The Commissioners having converted the New Consols held by them, in trust for the charities under their control, into  $\pounds_{4\frac{1}{2}}$  per cent. War Loan Stock, you are requested to note that, in future, the dividends on New Consols heretofore payable to you in January and July, or in April and October, as the case may be, will cease to be paid, and in lieu thereof dividends on the War Stock will be payable in June and December.

The New Consols will not bear further interest after the 5th inst., and in the case of Charities in which the dividends would ordinarily be remitted in January, 1916, one quarter's interest to the 5th inst. will be payable, and will be remitted to you as soon as possible; and, in addition, one half-year's interest on the War Stock will be paid to all the charities entitled in December next.
