Highly prominent building comprising 21,543 sq ft NIA of Grade A office accommodation arranged over basement, ground and six upper floors.

Flexible floorplates ranging from 1,563 to 3,169 sq ft, with exceptional views and excellent levels of natural light.

Multi-let to four office tenants including Centurion Selection Limited, Sapio Research Limited, Deerns UK Limited and Field Gibson Media Limited.

Reversionary passing rent of £479,125 per annum, reflecting £41.95 per sq ft.

The Southbank is one of the most visited areas in London, attracting over 34.8 million people in 2024. It is home to iconic landmarks including the Tate Modern, National Theatre, London Eye and The Shard. The Southbank Centre alone hosts more than 5,000 events each year, drawing 4.5 million visitors to exhibitions, concerts and festivals.

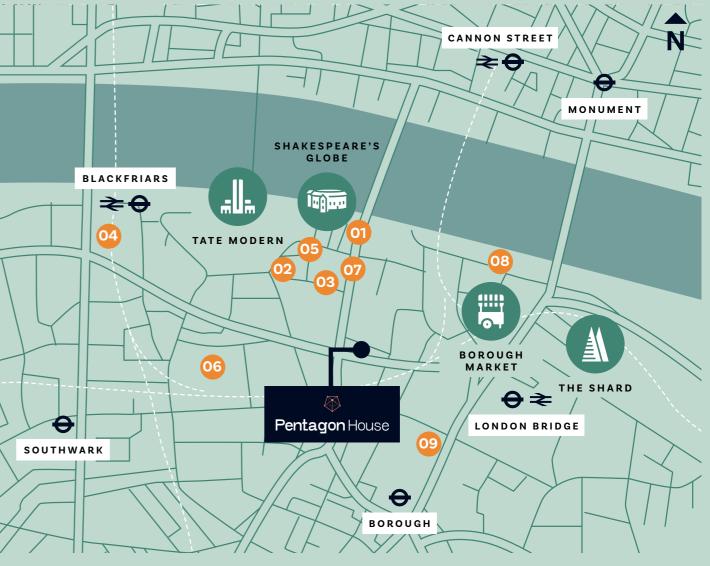

Pentagon House

Pentagon House is a prominent office building comprising 21,543 sq ft NIA across basement, ground and six upper floors.

Originally of Victorian construction, the building features traditional brick elevations with modern aluminium glazing to the front and rear. A comprehensive refurbishment was completed in 2013, with subsequent upgrades to the M&E systems carried out in recent years.

The property benefits from floorplates ranging from 1,563–3,169 sq ft and excellent natural light throughout.

Opportunity to regear current leases with occupiers who have been in the Property for multiple terms.









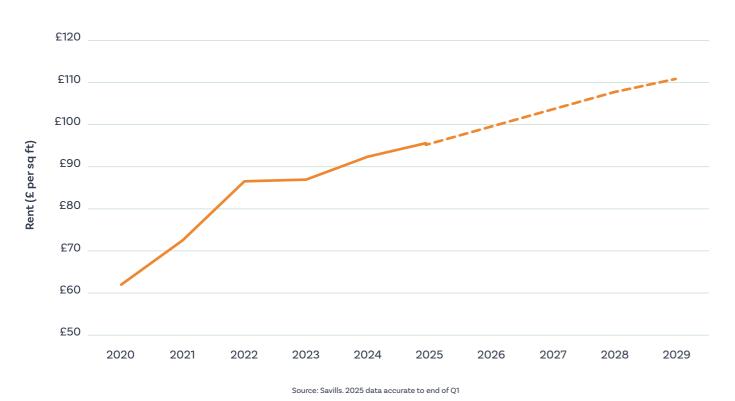

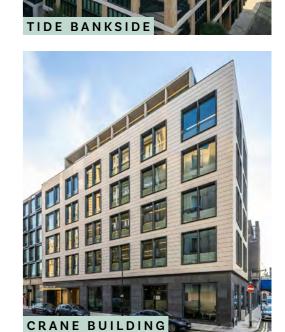
