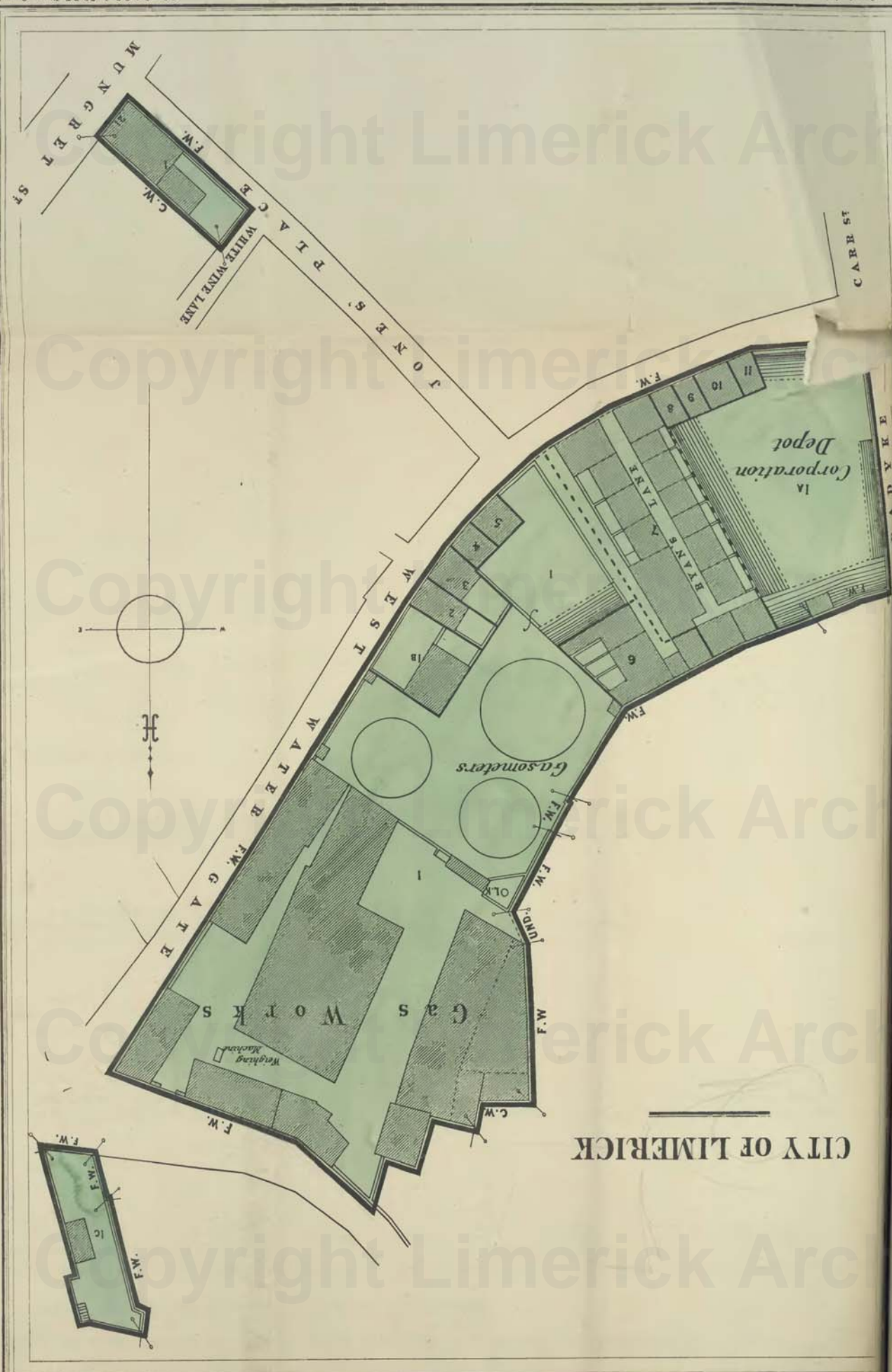

Consolidated Final Notice to Tenants and adjoining Owners and Occupiers.

To all whom it may concern.

The Land Judges of the High Court of Justice, Ireland, have ordered a Sale of Houses, Yard, Gas Works, and Premises at West Watergate, in the Parish of Saint Michael, and City of Limerick; and also the House and Premises, No. 21, Mungret Street, in the Parish of Saint John, and City of Limerick, held in fee, and which Premises are delineated on the Map hereto annexed, and are alleged to be subject to the tenancies, leases, agreements for lease, rights of common, rights of turbary, rights of way, and other rights and easements set forth in the Schedule hereto.

If any person alleges that he has any interest in said premises, not derived under said leases, agreements, or tenancies, or that his interest is incorrectly stated, or claims any right of common or of cutting turf, right of way, or other easement affecting any of the said lands, and not admitted in the said Schedule, or any objection to the boundaries as delineated on the said Map, he must lodge his objection, in writing, with the Clerk of the Records of the said Court, on or before the 4th day of November, 1881, otherwise his interest will be barred and concluded by said Sale; and said Map will be treated as conclusive and binding on all persons whoever. And such objection must be verified by affidavit, entitled as above, and sworn, if out of Dublin, before one of the Commissioners of the High Court of Justice, and transmitted under cover, sealed with the seal of the said Commissioner.

And Notice is also given to the owners and occupiers of adjoining Premises that I have fixed Friday, the 11th day of November, 1881, at my Chamber, Land Judges' Court, Inns'-quay, Dublin, for the settlement of the Rental of said Premises, when any person interested is at liberty to attend.
