

## GRADE TWO

Candidates may be asked up to 3 questions. These may be chosen from the previous grade and from the following

assemblé	assemble/join together
soutenu	sustain/hold
en dehors	outwards
en dedans	inwards
en arrière	travelling backwards
relevé	rise/a snatching of the feet
ports de bras	carriage of the arms
croisé	crossed
ouvert	open
en face	facing (the audience)
passé	pass
enchainement	chain of steps/linking together of two or more steps.
changement	change
soubresaut	simple jump without change of feet

## GRADE THREE

Candidates may be asked up to 3 questions. These may be chosen from the previous grades and from the following

<b>Question</b>	<b>Answer</b>
rond de jambe	circle of the leg
à terre	on the ground
arabesque	represents the shape of a bow/ a position on one leg, the other in 4 <sup>th</sup> opposite 1 <sup>st</sup> à terre or en l'air
de côté	facing the side
demi-detourné	half a turn towards the back foot
pas de chat	step of a cat
pas de bourrée	small running steps/consisting of three movements (5 <sup>th</sup> ; 2 <sup>nd</sup> ; 5 <sup>th</sup> )
pas de basque	step from the Basque country representing the swirl of a skirt
sissonne	a scissor movement from two feet onto one foot
