agreeable to a resolution of Council on the 20th June 1841
to Jos. Pinn Architect for £1055 said bond dated
11th Oct 1841 - for said sum - with interest
at 6 per cent - & payable on the 10th Oct
1842 - & that this resolution be engraved on
the back of said bond

Resolved that the following be presented to the
Court of Ireland - To his Excellency Earl of Grey

We the Mayor Sheriff & Common Council of Limerick
assembled at a meeting, beg leave to take this first
opportunity we have since your Excellency assumed
the Government of this Country to assure you
of our inviolable attachment to her Majesty's person
Crown & Government - and to express the gratitude we
owe to her Majesty for having selected a Nobleman
as her Representative in this County - whose public
& private character is held in such estimation as to
deserve the veneration & respect of her faithful & loyal
subjects - We cannot conclude without taking
the opportunity of renewing the assurance of our inviolable
attachment to our beloved Sovereign & our anxious desire
to promote the peace & prosperity of this part of her Majesty's
Dominions.
