


FLOOR DETAILS

- **First Floor:** Includes a glazed, partitioned director's office / private meeting room, high ceilings, plus access to a rear fire escape and light well.
- **Second Floor:** Dual-aspect accommodation with excellent two-way natural light.
- **Third Floor:** Dual-aspect accommodation with far-reaching views and strong natural light, also benefitting from private call booth.





DESCRIPTION

Occupying the first, second and third floors, this attractive and versatile Class E building offers high-quality office accommodation which can be let on a floor-by-floor basis or as a whole.

The common parts are currently being refurbished, with design references including a Hague Blue colour palette, subtle Art-Deco detailing, upgraded entrance lighting and a stair runner to the main stairwell (see image precedents).

Each office floor will be delivered in white-box condition, featuring refurbished engineered timber flooring, a fitted kitchenette, LED lighting and excellent levels of natural light to both front and rear elevations. The accommodation will be ready for occupation from 19 March 2026.



LOCATION

The building is prominently situated on the west side of Lexington Street, between Beak Street and Brewer Street, in the heart of Soho

Oxford Circus Underground Station (Bakerloo, Victoria and Central lines) is approximately 0.4 miles away, with Piccadilly Circus Underground Station (Bakerloo and Piccadilly lines) just 0.2 miles distant, providing exceptional connectivity across London.

Soho is internationally renowned for its strong association with the media and creative industries and benefits from immediate proximity to the retail destinations of Regent Street and Carnaby Street.
