Description

40A Bank Street is a 2 storey refurbished building providing 7 studios, with shared WC and kitchenette facilities. The refurbishment has been recently completed and benefits from:

Location

The property is located in the Cathedral Quarter in Sheffield city centre. The Cathedral Quarter has witnessed a renaissance in recent years with a number of substantial buildings being converted into private residences. The property is a stone's throw from Fargate and thus enjoys excellent transport links in terms of tram and bus stops. There is also on street and multistorey car parking immediately nearby.



Tenure and Tenancy

The property is held freehold and is currently fully let to 7 separate tenants, all on short term contracts with 3 month notice (further details available on request).

The tenancies are all on an all exclusive basis (except business rates) and provide a total annual income of £32,280 pax. This provides a net annual income of £30,233 pax.
