WHEREAS this Indenture is supplemental to an Indenture of Agreement bearing date the 14th day of October 1930 made between certain of the Governing Bodies and the Promoters for the conducting of a Sweepstake under the provisions of the Public Charitable Hospitals (Temporary Provisions) Act 1930 upon the Grand National Race 1931.

AND WHEREAS it was provided by Article 25 of the said Agreement that the terms and conditions thereof should apply mutatis mutandis to further Sweepstakes sanctioned by the Minister for Justice to be held under the Act by the Governing Rodies and in particular to a Sweepstake upon the Derby Race 1931 AND WHEREAS it was provided by Article 26 of the said Agreement that the Governing Bodies (parties thereto) should give due representation on the Committee of Governing Bodies of other Hospitals adhering to the said Agreement at any time before a Scheme should be sanctioned by the Minister AND WHEREAS the Governing Eodies parties hereto and not parties to the said Agreement of the 14th day of October 1930 have each executed Agreements adhering to the terms of the said Agreement and have been given representation on the Committee of Governing Bodies AND WHEREAS the Governing Bodies desire to promote a Sweepstake under the Provisions of the Act upon the Derby Race 1931 on the terms and conditions of the said Agreement of 14th day of October 1930 subject to the alterations and additions herein provided NOW THIS as follows:-INDENTURE WITNESSETH

- 1. The Governing Bodies agree to hold a Sweepstake under the Act upon the Derby Race 1931.
- 2. The Governing Podies and Promoters agree that the said Sweep-stake subject to the sanction of the Minister shall be held conducted managed and promoted in accordance with the Scheme of the Committee already prepared and upon the terms and conditions of the said Agreement of 14th day of October 1930 subject to the amendments contained herein.
- The percentage payable to the Promoters provided for in Article
 14 (b) of the said Agreement shall be altered and in lieu

thereof there shall be payable to the Promoters out of the amount of moneys received from the sale of tickets ascertained under the Act the following moneys:-

6% thereof will be paid to the Promoters for promoting the Sweepstake in respect of the first moneys received from the sale of tickets not exceeding £100,000.

- 5% thereof will similarly be paid in respect of the second £100,000 received from the sale of tickets and 2% thereof will similarly be paid in respect of all moneys received from the sale of tickets exceeding £200,000.
- 4. In case the disbursements certified by the Auditors to have been properly incurred in and about the Sweepstake together with the percentage payable to the Promoters as provided for in Article 3 hereof shall exceed thirty per cent. of the moneys received from the sale of tickets in the Sweepstake calculated under the Act the Promoters shall themselves bear any such excess.
- the Scheme and shall consist of the moneys paid into or earned by the Trustees Prize Account after deduction of any moneys paid thereout for purposes of adjustment under the direction of the Auditors. The Prizes shall be provided by the Committee and shall be paid in manner following that is to say:-

ALL prizes payable out of the prize units as determined by the Committee on the provisional certificate of the Auditors provided for in Article 7 of the Scheme shall be payable to the prizewinners on the expiration of seven days from the Race. The balance of the sum so certified by the Auditors over and above the prize units shall be equally distributed between the drawers of the one hundred cash prizes provided for in the Scheme on the expiration of the said seven days from the race. The remainder, if any, of the sum available for prizes will be equally distributed between the drawers of the said one hundred cash prizes so soon as the Auditors have presented and certified their final accounts. This final distribution shall be made within three months of the race.

6. For the purpose of the Prizes:

Winning Horse and Placed Horses shall be determined in accordance with the Pules of Tattersalls Committee Governing Wagers.

- 7. There shall be added after the words College Green, Dublin in Article 10 (a) the words "or such other Bank or Banks as the Trustees may from time to time direct".
- 8. There shall be added after the words Pank of Ireland, College Green, Dublin, in Article 10 (d) the words "or in such other Bank or Banks as the Trustees may from time to time have a Trustees Hospital Account or Accounts" and after the words "National Bank, College Green, Dublin" in the same Article the words "or at such other bank or banks as the Trustees may from time to time have a Prize Account or Accounts".
- 9. Wherever the words "Proceeds Account" "Trustees Hospital Account" or "Trustees Prize Account" appear in said Agreement there shall be added the words "or Accounts".
- Agreement of the 14th day of October 1930, and subject to the amendments and additions made herein the said Agreement shall remain and be of full force and effect and shall be binding on all the Governing Bodies parties hereto.

IN WITNESS whereof each of the Governing Bodies has caused its Common Seal to be affixed hereto or not having a Common Seal has caused the within Agreement to be duly executed by a person or persons on its behalf authorised thereto and the Promoters have caused their Common Seal to be affixed hereto the day and year first above WRITTEN.
