Dear Madam,

I thank you for your letter of the 20th inst. enclosing Report, for which I am very much obliged.

My Committee propose calling a Meeting some day in the week commencing the 1st September, in Dublin, at which the Representatives of all Tospitals in the Free State, who are eligible to participate, will be present.

I have pleasure in enclosing herewith a form showing exactly the details that are required for the presentation of a scheme under the Public Charitable Mospitals (Temporary Provisions) Act 1930.

You will notice that it is necessary to have prepared an Audited Statement of your Accounts for the last financial year ending prior to June of this year.

For your information, I would point out that in the second column the total number of days all the beds in your Hospital were occupied, and in the third column the actual number of days beds were

occupied by free patients, or by patients for whom not more than 10/- per week was paid by themselves, or on their behalf by anybody, should be stated.

While this is in the course of preparation, it would be well if your Managing Committee, or Poard, held a Meeting, at which it will be necessary for them to pass a Resolution declaring their intention of joining in with the Dublin and other Mospitals in promoting future Sweeps, and to engge Mesers Hospitals' Trust, Ltd. as promoters, upon the terms of the Agreement at present in existence, subject of course to any modifications that your Board, or other Poards, may agree upon.

It will be necessary for your Board, or Committee, to appoint two Representatives to act in their interest on the joint Committee referred to.

If I have not made myself clear, perhaps you will be good enough to write me asking for any details or particulars you require.
