LOCATION

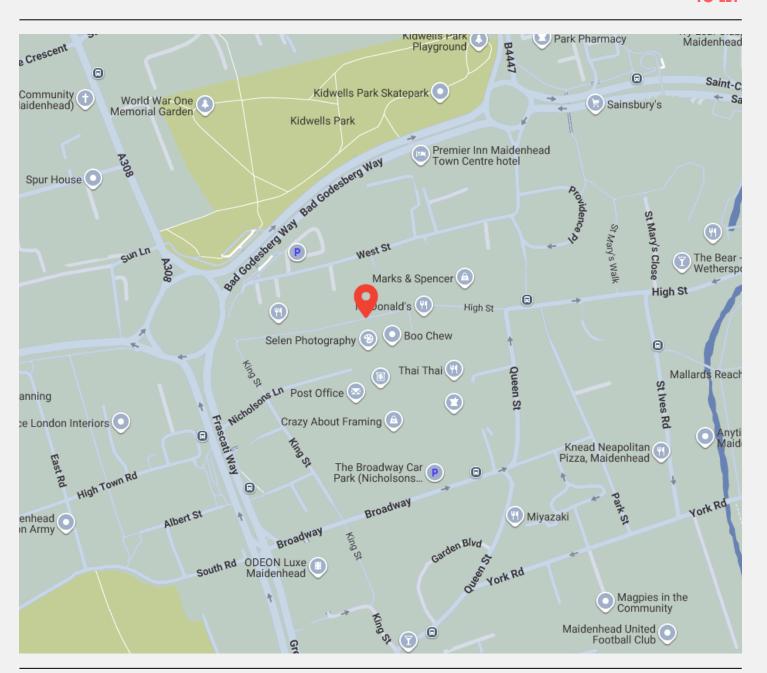
Maidenhead, a market town in the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead, in Berkshire, is located circa 12 miles north east of Reading and 25 miles west of London. The town lies adjacent to Junction 8/9 of the M4 motorway and the A404(M) which links with the M40. Direct rail services to London Paddington has a journey time of approximately 25 minutes

The regeneration of Maidenhead is well underway, benefitting from substantial investment.

The opening of the Crossrail Elizabeth Line allows for faster connectivity across London. Large development projects such as Waterside Quarter and Watermark have completed.

A former bank, the property occupies a prime position on the pedestrianised section of the street directly opposite the entrance to Nicholsons Shopping Centre.

Key occupiers currently include M&S, Boots, Costa, Tesco Express and Specsavers.

The property is to be redeveloped to convert the first and second floors of the building to residential.

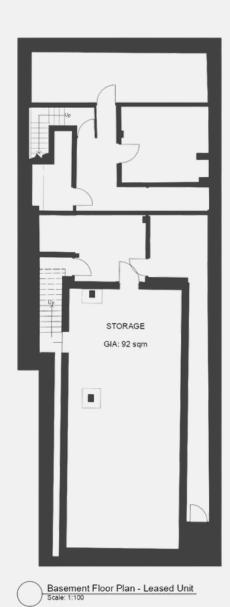

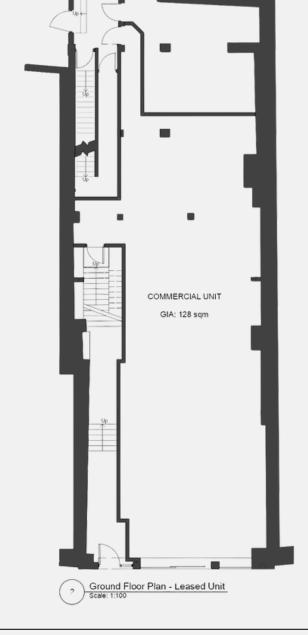

The configuration of space is shown on the attached sketch proposals, providing open plan accommodation.

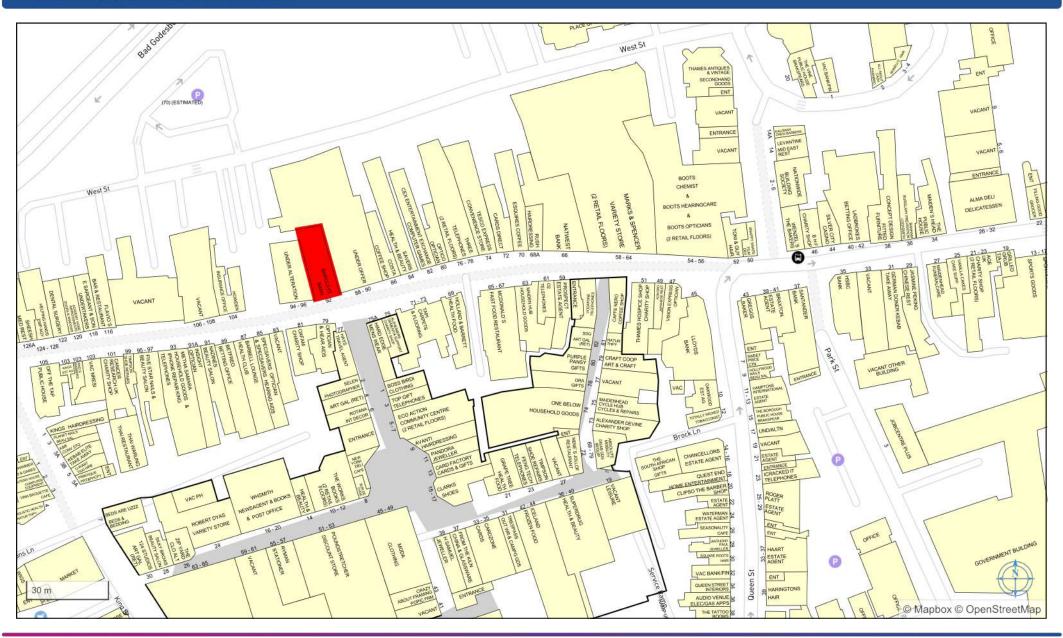
