Again there was an increase in admissions and the number of babies born.

Increasing costs and increasing salaries are putting severe strain on the hospital resources. It has been necessary to make adjustments in the prices charged. During the year the hall and stairways as well as room 6 were renovated.

MEDICAL REPORT, 1971

The number of admissions was 819 (744) and the number of babies born was 796 (702). The 1970 figures are gives in brackets for comparision.

Caesarian Operations: There were 20 cases.

Twins: Nine patients had twins. Two died of atelutasis and prematurity and one was anencaphalic.

Stillbirths: There were 8 cases (16 last year). Five had major congenital abnormalities. Two were due to cord anomaly. One was the baby of a diabetic mother. One was unexplained. P.M. was carried out.

Naonatal Deaths: There were 11 cases. (7 last year). Congenital abnormalities was responsible for 2. Six were due to atelectasis and prematurity. Asphyxia was the cause of one. (No P.M.). One was due to difficult Breech delivery (No P.M.). One baby died in another hospital and no details were obtained.

Maternal Death: One patient died from rupture of a lower segment scar in labour, in spite of operative repair and transfusion.
