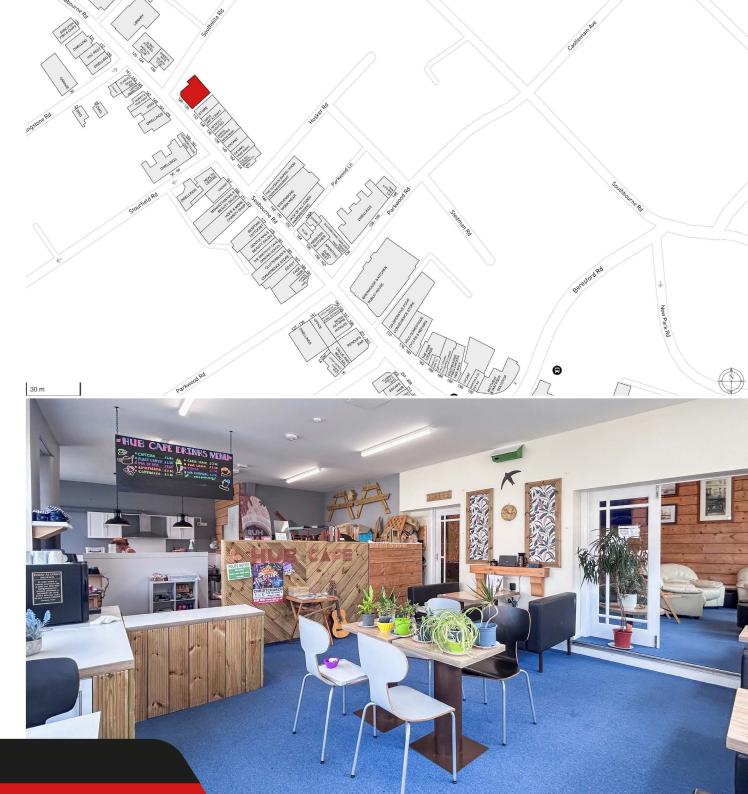
Description

A prominent corner retail unit, benefitting from return frontage to both Seabourne Road and Southville Road. The ground floor is a good size throughout and could benefit from being split into two lock up units.

At ground floor level, there are male & female cloakrooms and a kitchenette. The basement which is a good size and arranged in to a number of rooms, is accessed via an internal staircase and externally via a hatch.

To the side of the property, fronting Southville Road, there is the potential for 3 allocated parking spaces.
